### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 6 to the Contract for Consulting/Professional Services Emergency and Disaster Mitigation and Recovery (Contract) with Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc., (CGA) for the Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Nos. 2 and 9 Hurricane Hardening (Project) for a not to exceed amount of \$253,685.00.

**Summary:** On June 20, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2017-0821) with CGA. CSA No. 6 provides for consulting/professional engineering services and related services for hurricane hardening evaluation and recommendations at WTP Nos. 2 and 9.

This Contract was procured under the requirements of the 2002 Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance (R2002-0064) prior to the adoption of the new Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance on October 16, 2018. The SBE participation goal established under the 2002 Ordinance was 15% overall participation. The Contract provides for 41% SBE participation. CSA No. 6 includes 57.51% SBE participation which includes 57.51% MBE participation, 57.51% (A). The cumulative SBE participation including CSA No. 6 is 54.59%, which includes 54.59% MBE participation, 54.59% MBE (A). CGA is headquartered in Fort Lauderdale, Florida and maintains an office in Palm Beach County from which the majority of the work under CSA No. 6 will be undertaken. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY22 budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 22-024) Districts 3 and 5 (MWJ)

**Background and Justification:** PBCWUD owns, operates, and maintains five (5) water treatment plants, including WTP Nos. 2 and 9. The purpose of this Project is to evaluate the facilities at WTP Nos. 2 and 9 against the latest edition of the Florida Building Code wind loading criteria. The Project will also provide recommendations and prepare a planning level cost estimate for facilities in need of hurricane hardening. Implementation of the hurricane hardening recommendations will improve life safety of PBCWUD personnel and reliability of production and distribution of potable water during hurricane events.

### SCOPE OF SERVICES

### PBCWUD Project No.: 22-024

Project Title: Water Treatment Plant Nos. 2 and 9 Hurricane Hardening

Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. (CONSULTANT), shall perform:

### Scope of Services

### Background

The Water Treatment Plants (WTP) Nos. 2 and 9 are water treatment facilities owned and operated by Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD). Improvements to the Florida Building Code (FBC), particularly with respect to wind loading, have been made. PBCWUD has requested CONSULTANT to provide a structural evaluation of a total of five (5) selected structures at the WTP Nos. 2 and 9. Although WTP No. 2 consists of seven (7) structures and WTP No. 9 consists of seven (7) structures, this scope of work is limited to a total of five (5) initial structures that are considered to have the highest priority uses. The aim of the evaluation is to determine whether the selected buildings comply with current wind load criteria, as set forth in the latest version of the FBC. If the structures are found to be deficient, remedial work will be recommended to bring the structures into compliance. CONSULTANT will prepare a Technical Memorandum (TM) including the results, findings, and recommended remedial works resulting from the evaluation.

### **Project Scope**

The evaluation will include the following major tasks:

- 1. Research designed/permitted information available on the existing buildings at WTP Nos. 2 and 9, as listed below. The research of the available information assumes that the PBCWUD will provide all the required documentation, including record drawings. specifications, calculations, and Building Department permits. Perform threedimensional (3D) scanning of all the buildings/structures to document the conditions of the exterior envelope.
  - a. WTP No. 2
    - 1. Administration Building
    - 2. High Service Pump Building
    - 3. Clearwell Well Filter Building
    - 4. Miex Building
    - 5. Generator Building
    - 6. Hypochlorite Building
    - 7. Miex Facility
  - b. WTP No. 9
    - 1. Membrane Building

    - Chemical Tanks Area
       Degasifier Building
    - 4. Clearwell Control Building

- 5. Chlorine Building
- 6. Wastewater Pump Station (WWPS)
- 7. Maintenance Building
- 2. Visual condition assessment of the existing exterior envelope of the five (5) selected buildings, which are:
  - a. WTP No. 2
    - 1. Administration Building
    - 2. Clearwell Well Filter Building
  - b. WTP No. 9
    - 1. Membrane Building
    - 2. Clearwell Control Building
    - 3. Chlorine Building (Partial Evaluation)

Evaluation of the existing structural exterior components using the current live, dead, and wind load criteria as detailed in the FBC, for the selected aforementioned buildings.

- 3. As required, perform nondestructive tests on the exterior envelope of the selected buildings to identify the presence of masonry grout columns and steel reinforcing.
- 4. Identify and provide recommendations of the areas that may require improvements to comply with current live, dead, and wind load criteria in accordance with the FBC. Provide planning level cost estimates with technical descriptions and sketches of each area of the selected aforementioned buildings that will require remedial work.

