I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 3 to the Contract for Consulting/Professional Services Emergency and Disaster Mitigation and Recovery (Contract) with Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. (CGA) for the Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Nos. 8 and 11 Hurricane Hardening (Project) for a not to exceed amount of \$335,465.00.

Summary: On June 20, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2017-0821) with CGA. CSA No. 3 provides for consulting/professional engineering services and related services for a hurricane hardening evaluation and recommendations at WTP Nos. 8 and 11. This Contract was procured under the requirements of the 2002 Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance (R2002-0064) prior to the adoption of the new Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance on October 16, 2018. The SBE participation goal established under the 2002 Ordinance was 15% overall participation. The Contract provides for 41% SBE participation. CSA No. 3 includes 46.48% SBE participation. The cumulative SBE participation including CSA No. 3 is 55.20% SBE participation. While CGA is headquartered in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, they maintain an office in Palm Beach County from which the majority of the work under CSA No. 3 will be undertaken. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY21 budget (PBCWUD Project No. 21-061) Districts 2, 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: PBCWUD owns, operates, and maintains five (5) water treatment plants, including WTP Nos. 8 and 11. The purpose of this Project is to evaluate the facilities at WTP Nos. 8 and 11 against the latest edition of the Florida Building Code wind loading criteria. The Project will also provide recommendations and prepare a cost estimate for planning purposes for facilities in need of hardening. Implementation of the hurricane hardening recommendations will improve life safety of PBCWUD personnel and reliability of production and distribution of potable water during hurricane events.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Project Title: Water Treatment Plant Nos. 8 and 11 Hurricane Hardening

Scope of Services

Background

The Water Treatment Plants (WTP) Nos. 8 and 11 are water treatment facilities owned and operated by Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD). Improvements to the Florida Building Code (FBC), particularly with respect to wind loading, have been made. PBCWUD has requested Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. (CGA) to provide a structural evaluation of a total of five (5) selected structures at the WTP Nos. 8 and 11. Although WTP No. 8 consists of eighteen (18) structures and WTP No. 11 consists of ten (10) structures, this scope of work is limited to a total five (5) initial structures that are considered to have the highest priority uses. The aim of the evaluation is to determine whether the selected buildings comply with current wind load criteria, as set forth in the latest version of the FBC. If the structures are found to be deficient, remedial work will be recommended to bring the structures into compliance. CGA will prepare a technical memorandum (TM) including the results, findings, and recommended remedial works resulting from the evaluation.

Project Scope

The evaluation will include the following major tasks:

- Research designed/permitted information available on the existing buildings at WTP Nos. 8 and 11, as listed below. The research of the available information assumes that the PBCWUD will provide all the required documentation, including record drawings, specifications, calculations, and Building Department permits. Perform 3D scanning of all the buildings/structures to document the conditions of the exterior envelope.
 - a. WTP No. 8
 - 1. Administration, Control, and Filter Building
 - 2. Generator and Warehouse Building
 - 3. Chlorine Building
 - 4. Vacuum Filter Building
 - 5. Wellfield Generator
 - 6. Lime Delivery System
 - 7. Lime Softening Units
 - 8. Ferric Chloride System
 - 9. Anion Exchange Systems 1 and 2
 - 10. Brine Storage Facility
 - 11. Lime Softener Effluent Flume
 - 12. Chemical Storage Facility
 - 13. Ammonia Storage Facility
 - 14. Carbon Dioxide Storage Facility

- 15. Ozone Contact Basin
- 16. Fluoride System
- 17. Washwater Recovery Basin
- 18. Wastewater Pump Station No. 7004

b. WTP No. 11

- 1. Administration, Control, and Membrane Building
- 2. Warehouse Building
- 3. Electrical Building
- 4. Florida Power and Light Transformer
- 5. Sodium Hypochlorite Storage Facility
- 6. Chemical Storage Facility
- 7. Carbon Dioxide, Ammonia, and Cal-Flo Storage System
- 8. Clearwell, Degasifier, and Odor Scrubber
- 9. Process Drain Pump Station
- 10. Injection Well and Monitoring Well
- Visual condition assessment of the existing exterior envelope of the five (5) selected buildings, which are:
 - a. WTP No. 8
 - 1. Administration, Control, and Filter Building
 - 2. Generator and Warehouse Building
 - 3. Chlorine Building
 - 4. Wellfield Generator
 - b. WTP No. 11
 - 1. Administration, Control and Membrane Building

