	Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a First Amendment (Amendment) to Communication Tower Agreement with the City of West Palm Beach (City).						
Summary: In 2015, the City constructed a 440-foot guyed communication tower. On May 5, 2015, the County and the City entered into a Communication Tower Agreement (R2015 0573) (Tower Agreement) whereby the County relocated its antenna equipment to the new tower and constructed its own equipment building in order to maintain its public safety and public service communication capabilities. Subsequently, it was determined that the County's share of the Replacement and Renewal Costs were not consistently stated between the Board item, the body of the agreement and the exhibits, as it indicated the monthly contribution, not the annual contribution. In addition, the City permitted another entity to occupy a tower slot reserved for the County, so the County's contributions needed to be reevaluated and the exhibit demonstrating the location of the antenna equipment needed to be updated. This Amendment rectifies these inaccuracies and correctly sets forth the County's annual Replacement and Renewal (R/R) contribution and updates the location of the County's antenna equipment on the tower. The Amendment also sets forth the understanding between the County and the City as to how reserved slots for future use on the tower will be treated if another tower tenant seeks to utilize one of the County's reserved slots for future use. Under said circumstances, the City will be required to ensure that the County's paid an amount equal to 75% of all maintenance and R/R costs paid to date by the County for the reserved slot. Upon execution of this Amendment, the City shall invoice and the County shall pay the amount owed as if County had been assessed the correct Replacement and Renewal cost from the inception of the Tower Agreement. Other than the changes set forth herein, all other terms remain the same. Funding for this Agreement is from the 800 MHz Replacement, Repair & Improvement Fund. (FDO Admin) Countywide/ District 7 (MWJ)							
Background and Policy Issues: Previously, the City and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) had an interlocal agreement for use of the City's communications tower located at 5801 Ernest Street at the City's wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) for public safety radio equipment. The County administered that agreement on behalf of PBSO when the County's public safety radio system became operational. In 2015, the City constructed a new tower at its sole cost and demolished the existing tower to accomplish an expansion of the WWTP. The Tower Agreement replaced the prior interlocal agreement and allowed the County to transfer all existing tower use reservations to the new City tower and to construct a new communications equipment shelter with back-up generator. Under the Tower Agreement, the City agreed to perform all on-going maintenance/repair and the renewal/replacement of the radio tower itself, with County paying a flat user fee (\$10/yr), and a maintenance fee and the renewal/replacement fee based on County's pro rata share of the maintenance and renewal/replacement costs. The term of the Tower Agreement is for thirty (30) years.

# FIRST AMENDMENT TO COMMUNICATION TOWER AGREEMENT

WPB Contract No. 14580.001

WHEREAS, the City constructed a new 440-foot guyed communication tower and equipment building area on property located at 5801 Ernest Street, West Palm Beach, FL 33409 to replace City's existing communications tower used by City and by public safety and local government agencies; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that Communication Tower Agreement, dated May 5, 2015, by and between the City and County (R2015 0573) (the "Agreement"), the County relocated its Antenna Equipment to the new tower and constructed its own equipment building and appurtenances on a portion of the tower property in order to maintain its public safety and public service communication capabilities; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, the parties determined that Exhibit C did not accurately reflect the Antenna Equipment actual locations on the tower; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, the parties determined that Section 6.3.3 of the Agreement incorrectly stated the County's share of the Replacement and Renewal Costs ("**R&R Costs**"), as it indicated the monthly calculation, not the annual contribution; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement, along with Exhibits C, F & G, to correct the error;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the agreements contained in this Amendment, along with other valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

#### 1. Reservation for Future Use. The Agreement is hereby modified to add the following:

5.3.1 The City shall exercise good faith efforts to ensure that one Authorized User does not occupy tower space reserved for another Authorized User's future use, as identified in **Exhibit C**. Prior to the City considering another Authorized User's request for a reserved slot, the City shall proceed as follows.

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- a) City shall advise the Authorized User\_with the reserved slot ("Reserver") of the request and identify a replacement slot within 10' of the reserved slot for the Reserver's consideration. If the request is for a public safety need that cannot be met at an unreserved slot or another tower, and an equivalent slot exists, as determined by Reserver and City, for the Reserver's reservation, the City may process an amendment to the Agreement reflecting the new reserved slots. Updates to <a href="Exhibit C">Exhibit C</a>, along with all structural and intermodulation studies, as required by <a href="Section 5.4">Section 5.4</a> of the Agreement, shall be completed through an amendment prior to the requesting Authorized User placing any equipment in or near the originally reserved slot.
- b) If no replacement slot exists for the Reserver and the City permits an Authorized User ("**Proposer**") to occupy the Reserver's prior reserved slot, the City shall: 1) calculate maintenance and R&R Costs paid to date by Reserver for the reserved slot; and 2) confirm that the Proposer has paid the Reserver an amount equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of all payments Reserver has made for maintenance and R&R Costs for the reserved slot. Such payment shall be made prior to the Proposer placing any equipment in or near the reserved slot, and not more than 60 days from the City's approval of the Proposer's use of the Reserver's reserved slot.
- 2. <u>R&R Cost</u>. Section 6.3.3 of the Agreement is hereby amended and replaced and shall now read as follows:
  - 6.3.3 As of the date of this Agreement, the County's annual share of the R&R Costs shall be Thirty-Two Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Six and 47/100 Dollars (\$32,236.47). City shall invoice County on each anniversary of the date of this Agreement during the Term of this Agreement or any extensions thereof, and payment shall be due within forty-five (45) days of County's receipt of the invoice.
- 2. <u>Exhibits</u>. Pursuant to Section 16.19 of the Agreement, the Exhibits shall be amended and updated from time to time and such amended and updated Exhibits shall be incorporated and become part of the Agreement. The original Exhibit C, Exhibit F and Exhibit G are hereby amended and replaced by the **Exhibit C** Antenna Equipment List, **Exhibit F** Computation of Maintenance Fee and **Exhibit G** Computation of Renewal and Replacement Fee attached to this Amendment, which are hereby incorporated into the Agreement.
- 3. <u>Reimbursement</u>. The County and City agree that City shall invoice and the County shall pay the amount owed as if County had been assessed the correct R&R cost noted above from the inception of this Agreement.
- 4. **<u>Defined Terms</u>**. Terms not specifically defined in this Amendment shall have the same meaning as given in the Agreement.
- 5. <u>Effect of Amendment</u>. Except to the extent the Agreement is modified by this Amendment, the terms and provisions of the Agreement shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the terms of the Agreement and the terms of this Amendment, the terms of this Amendment shall govern and prevail.