The Scope of Professional Services to be provided and associated fees are detailed herein. CONSULTANT shall execute Professional Services Agreements (PSAs) with Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. (LYE) and RADISE International, L.C. (RADISE) to assist with the structural evaluation of the exterior envelope of the buildings. CONSULTANT understands that time is of the essence, and, shall make every effort to perform this work in an expeditious manner, whenever possible. The specific work to be completed under each task is detailed below.

### Task 1 - Due Diligence

CONSULTANT shall perform due diligence to obtain the required information to complete the evaluation. These services shall include:

- 1.1. Data Collection Review site pictures, record drawings, permits, copies of any emergency repair work, and other relevant PBCWUD records. The research of the available information assumes that PBCWUD will provide all the required documentation, including record drawings, specifications, calculations, and Building Department permits.
- 1.2. Site Visits Conduct a visual structural condition assessment of the exterior of the five (5) selected buildings at WTP Nos. 2 and 9. This assessment shall identify structural defects such as corrosion, fatigue, or structural damage by accidental actions.
- 1.3. Review Record Drawings Review the record drawings of the five (5) selected buildings. Identify the critical structure members based on the building elevation and plan view drawings of the Administration Building, Clearwell Filter Building, Membrane Building, and Clearwell Control Building. Evaluate and analyze the exterior envelope of each building structure for lateral wind load requirements per American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) 7-15 latest edition and 186 MPH set by the PBCWUD.

Evaluate and analyze the existing roll up doors of the Chlorine Building at WTP 9 for wind load requirements per American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) 7-15 latest edition and 186 MPH set by the PBCWUD, shown above as partial evaluation.

- 1.4. Survey Utilize a Leica C10 High Resolution 3D scanner to obtain as-built information for all seven (7) structures/buildings at WTP No. 2 and seven (7) structures/buildings at WTP No. 9. Compile multiple scans around the perimeter of each structure with sufficient overlap for data processing and quality control with redundancy. Process individual data point clouds through 3D scanner software to create a spatially precise as-built of each structure and export into an AutoCAD drawing file structure.
- 1.5. Structural Investigation Based on the visual assessment (Subtask 1.2) and detailed evaluation and analysis (Subtask 1.3), determine if nondestructive testing will be needed. If so, CONSULTANT will indicate the location, type, and the number of tests required prior to commencement of such field testing.
- 1.6. Prepare Summary of Findings Prepare a presentation with the findings of the Due Diligence task, including recommendations of structural elements that require nondestructive testing.
- 1.7. Meeting with PBCWUD Meeting with PBCWUD to discuss the findings of the Due Diligence task. After presenting the due diligence findings and detailed evaluation, CONSULTANT will discuss with PBCWUD how to proceed with the field work evaluation and technical memorandum. Prepare for and attend one (1) meeting with PBCWUD staff to discuss the findings of the Due Diligence task.

### Deliverables

- Presentation with approach, findings, and recommendations
- Meeting Agendas and Minutes

### Task 2 - Field Evaluation

CONSULTANT shall conduct an assessment to evaluate the current condition and compliance with the current live, dead, and wind load criteria. These services shall include:

- 2.1. Field Coordination Coordinate and participate in the necessary site visits with subconsultants and PBCWUD.
- 2.2. Nondestructive Test If necessary, performance of nondestructive testing on the designated structural elements of the five (5) selected buildings as indicated by the Structural Engineer. The type of test will be determined by the Structural Engineer.
- 2.3. Structural Field Evaluation Based on the previously performed evaluations, CONSULTANT will determine if the results of the tested areas conform to the live, dead, and wind load criteria.
- 2.4. Prepare Summary of Findings Prepare a presentation with the findings and results of the Field Evaluation task. A total of one (1) meeting is assumed for this task.
- 2.5. Meeting with PBCWUD Prepare for and attend one (1) meeting with PBCWUD staff to discuss the findings and results of the Field Evaluation task.

### Task 3 - Preparation of Technical Memorandum

CONSULTANT shall prepare a TM providing a compilation of the findings and preliminary recommendations of the structures to be improved to withstand current wind load requirements.

The TM will also provide a preliminary cost estimate (Class 5, 0-2% project definition) for the proposed preliminary recommendations. The services under this task will include the following:

- 3.1. Compile All Data/Investigation Results Compile all data related to the results of the investigation performed.
- 3.2. Prepare TM Prepare a TM to include the assessment findings of the seven (7) buildings/structures at WTP 2 and seven (7) buildings/structures at WTP 9 and preliminary recommendations related to improving the existing selected five (5) buildings, and associated preliminary cost estimate. A total of one (1) meeting is assumed for this task.
- 3.3. Meeting with PBCWUD Coordinate and participate in the discussion meeting with PBCWUD to discuss the TM.

