I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Authorization (WA) No. 5 to the Lift Station Rehabilitation Continuing Construction Contract 2020 (Continuing Contract) with Hinterland Group Inc. (Hinterland) for the Lift Station 8306 Improvements (Project) in the amount of \$438,231.33.

Summary: On September 15, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2020-1379) with Hinterland. WA No. 5 provides for the installation of 650 linear feet of 6-inch force main necessary to connect Lift Station (LS) 8306 to the existing force main pipe along NW 1st Avenue in South Bay. The Project also includes the installation of a fire hydrant and a water service, mechanical and electrical rehabilitation of the lift station. The Continuing Contract was procured under the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance. On January 15, 2020, the Goal Setting Committee applied an Affirmative Procurement Initiative (API) of a mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting participation, of which 3% shall be among certified African American and/or Hispanic American owned firms. The Continuing Contract provides for 26.87% SBE participation which includes 3.18% MBE participation, 3.18% MBE (H). WA No. 5 includes 20.33% SBE participation which includes 12.73% MBE participation, 12.73% MBE (H). The cumulative SBE participation including WA No. 5 is 7.71% which includes 2.99% MBE participation, 2.99% MBE (H). Hinterland is a Palm Beach County based Company. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY22 budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 20-007) District 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: LS 8306 is located in South Bay in the parking lot of the agricultural processing facility approximately 350 feet north of the Florida East Coast (FEC) railroad tracks and 540 feet west of NW 1st Avenue. LS 8306 currently discharges through a force main beneath the agricultural processing facility parking lot then under the FEC rail tracks and into a gravity manhole at the north end of NW 3rd Avenue. The capacity of the existing gravity system that LS 8306 discharges into is seasonally stressed when the waste wash water from agricultural use is pumped through the system.

New force main and lift station improvements will reduce the seasonal stress on the existing gravity system. A new fire hydrant will also be designed on the west side of the agricultural processing facility property north of the FEC railroad (on the east side of the U.S. 27/S.R. 80 road right-of-way). LS 8306 will also be rehabilitated with new pumps, a 1.5-inch water service, new valves, and concrete slab with a fence.



Location Map






