I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 3 to the South County Reclaimed Water Transmission Pipeline Phase I Contract (Contract) with Chen Moore and Associates, Inc. (Consultant) for the South County Reclaimed Water Transmission Pipeline Sequence 2 (Project) for a not to exceed amount of \$1,043,923.82.

Summary: On March 13, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2018-0295) with Consultant. CSA No. 3 provides for professional consulting services relating to design and permitting of the Project. These services include, survey, subsurface utility exploration, geotechnical exploration, engineering design, permitting, outreach and bidding support services for the design of approximately three (3) miles of proposed 30-inch reclaimed water transmission pipeline. The construction of this pipeline will allow for the delivery of reclaimed water obtained from Broward County to potential customers in the PBCWUD service area.

This Contract was procured under the requirements of the 2002 Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance (R2002-0064) prior to the adoption of the new Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance on October 16, 2018. The SBE goal established under the 2002 Ordinance was 15% overall participation. The Contract provides for 82.50% SBE participation. CSA No. 3 includes 84.43% SBE participation. The cumulative SBE participation, including CSA No. 3, is 82.42%. Consultant is headquartered in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, but maintains an office in Palm Beach County from which the majority of the work will be undertaken. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY21 budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 21-048) <u>District 5</u> (MJ)

Background and Justification: On April 5, 2016, the BCC approved an Interlocal Agreement with Broward County related to the construction, ownership, operation and maintenance of a Regional Reclaimed Water System (Agreement) to deliver reclaimed water from Broward County's northern wastewater treatment plant to the PBCWUD service area (R2016-0470). The First Amendment to the Agreement was approved by the BCC on August 15, 2017 (R2017-1052). The Project will deliver reclaimed water to potential customers in the PBCWUD service area.
