I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: payment in an amount not to exceed \$9,000 for participation in the 15th Annual Palm Beach Partners Business Matchmaker Conference & Expo, which will be held on September 17, 2021.

Summary: The Palm Beach County Office of Equal Business Opportunity, Department of Airports, and Palm Tran are participating with the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD), the School District of Palm Beach County, the City of West Palm Beach, the Center for Technology, Enterprise & Development, Inc. (TED Center), and the Solid Waste Authority (SWA) to present the 2021 Business Matchmaker Conference & Expo (a statewide conference). This is the 15th Annual Matchmaker Conference & Expo held in Palm Beach County, and Palm Beach County will contribute a total of \$9,000 with the County's contribution broken down as follows: the Office of Equal Business Opportunity – \$3,000, Department of Airports – \$3,000, and Palm Tran – \$3,000. Payment will be made on or before August 31, 2021, to the TED Center, the fiscal agent for the conference. The conference and expo will provide Small Business Enterprise owners an opportunity to collaborate with larger businesses in an effort to increase business opportunities and knowledge of programs offered by the above listed governmental and non-profit partners. Countywide (DB) (OEBO).

Background and Justification: On September 17, 2021, the Palm Beach Partners will present the 15th Annual 2021 Business Matchmaker Conference & Expo virtually. This event will feature workshops and seminars that will provide information to Small/Minority/Women Business Enterprise (S/M/WBE) owners. Additionally, one-on-one business matchmaking appointments will be made available for conference participants to meet with key staff from Palm Beach County, the SFWMD, School District of Palm Beach County, the City of West Palm Beach, the TED Center, and the SWA.

Purpose of Form
