

If the Project is not completed within the time period allotted, this Agreement will expire on the last day of the scheduled completion as provided in this paragraph unless an extension of the time period is requested by the AGENCY and granted in writing by DEPARTMENT prior to the expiration of the Agreement. Expiration of this Agreement will be considered termination of the Project. Only Project costs incurred on or after the Commencement Date of this Agreement and on or prior to the termination date of the Agreement are eligible.

Reason for this Supplemental and supporting engineering and/or cost analysis:

Palm Beach County Traffic Division has changed their standard for vehicle detection at mast arm signal installations. Due to ongoing maintenance issues with the video carmeras, Palm Beach County's Traffic Division has a new policy that was implemented requiring that new signals be constructed utilizing loop detection. Therefore, additional time is needed in order to complete the redesign of the signal plans.
