I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: a Resolution amending the application fee schedule for reviewing a Traffic Impact Study for compliance with Article 12 of the Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) and a Land Use Traffic Study for compliance with Policy 3.5(d) of the Land Use Element of the Comprehensive Plan.

SUMMARY: All Traffic Impact Study and Land Use Traffic Study review applications must be accompanied by the associated required fee. Fees are applied countywide, including municipalities. Since the Board of County Commissioners approved the original application fees on April 15, 2008 the fees have not changed, whereas, staff costs have increased. Adopting this Resolution will amend the application fees to account for current staff review costs, as well as establish a method to adjust the fees to automatically increase to match the increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) on October 1st of each year. Fees will increase 10% every year until after the 5th year, when fees will increase based on the CPI. On October 21, 2021 the Engineering Department sent notice of the proposed fee changes to the Palm Beach Chapter of the Florida Engineering Society (FES) and The Gold Coast Builders Association (GCBA). A meeting with the GCBA Executive Officer was held and addressed their comments. No feedback was received from FES. Countywide (YBH)

Background and Policy Issues: The existing fees only cover approximately 25% of the increased costs. The adjusted fees are expected to recover about 55% of the annual costs in the first year and 87% by year five. According to the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics, the CPI has increased 41% between November 2010 and November 2021. The revised fees are based on that CPI increase. The goal of the yearly CPI adjustment is to ensure that fees align with future cost changes.

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RESOLUTION NO. 2021-____

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING THE APPLICATION FEE SCHEDULE FOR REVIEWING A TRAFFIC IMPACT STUDY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH ARTICLE 12 OF THE UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE; AND REVIEWING A LAND USE TRAFFIC STUDY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH POLICY 3.5(d) OF THE LAND USE ELEMENT OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS, Article 12.D.1.A of the Palm Beach County (COUNTY) Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) provides that prior to acceptance of any application for a site specific development order in the unincorporated area, or issuance of a site specific development order in the incorporated area, a non-refundable application fee shall be paid in accordance with the fee schedule established by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC); and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2008 the BCC established application fees to offset Traffic Division (DIVISION) costs for reviewing Traffic Impact Studies for compliance with Article 12 of the ULDC, and Land Use Traffic Studies for compliance with Policy 3.5(d) of the Land Use Element of the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the application fee for the DIVISION to review and process Traffic Impact Studies is \$0.80 per net daily trip with a minimum fee of \$150; and

WHEREAS the application fee for the DIVISION to review and process Land Use Traffic Studies is \$0.40 per net daily trip with a minimum fee of \$75; and

WHEREAS, the DIVISION analyzed the current application fees and found that they cover approximately 25% of the costs incurred by the DIVISION, as shown in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the fee schedule for the next five (5) years and establish future increases, commencing October 1, 2027, based on increases to the Consumer Price Index (CPI), so that fees do not lag behind costs to the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and desirable that the application fees be amended, as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
- 2. The application fees for the DIVISION for reviewing Traffic Impact Studies and Land Use Traffic Studies are hereby amended, as shown in **Exhibit B**.
- 3. Commencing October 1, 2027, the application fees shall automatically increase by a percent equal to the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) from the previous COUNTY fiscal year (October 1 September 30). The Application Fee Rates shall be rounded to the nearest ten (10) cent increment and the Minimum

Application Fee shall be rounded to the nearest ten (10) dollar increment. The County Engineer shall amend the fee schedule to reflect the CPI increases, if any, by October 31.

- 4. Any amendment to the application fees, other than the amendment to reflect the automatic increase pursuant to the CPI, shall require a resolution by the BCC.
- 5. The application fees, as amended from time to time, shall be posted in the DIVISION. All applications shall be accompanied by the required fee. Any application not accompanied by payment of the required fee shall be deemed incomplete and shall not be processed. All fees shall be nonrefundable, and shall be payable to the BCC upon submission of the application.
- 6. All resolutions, administrative orders, or policies in conflict with this Resolution, are hereby repealed or shall be of no further force and effect.
- 7. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Resolution is for any reason held by the Courts to be unconstitutional, invalid, inapplicable, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Resolution.
- 8. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the BCC.