Evaluation of the existing structural exterior components using the current live, dead, and wind load criteria as detailed in the FBC, for the selected aforementioned buildings.

- 3. As required, perform nondestructive tests on the exterior envelope of the selected buildings to identify the presence of masonry grout columns and steel reinforcing.
- 4. Identify and provide recommendations of the areas that may require improvements to comply with current live, dead, and wind load criteria in accordance with the FBC. Provide planning level cost estimates with technical descriptions and sketches of each area of the selected aforementioned buildings that will require remedial work.

The Scope of Professional Services to be provided and associated fees are detailed herein. CGA shall execute Professional Services Agreements (PSAs) with Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. (LYE) and RADISE International, L.C. (RADISE) to assist with the structural evaluation of the exterior envelope of the buildings. CGA understands that time is of the essence, and, shall make every effort to perform this work in an expeditious manner, whenever possible. The specific work to be completed under each task is detailed below.

Task 1 - Due Diligence

CGA shall perform the due diligence to obtain the required information to complete the evaluation. These services shall include:

1.1. Review site pictures, record drawings, permits, copies of any emergency repair work, and other relevant PBCWUD records. The research of the available information

- assumes that PBCWUD will provide all the required documentation, including record drawings, specifications, calculations, and Building Department permits.
- 1.2. Conduct a visual structural condition assessment of the exterior of the five (5) selected buildings at WTP Nos. 8 and 11. This assessment shall identify structural defects such as corrosion, fatigue, or structural damage by accidental actions.
- 1.3. Review the record drawings of the five (5) selected buildings and identify the critical structure members based on the building elevation and plan view drawings. Evaluate and analyze the exterior envelope of each building structure for lateral wind load requirements per American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) 7-15 latest edition and 186 MPH set by the PBCWUD.
- 1.4. Utilize a Leica C10 High Resolution 3 Dimensional (3D) scanner to obtain as-built information for all eighteen (18) structures\buildings at WTP No. 8 and ten (10) structures/buildings at WTP No. 11. Compile multiple scans around the perimeter of each structure with sufficient overlap for data processing and quality control with redundancy. Process individual data point clouds through 3D scanner software to create a spatially precise as-built of each structure and export into an AutoCAD drawing file structure.
- 1.5. Based on the visual assessment (Task 1, Item 4) and detailed evaluation and analysis (Task 1, Item 5), determine if nondestructive testing will be needed. If so, CGA will indicate the location, type and number of tests required prior to commencement of such field testing.
- 1.6. Prepare a presentation with the findings of the Due Diligence Task, including recommendation of structural elements that require nondestructive testing. After presenting the due diligence findings and detailed evaluation, CGA will discuss with PBCWUD how to proceed with the field work evaluation and technical memorandum. A prioritization of the five (5) buildings will be perform based on use, criticality, and resilience, this will be performed with the use of a weighted scoring to be discuss with PBCWUD. A total of two (2) meetings are assumed for this prioritization.
- 1.7. Prepare for and attend one (1) meeting with PBCWUD staff to discuss the findings of the Due Diligence Task.

- Presentation with approach, findings, and recommendations
- Meeting Agendas and Minutes

Task 2 - Field Evaluation

CGA shall conduct an assessment to evaluate the current condition and compliance with the current live, dead and wind load criteria. These services shall include:

- 2.1. Coordinate and participate in the necessary site visits with subconsultants and PBCWUD.
- 2.2. If necessary, performance of nondestructive testing on the designated structural elements of the five (5) selected buildings as indicated by the Structural Engineer. The type of test will be determined by the Structural Engineer.
- 2.3. Based on the previously performed evaluations, CGA will determine if the results of the tested areas conform to the live, dead, and wind load criteria.
- 2.4. Prepare a presentation with the findings and results of the Field Evaluation Task. A total of one (1) meeting is assumed for this task.

