Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: receive and file proof of publication of the advertisement of the adopted Ordinance reflecting new commission districts legal boundaries as required by the Constitution of the United States, Constitution of the State of Florida, Florida Statutes and the Federal Voting Rights Act.							
Summary: On December 7, 2021 the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) adopted new commission boundaries based on the 2020 census. Florida Statute Chapter 124.02 requires a certified copy of the Ordinance approving revised commission districts, including their legal descriptions, be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in Palm Beach County. The required publications were advertised on December 17, 2021 and December 23, 2021. In addition, Florida Statute Chapter 124.03 requires the Clerk of Courts of Palm Beach County to submit to the Department of State a certified copy of the minutes of the Board acknowledging the required advertisement of the adopted Ordinance reflecting the description of new commission districts. Countywide (RPB)							
Background and Policy Issues: Chapter 124, Florida Statutes (FS) requires County Commissioners from time to time to amend the boundaries of Commission Districts to maintain them as nearly equal in proportion to population as possible, provided changes made in the boundary of Commission Districts, pursuant to Statute, shall be made only in odd-number years. On June 15, 2021 the BCC approved the following criteria to be applied when redrawing Commission Districts: 1) achieve population equity (10% or less variance among districts population) among Commission Districts; 2) adhere to Section 2 of the Voting Rights Acts of 1965, as amended and interpreted through case law; 3) follow major natural and man-made boundaries; 4) maintain integrity of Communities of interest, including municipal boundaries; 5) ensure compacted; 6) contiguity of Districts; and 7) preserve the core of existing voter's districts. On November 2, 2021 the BCC considered options that reflected reconfiguration of district boundaries based on 2020 census data. The BCC directed staff to bring back Scenario 8, with modifications, to be further considered at the November 23, 2021 hearing. On December 7, 2021, the BCC adopted the final redistricting map.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on December 7, 2021, during a public hearing session, the Board of County Commissioners approved the following new Commission District Boundaries (seven) as outlined in Ordinance No. 2021-036 and published as follows in its entirety along with legal descriptions of the seven commission districts. This notice is published pursuant to Section 124.02, F.S. PUBLISH THE ATTACHED CERTIFIED ORDINANCE 2021-036 AND LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS IN THEIR ENTIRETY.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 036

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA FIXING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SEVEN COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; PROVIDING FOR MINUTES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 1(e), of the Florida Constitution requires that, after each decennial census, the Board of County Commissioners shall apportion the existing districts accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 census has been completed and the population information has been tabulated; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, in accordance with the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of the State of Florida, applicable State Law, and the Federal Voter Rights Act, seeks to revise its seven commission districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA,

SECTION 1. District Boundaries

The boundaries of the seven county commission districts are hereby changed to conform to the legal descriptions attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2. Publication

that:

Pursuant to §124.02, Florida Statutes, a certified copy of this Ordinance, including an accurate description of the boundaries of the districts, shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in Palm Beach County, and proof of such publication shall be entered on the minutes of the Board.

SECTION 3. Minutes

Pursuant to §124.03, Florida Statutes, the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners shall forthwith furnish the Department of State a certified copy of the Minutes of the Board of County Commissioners meeting reflecting the description of the boundaries of the districts as set forth in this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Repeal of Laws in Conflict

All local laws and ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Severability

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held by a Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 6. Inclusion in the Code of Laws and Ordinances</u>

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Laws and Ordinances of Palm Beach County, Florida. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or any other appropriate word.

<u>SECTION 7. Effective Date</u>

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the Department of State.
