I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Order 2021050-19 in the amount of \$725,000 to mill and resurface Ellison Wilson Road from McLaren Road to Donald Ross Road utilizing Palm Beach County's (County) annual asphalt milling and resurfacing contract R2021-0984 (Contract) with Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. (Ranger).

SUMMARY: Per County PPM CW-F-050, this work order exceeds the \$200,000 threshold for staff approvals of work orders to annual contracts, thus requiring approval from the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). Approval of this work order will allow the contractual services necessary to construct the improvements. Prior to this meeting date, approximately \$9 million of Ranger's \$50 million Contract that was approved on August 17, 2021, by the BCC, has been spent or encumbered. This Contract is one of three contracts with an available cumulative total of \$50 million for the annual asphalt milling and resurfacing program. The Affirmative Procurement Initiative selected for this Contract on September 16, 2020 by the Goal Setting Committee is a 15% minimum mandatory Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation. Ranger agreed to 15% SBE participation for the contract and 15.24% SBE participation for this work order. Their cumulative SBE participation, including this work order is 15%. District 1 (YBH)

Background and Justification: The County intends to construct the improvements in accordance with the attached work order. The budget for the improvements includes striping and marking costs of \$70,000 bringing the total fiscal impact to \$795,000.