2.5. Prepare for and attend one (1) meeting with PBCWUD staff to discuss the findings and results of the Field Evaluation Task.

Task 3 - Preparation of Technical Memorandum

CGA will prepare a Technical Memorandum (TM) providing a compilation of the findings and preliminary recommendations of the structures to be improved to withstand current wind load requirements. The TM will also provide a preliminary cost estimate (Class 5, 0-2% project definition) for the proposed preliminary recommendations. The services under this task will include the following:

- 3.1. Compile all data related to the results of the investigation performed.
- 3.2. Prepare a TM to include the assessment findings of the eighteen (18) buildings/structures at WTP 8 and ten (10) buildings/structures at WTP 11 and preliminary recommendations related to improve the existing selected five (5) buildings, and associated preliminary cost estimate. A total of one meeting is assumed for this task
- 3.3. Coordinate and participate in the discussion meeting with PBCWUD to discuss the TM

Deliverables

- Electronic copy (Portable Document Format (pdf)) and four (4) hardcopies of the TM.
- Meeting Agendas and Minutes

CGA Assumptions:

The following assumptions were the basis for the preparation of this proposal:

- The scope of work considers only the structural evaluation of the Administration, Control, and Filter Building, Generator and Warehouse Building, Chlorine Building and Wellfield Generator at WTP 8 and the Administration, Control, and Membrane Building at WTP No. 11. It does not include wind load analysis or flying debris mitigation of the screens located at the Filter Building at WTP No. 8.
- Topographical survey, geotechnical investigation nor detailed design are included in CGA tasks.
- The number of nondestructive test will be determined by the Structural Engineer after completing the initial evaluation of the five (5) selected buildings.
- The research of the available information assumes that PBCWUD will provide all the required documentation, including record drawings, specifications, calculations, and Building Department permits.