### **CONSULTANT Assumptions:**

The following assumptions were the basis for the preparation of this proposal:

- The scope of work considers only the structural evaluation of the Administration Building and Clearwell Well Filter Building at WTP 2 and the Membrane Building and Clearwell Control Building at WTP No. 9. Also includes the evaluation of the existing roll up doors Chlorine Building at WTP 9. It does not include wind load analysis or flying debris mitigation of the screens located at the Clearwell Filter Building at WTP No. 2.
- Topographical survey, geotechnical investigation nor detailed design are included in CONSULTANT's tasks.
- The number of nondestructive tests will be determined by the Structural Engineer after completing the initial evaluation of the five (5) selected buildings.
- The research of the available information assumes that PBCWUD will provide all the required documentation, including record drawings, specifications, calculations, and Building Department permits.

RADISE will perform Infrared Thermography testing on the exterior building envelopes of each of the structures to identify the presence of grout column infill and the respective spacing of the grout columns.

The Infrared Thermography and subsequent Structure Scan Equipment will be used to locate the grout infill within the cells of the masonry walls and determine the presence of steel reinforcement within the grout columns. It is anticipated that scanning for structural reinforcing will be performed at multiple locations on each wall of the building envelopes, and select locations provided by the structural engineer.

Should it be determined that the surveys for the higher/multi-level structures will need to be performed using support equipment to elevate the work staff, additional costs for rental of the scissor lift equipment and time to perform the survey will be incurred.

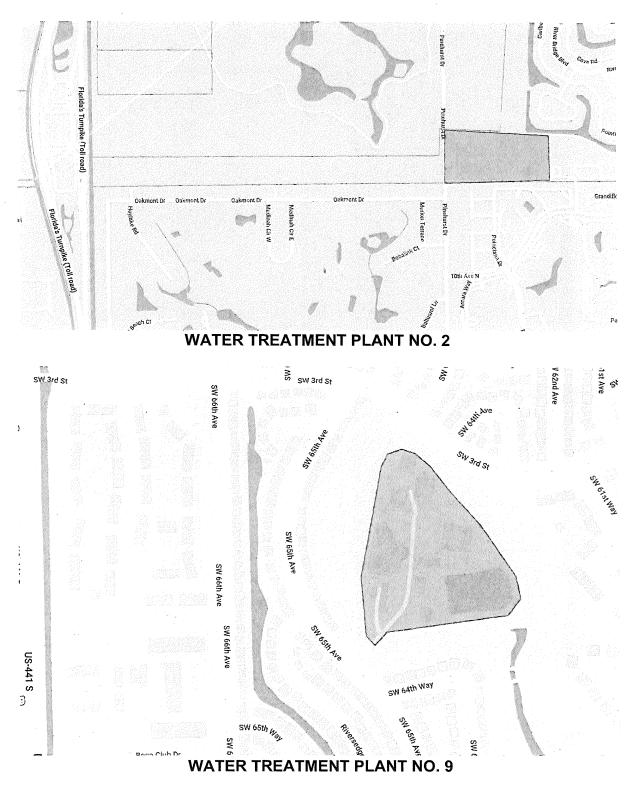

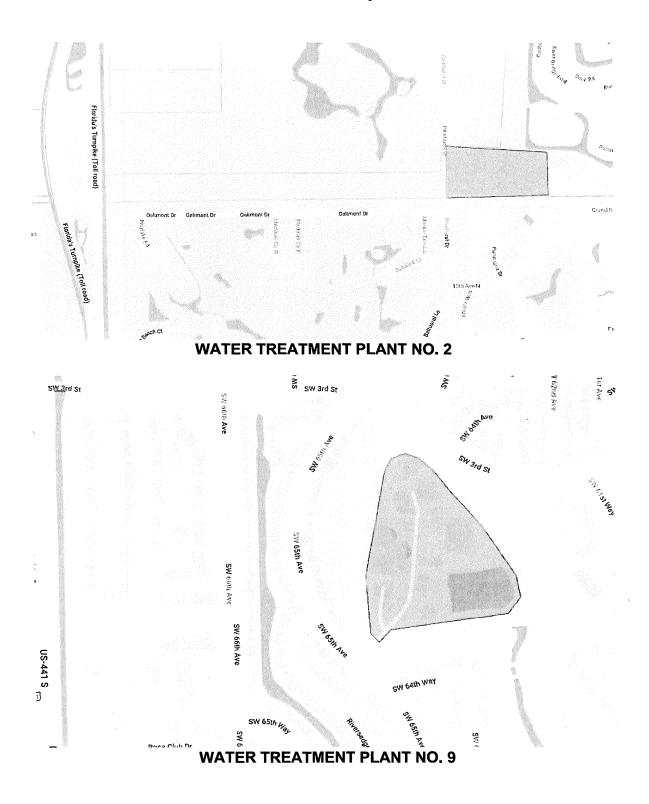
