SUMMARY: Approval of this contract will authorize the construction services necessary for the replacement of four culvert outfalls servicing Gun Club Road and Gun Club Estates. Both Gun Club Road and the roadways within Gun Club Estates are maintained by Palm Beach County. The Affirmative Procurement Initiative selected for this contract on December 15, 2021 by the Goal Setting Committee is a 5% minimum mandatory Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation. JDI agreed to 6.45% SBE participation. Bids for the contract were received by the Engineering & Public Works Department (Department) on February 15, 2022. JDI was the lowest responsive bidder of two bidders. The contract time for the Project is 120 calendar days. JDI has an office located in Palm Beach County. This Project is included in the Five-Year Road Program. District 3 (YBH)

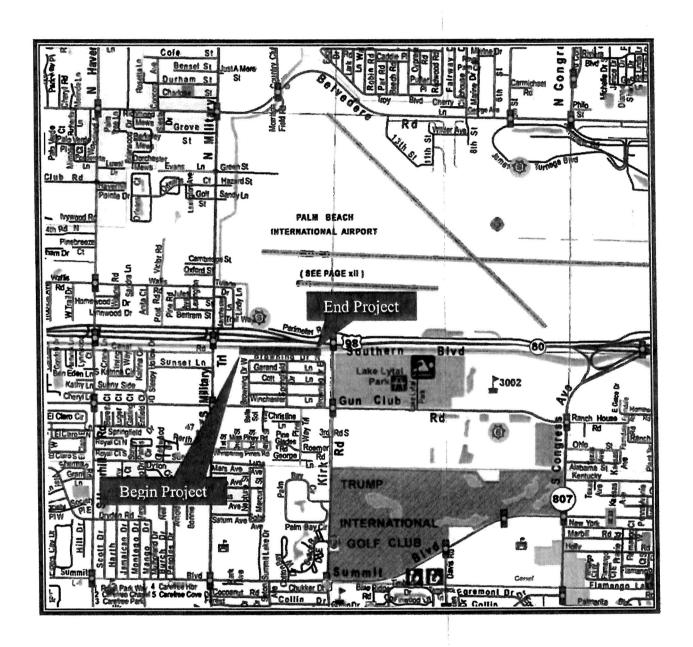
# PROJECT LOCATION
