The County has expended or encumbered \$1,703,989 (\$90,879/month) during the previous eighteen and three quarter (18.75) months of the current sixty (60) month term contract. An increase of \$5,501,000 over the previous authorized amount of \$2,469,000 is required to continue painting services countywide for the remaining forty-one and one quarter (41.25) months of the current term contract. This increase is necessary since the initial dollar amount of this contract was calculated based on a twelve (12) month term rather than a sixty (60) month term. Approval is also requested to add vendors that may become pre-qualified during the remaining term of the contract. Pre-qualification contracts allow for the addition of new qualified vendors during the full term of the contract. This term contract has no renewal options. The County has expended or encumbered \$591,688 (\$33,811/month) during the previous seventeen and one half (17.5) months of the current twentyfour (24) month term contract. An increase of \$150,000 over the previous authorized amount of \$666,079.70, inclusive of the Purchasing Director's ten percent (10%) authority, is required in order to continue tire services for County vehicles for the remaining six and one half (6.5) months of the current term contract. This increase is necessary due to the addition of a line item for the purchase of tires installed during service calls that were previously paid for under a separate CMA which has expired. The County has expended or encumbered \$161,120 (\$14,322/month) during the previous eleven and one quarter (11.25) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, resulting in staff workload reprioritization and periodic non-availability for work, a twelve (12) month extension to the current term contract with a retroactive start date of 08/16/2021, is necessary to solicit and award a new term contract. Due to the need for maintenance, repair and replacement of heavily used pumps, which are also subject to extreme conditions, runtime and are installed in heavily populated areas, \$687,500 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new twelve (12) month term contract. Xylem Water Solutions USA, Inc. ("Xylem"), a sole source vendor, requires that the County agree to indemnification and limitation of liability provisions that deviate from the County's standard requirements. In accordance with PPM CW-F-049, Risk Management and the County Attorney's Office negotiated and agreed to: (i) the County's and Xylem's waiver against each other, and against the other's officers, directors, members, partners, and employees of any and all claims for or entitlement to special, incidental, indirect, punitive, or consequential damages arising out of, resulting from, or related to the Contract; and (ii) the total liability of each party to the other for claims, costs, losses, and damages arising from the Contract to be limited to the amount established as the Contract Price ("Limitation of Liability"). The Limitation of Liability does not apply to Xylem's duty to indemnify the County in accordance with the County's standard indemnification provision, nor does it limit any claim by either party against the other based on costs, losses, or damages asserted by third parties for bodily injury, sickness, disease, or death, or to injury to or destruction of the tangible property; gross negligence or willful misconduct. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing shall be construed as a waiver of sovereign immunity under Section 768.28, Florida Statutes, nor a waiver of any defense the parties may have under such statute, nor as consent to be sued by third parties.