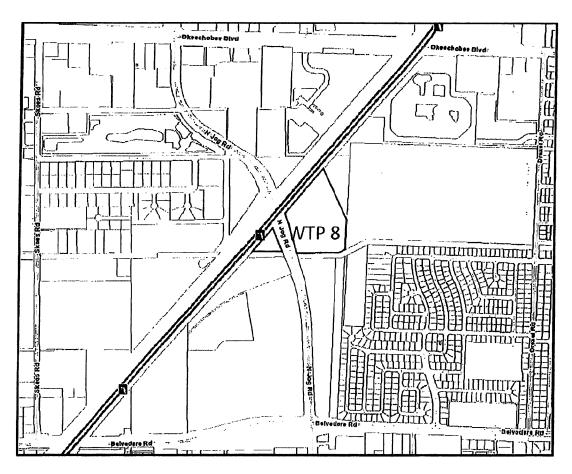

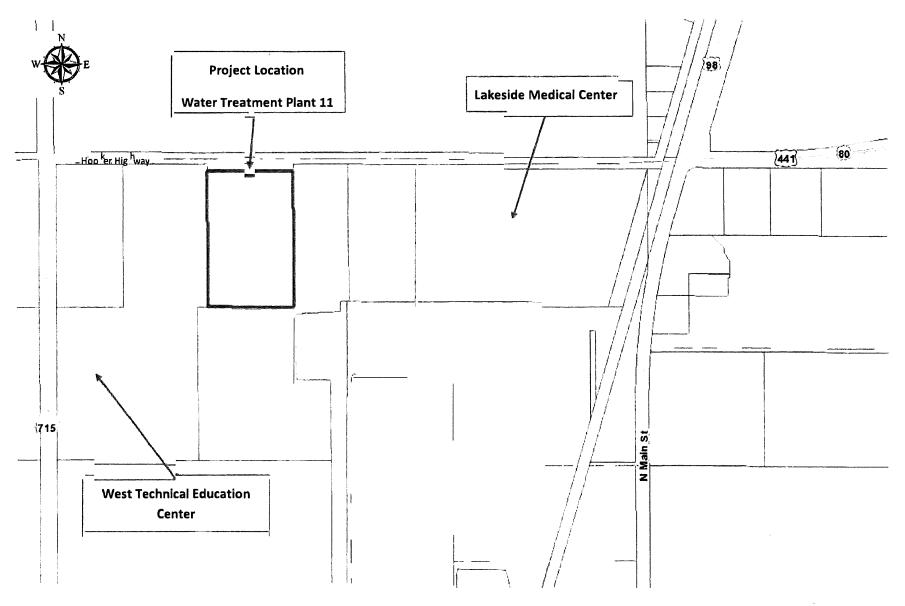

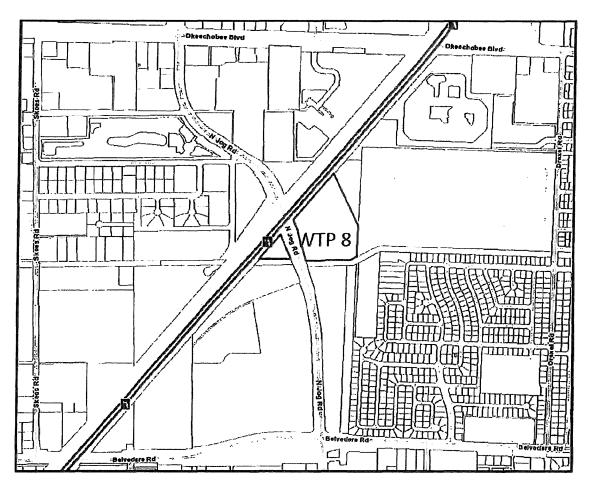
WATER TREATMENT PLANT NO. 8

<u>Location Map – Water Treatment Plant No. 11</u>

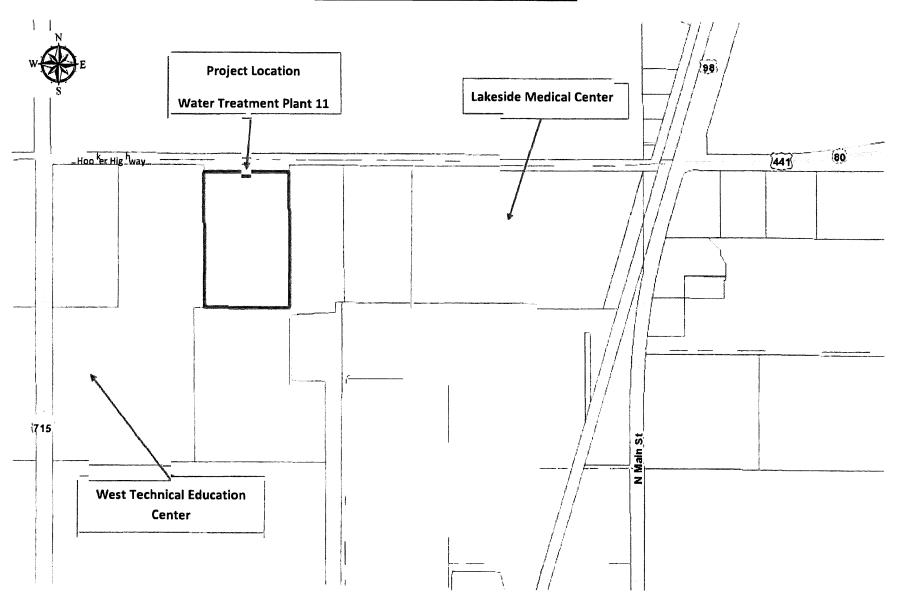
