# Second Amendment to Contract for Consulting/Professional Services

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT is dated this \_\_\_day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2022, by and between Palm Beach County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "County" and The Lord's Place, Inc., (hereinafter "TLP") whose FEIN ID is 59-2240502.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on October 01, 2020 the County, through its Criminal Justice Commission, and TLP entered into a Contract (R2021-0072) for a total contract price not to exceed \$272,350.00; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2021 the County, through its Criminal Justice Commission, and TLP entered into a First Amendment to the Contract (R2921-1940) which extended the Contract through December 31, 2021 without amending the total contract price; and

WHEREAS, TLP's responsibility under this Contract is to provide housing and case management services for the Palm Beach County Frequent Users Systems Engagement (PalmFUSE) pilot program, as more specifically set forth in the "Scope of Work" attached as Exhibit "A" to the Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the amounts of the budget line items require adjustment as set forth in Exhibit "C-1" to this amendment.,

**NOW THEREFORE**, the above named parties hereby mutually agree to amend the Contract and enter into this Second Amendment as follows:

- I. Exhibit "C" of the Contract is hereby amended by adding the attached Exhibit "C-1" which reallocates budget line item funding.
- II. There is no adjustment to the total Contract price of \$272,350.00.
- III. All other provisions of the Contract and First Amendment not in conflict with this Second Amendment remain in effect, are ratified, and are to be performed at the same level as specified in the Contract.
