(All Webbs).

Summary: In accordance with County PPM CW-O-051, all delegated contracts/agreements/grants/ procurement items must be submitted by the initiating Department as a receive and file agenda item and are attached unless the documents have been recorded in the Public Records of Palm Beach County. The documents have been fully executed on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) by the Director of the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) in accordance with Resolutions R93-1619, R96-0228, and R2003-0539 and are now being submitted to the BCC to receive and file. Districts 2 & 5 (MJ)

Background and Justification: PBCWUD's Uniform Policies and Procedures require Standard Development Agreements to obtain concurrency for water and/or wastewater service. The terms and conditions for Standard Development Agreements are outlined in the PBCWUD Uniform Policies and Procedures Manual. The BCC delegated the authority to execute various types of Standard Development Agreements, and related documents including Standard Indemnity Agreements to the Department Director including potable water and wastewater agreements (R93-1619); reclaimed water agreements (R96-0228); and additional conditions for potable water, wastewater, and reclaimed water agreements (R2003-0539).

- A) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Renewal Agreement is with Mattamy Palm Beach, LLC SDA #01-01232-001 (District 2). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located south of Southern Boulevard on the east side of Jog Road, 55.00 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- B) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Renewal Agreement with Toll FL I, LLC SDA #09-01075-000 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located east of Jog Road and north of Old Clint Moore Road, 116.95 ERC's for water and 118.45 ERC's for wastewater for five (5) years.
- C) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Second Renewal Agreement with Boca Raton Associates VII, LLLP SDA #09-01051-001 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located west of Lyons Road, east of SR 7 and south of Atlantic Boulevard, 140.90 ERC's for water and 157.00 ERC's for wastewater for five (5) years.
- D) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Second Renewal Agreement with Principal Development Group, LLC SDA #03-01021-002 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located northwest of Hagen Ranch Road and Atlantic Avenue, 64.40 ERC's for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- E) CO No. 5 provides geophysical logging and drilling in order to remove a 26-inch diameter surface casing at well 3W-10. This work is required due to unforeseen site conditions; the additional surface casing needs to be removed before rehabilitation of the well can be completed. CO No. 5 will increase the contract amount by \$33,000.00 and for an additional 22 calendar days project time extension. Change Order No. 1 was approved on August 28, 2019 in the amount of \$63,000.00. Change Order No. 2 was approved on December 16, 2020 in the amount of \$1,443.25 and provides for a 34-day time extension. Change Order No. 3 was approved on March 3, 2021 in the amount of \$3,750.00 and provides for a 57-day time extension. Change Order No. 4 was approved on April 15, 2021 in the amount of \$11,655.10 and provides for an 11-day time extension. The cumulative time extension including Change Order Nos. 1 to 5 is 122 days. County PPM CW-F-050 requires BCC notification when the cumulative limit of one hundred twenty (120) days has been reached to reset the applicable time limit approvals. 

To date, AWE has removed the existing 12-inch diameter well screen and riser and 20-inch diameter well casing. During that time, problems with overdrilling of the 20-inch were encountered included obstructions on or adjacent to the casing which slowed progress. Today, prior to installing the new 24-inch PVC well casing, AWE discovered a 26-inch diameter well casing approximately 7.5 feet below grade. This existence of this casing was not anticipated based on the well construction information for 3W-10 and may likely had been the obstructing slowing progress in earlier phases of work.

Attached, please find AWE's request for work authorization. AWE is requesting \$3,000 to perform a caliper log to the existing total depth (approximately 80 feet) to determine the estimated depth of the 26-inch diameter well casing; and \$30,000 to perform a 28-inch diameter overdrill of the 26-inch diameter well casing. Based on line item C4 in the contract bid, the AWE cost for overdrill was bid at \$60,000. Their work to date has included two overdrills of the 12-inch casing and 20-inch casing. As such, the requested fee of \$30,000 to perform a 3rd overdrill is in line with the bid costs. The removal of this additional existing casing is necessary to proceed with new well construction if the well is to remain an in-place replacement. As previously discussed during the progress meetings, relocation would involve additional permitting given the location of the nearby forcemain.
