Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Grant Modification #1 from Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs to extend FY2018 Justice and Mental Health Collaboration Program grant award from December 31, 2021 through December 31, 2022 to increase public safety and officer safety by facilitating collaboration among the criminal justice, mental health, and substance abuse treatment systems.

I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A) Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office a Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs FY2018 Justice and Mental Health Collaboration Program grant award in the amount of \$750,000 for the period of January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021; **(B) Approve** a budget amendment of \$750,000 in the Sheriff's Grants Fund.

Summary: On September 26, 2018, the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) received a Federal grant award in the amount of \$750,000 to address school and community violence. Funding provided will be used for personnel costs, contractual services, supplies, travel/training, data collection and assessment tools, and community awareness. The PBSO will provide the 20% required match and overmatch in-kind contribution in the amount of \$212,086 through its approved operating budget. One PBSO position is created with this action. An increase in funding from the County may be requested through our annual budget process once the grant period ends. Countywide (LDC)
