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#### Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- (A) Amendment No. 9 to the Construction Manager (CM) at Risk Contract (Contract) with The Morganti Group, Inc. (MGI) for CM at Risk Services for Miscellaneous Airport Improvements for Palm Beach County Department of Airports (Department) in the amount of \$889,840 and 175 Calendar Days for Work Order SMC 12: West People Tube Repair at Palm Beach International Airport (PBI); and
- (B) A Budget Transfer of \$889,840 in the Airport's Improvement and Development Fund to provide budget for the project, including a transfer from Reserves in the amount of \$889,840.

Summary: The CM at Risk Contract with MGI was approved by the Board on August 20, 2019 (R-2019-1221). The Contract is for 2 years with 3 one (1) year renewal options for CM at Risk Services for Airport Improvements for the Department. MGI is a Danbury, Connecticut, based firm; however, the work will be directly managed by their southeast regional office in Palm Beach County. The County has exercised the first one-year renewal option. The contract value to date is \$7,348,832.71. Approval of Amendment No. 9 in the amount of \$889,840 and 175 Calendar Days will enable MGI to complete SMC 12: West People Tube Repair at PBI. This project includes repairs to the elevated pedestrian walkway between the long term parking garage and the terminal. The damage was caused by an operator of an oversized vehicle failing to heed the early warning signs for the maximum clearance height on the ground level south entrance lanes to the terminal. The vehicle struck the bottom of the walkway causing damage to the stucco façade, framing, fire sprinklers and electrical systems. The walkway was not being used at the time and was closed until it was determined that there was no structural damage. The project was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on March 2, 2021 and an Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (API's) of 12% SBE participation was applied. subcontractor SBE participation on this project is 86%. In addition, MGI's S/MBE teaming partner, Cooper, will provide 15% of the Construction Management Fees. Current cumulative subcontractor S/M/WBE participation for all work orders to-date under this contract including this amendment is 42%. Pursuant to changes to Chapter 332, Florida Statutes, effective October 1, 2020, a governing body of a commercial service airport may not approve purchases of contractual services in excess of the Category Five threshold amount of \$325,000 provided in Section 287.017, Florida Statutes, on a consent agenda. This amendment exceeds the threshold amount and must be approved on the regular agenda. Countywide (AH)

Background and Policy Issues: The PBI southern lanes at level one west entrance to the terminal have a maximum height of 13-ft due to the elevated pedestrian walkway connecting the long term parking garage to the terminal bridge structure to the second level entrance to the terminal. Multiple early warning signs of the height restriction are located in advance of the structure. On October 10, 2021 a semi-tractor trailer failed to heed the warnings and struck the underside of the pedestrian bridge damaging the framing, stucco façade, sprinklers and electrical system. The County will seek reimbursement from the responsible driver's insurance company.

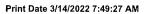

WHEREAS, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER represents that the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, Subcontractors, material and equipment suppliers have compared and reviewed all general and specific details on the Drawings and that all conflicts, discrepancies, errors and omissions, which are within the commonly accepted knowledge based of a licensed general contractor, subcontractor, trades persons, manufacturers or other parties required to carry out the Work involved in this Amendment, have been corrected or clarified prior to execution of this Amendment to the Contract, and therefore CONSTRUCTION MANAGER warrants that the GMP (exclusive of contingency) includes the cost of correcting all conflicts, discrepancies, errors, or omissions which CONSTRUCTION MANAGER identifies, or should have identified through the exercise of reasonable skill and care, during the pre-construction phase of this Contract; and

WHEREAS, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER's review and comparison of all Drawings has taken into consideration the total and complete functioning of all systems and therefore the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER represents that the GMP represents the total cost for complete and functional systems including Pre-Construction Services.

NOW THEREFORE, in considerations of the mutual covenants herein contained, and such other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which the parties hereby acknowledge, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

#### (1) GUARANTEED MAXIMUM PRICE

Pursuant to Article 2.2 and Article 6 of the Contract between Owner and CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, the parties have agreed to the establishment of a Guaranteed Maximum Price of \$889,840.00 for the construction costs for Work Order SMC 12: West People Tube Repair at Palm Beach International Airport.
