I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- (A) A contract with Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. (Ranger) in the amount of \$452,773.50 and 150 Calendar Days for the Vehicle Service Road Relocation at Palm Beach International Airport (PBI); and
- (B) A Budget Transfer in the amount of \$452,774 in the Airport's Improvement and Development Fund, including a transfer from Reserves of \$452,774.

Summary: This project was advertised utilizing the County's competitive bid process. On May 13, 2021, two (2) bids were received for the Vehicle Service Road Relocation at PBI. Ranger, a Palm Beach County, Florida company has been identified as the lowest responsible/responsive bidder in the amount of \$452,773.50. This project consists of the relocation/realignment of the existing airfield service roadway at the approach end of Runway 28R at PBI. A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 23% was established for this project. Ranger has committed to meet the DBE goal of 23%. Pursuant to changes to Chapter 332, Florida Statutes, effective October 1, 2020, a governing body of a commercial service airport may not approve purchases of contractual services in excess of the Category Five threshold amount of \$325,000 provided in Section 287.017, Florida Statutes, on a consent agenda. This contract exceeds the threshold amount and must be approved on the regular agenda. **Countywide (AH)**

Background and Policy Issues: This project will provide for the design and construction of the realignment of the interior airfield service roadway serving the east side of PBI to remove it from inside the Runway Safety Area (RSA) and the Runway Object Free Area (ROFA) to meet Federal Aviation Administration standards. This roadway is utilized on a daily basis by Department of Airports' staff, Palm Beach Sheriff's Office (PBSO) personnel and other airport tenants and users to move efficiently between the north and south portions of the airfield. Builder's Risk Insurance is not required for this project.

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The prices named in the Bid are for the completed work, and include the furnishing of all materials and all labor, tools, and appliances and all expense, direct or indirect, connected with the proper execution of the work and of maintaining the same until it is accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

Time is of the essence. The Contractor shall commence the work to be performed under this Contract on the date set by the Owner in the written notice to proceed, continue the work with due diligence and shall complete the entire work per Attachment No. 2 to the Bid Form. Further, in the event interim milestone completion dates are established in Attachment No. 2 of the Bid Form for separable portions of the work, the Contractor agrees to complete said separable portions of the work in accordance with said milestone dates.

In case of failure on the part of the Contractor to complete the work within the time(s) specified in the Contract, or within such additional time(s) as may be granted by formal action of the Board of County Commissioners or fails to prosecute the work, or any separable part thereof, with such diligence as will insure its completion within the time(s) specified in the Contract or any extensions thereof, Owner will suffer damage, the amount of which is difficult, if not impossible to ascertain. Therefore, the Contractor shall pay to the Owner, as liquidated damages, the amounts indicated in the Milestone and Damages Data (Attachment #2 of the Bid Form) for each calendar day of delay that actual completion extends beyond the time limits specified in said Attachment until such reasonable time as may be required for final completion of work. In no way shall costs for liquidated damages be construed as a penalty on the Contractor.

Liquidated damages due to the Owner may be deducted from payments due to the Contractor, or may be collected from the Contractor or its surety or sureties. These provisions for liquidated damages shall not prevent the Owner, in case of the Contractor's default, from terminating the Contractor's right to proceed as provided in General Provision section 80-09 "Default and Termination of Contract".

As provided in F.S. 287.132-133, by entering into this contract or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the contractor certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Convicted Vendor List maintained by the State of Florida Department of Management Services within the 36 months immediately preceding the date hereof. This notice is required by F.S. 287.133 (3) (a).





AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM) has reviewed the submitted bids for the referenced project. The established deadline for submission of bids was on May 13, 2021. The Bid Opening was conducted on May 13, 2021 at 1:00 PM.

A total of two (2) bids were submitted for this Project to the Palm Beach County Department of Airports (DOA) from local contractors: Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. (Ranger), and Rio-Bak Corporation (Rio-Bak). The two contractor bids, along with the Engineer's Estimate, are presented in the table below:

Engineer's Estimate	\$384,370.00
Ranger Construction Industries, Inc.	\$452,773.50
Rio-Bak Corporation	\$537,700.00

AECOM's review indicated that both Ranger and Rio-Bak completed the Bid Form and all necessary attachments as required per the bid documents. These documents, among others, include: Addenda acknowledgement, Bid Form, Bid Price Form, Designation of Subcontractors, Bid Bond, DBE Schedules, Trench Safety Affidavit, Bidder Qualification Questionnaire, and the E-Verify Certification.

Ranger, the lowest bidder, and Rio-Bak each have previous experience working on projects for the DOA and each have provided a list of previous projects validating their qualifications, capabilities, and experience with their Bid. AECOM's review showed both Bids were calculated correctly on the Bid Price form and appear to be complete responsive bids.

Based on AECOM's evaluation of the qualifications and the bids submitted, it is our recommendation that the DOA award the PB 21-7, Vehicle Service Road Relocation Contract to the lowest responsible/responsive bidder, Ranger Construction Industries, Inc., contingent on the DOA's legal and DBE review of the bid documents.
