## I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A)** Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, Contract Award Modification Notice 6 with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Transportation Security Administration (TSA), to provide \$178,796 in supplemental funding and to extend the contract agreement through December 31, 2022; and **(B)** Approve a budget amendment of \$178,796 in the Sheriff's Grants Fund.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) accepted this grant for \$126,249 on August 25, 2020 (R-2020-1179) to fund five (5) Canine Teams at the Palm Beach International Airport (PBIA) through TSA's National Explosives Detection Canine Team Program (NEDCTP) for the contract period July 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. The BOCC approved contract modification #1 on March 9, 2021 (R-2021-0377) which provided \$21,042 in additional funding and extended the contract period through January 31, 2021. The BOCC approved contract modification #2 on April 6, 2021 (R-2021-0457) which provided \$21,042 in additional funding and extended the contract period through February 28, 2021. The BOCC approved contract modification #3 on May 18, 2021 (R-2021-0720) which provided \$210,416 in additional funding and extended the contract period through December 31, 2021. The BOCC approved contract modification #4 and #5 on March 22, 2022 which provided \$73,704 in additional funding and extended the contract period through March 31, 2022 (R-2022-0251 & R-2022-0252). This contract modification will provide \$178,796 in additional funding and extend the contract period through December 31, 2022. The purpose of the TSA NEDCTP Program is to provide enhanced security at the Palm Beach International Airport, to promptly respond to threats and suspected explosive devices which affect air carrier operations. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. The contract number is 70T02020T9NNCP464. There is no match requirement associated with this award. Countywide (LDC)

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A) Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, Contract Award Modification Notice 4 and 5 with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Transportation Security Administration (TSA), to provide \$73,704 in supplemental funding and to extend the contract agreement through March 31, 2022; and (B) Approve a budget amendment of \$73,704 in the Sheriff's Grants Fund.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) accepted this grant for \$126,249 on August 25, 2020 (R-2020-1179) to fund five (5) Canine Teams at the Palm Beach International Airport (PBIA) through TSA's National Explosives Detection Canine Team Program (NEDCTP) for the contract period July 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. The BOCC approved Contract Modification #1 on March 9, 2021 (R-2021-0377) which provided \$21,042 in additional funding to offset the costs of the five Canine Teams at PBIA and extended the contract period through January 31, 2021. The BOCC approved Contract Modification #2 on April 6, 2021 (R-2021-0457) which provided \$21,042 in additional funding to offset the costs of the five Canine Teams at PBIA and extended the contract period through February 28, 2021. The BOCC approved Contract Modification #3 on May 18, 2021 (R-2021-0720) which provided \$210,416 in additional funding from March 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021. This Contract Modification #4 and #5 will provide \$73,704 in additional funding and extend the contract period through March 31, 2022. The purpose of the TSA NEDCTP Program is to provide enhanced security at the Palm Beach International Airport, to promptly respond to threats and suspected explosive devices which affect air carrier operations. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. The contract number is 70T02020T9NNCP464. There is no match requirement associated with this award. Countywide (LDC)

Background and Justification: The U.S. Department of Homeland Security Transportation Security Administration awards grants for the purpose of providing Homeland Security Enforcement programs. The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office is responsible for the overall safety and security of the Palm Beach International Airport. The Palm Beach International Airport could be victim to a terrorist attack and therefore every reasonable measure PBSO can take to ensure the safety of the citizens of Palm Beach County and travelers who utilize this airport is necessary.
