I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Order No. 22-006 to the annual electrical contract with Protect Video, Inc. (Contractor) (R2019-1756) for Palm Beach Sheriff's Office (PBSO) District 4 – New Generator Installation project in the amount of \$298,148 for a period of 240 calendar days from permit issuance.

Summary: On November 19, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the annual electrical contract with the Contractor to provide electrical services associated with repairs, improvements and renovations to County properties. Work Order No. 22-006 authorizes the installation of a new generator and automatic transfer switch at the PBSO District 4 facility. This facility is a critical facility that operates 24/7 and the emergency generator is required in order to maintain operations during electrical outages. This project was competitively advertised, and new contractors were invited to bid on the project by submitting prequalification documents prior to the submission of the bid response. The Contractor will have 240 calendar days from permit issuance to substantially complete the project. Liquidated damages for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved time extension thereof are \$193 per day. On June 5, 2019, the Goal Setting Committee applied the following Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (API) for this annual contract: 1) Sheltered market for projects less than \$100,000, when three (3) or more Small Business Enterprises (SBE) are qualified; or 2) 10% SBE Price Preference for projects \$100,000 or more. Since this project is over \$100,000, the applicable API is 10% SBE price preference. The Contractor is an SBE and committed to 100% SBE participation on this work order. The cumulative SBE participation on the annual electrical contract is 76.55%. The Contractor is a local business. Funding for this project is from the Planned Unit Development (PUD) Civic Site Cash Out fund. (Capital Improvements Division) <u>District 5</u> (MWJ)

Background and Justification: This project was openly, competitively advertised and procured. Bids for this project were opened on May 12, 2022. Protect Video, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid.



WHEREAS, the Owner and Contractor acknowledge and agree that the Contract between Owner and Contractor dated 11/19/19 (R2019-1756) ("Contract") is in full force and effect and that this Work Order incorporates all the terms and conditions of the Contract and the IFB/Q for this project, as may be supplemented and amended by this Work Order;

NOW THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein and the sums of money agreed to be paid by the Owner to the Contractor, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- **2. Total Bid Amount.** Pursuant to Section 6.3 of the Instructions to Bidders of the Annual Contract for Electrical between Owner and Contractor, the Contractor was the lowest, responsive, responsible Bidder in the amount of \$298,148.00 for the construction costs of providing and installing a new generator and transfer switch as set forth on the **Bid Form** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- **3. Schedule of Time for Completion.** The time of completion for this Work Order will be as follows: The Contractor shall substantially complete the project within **240** calendar days of permit issuance. Liquidated Damages are \$193/day for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved extension thereof.
- **4. APIs.** The APIs applicable to this Contract are attached hereto.
- **5. EBO Participation to Date.** To date Contractor has achieved 84.39% SBE subcontracting participation on this Contract. Contractor will provide 100% on this Work Order.

7. <u>Annual Contract Modifications and Additions.</u> The following provisions of the Annual Contract are modified as follows:

Section 5.2 of the "Instructions to Bidders" of the Contract is modified to include the following new section:

5.2.5 Failure to Provide the Required Documents after Notification of Award. If after Notification of award from the County, the successful Bidder does not provide within 14 Days of Notification the signed Work Order, the Public Construction Bond and Guarantee (when required), and the required certificates of insurance, the County may: 1. Terminate this Annual Contract for cause; 4. Pursue any and all remedies available against the Bidder for damages resulting from its failure to enter into a Work Order and provide all required documents within 14 Days after notification.

- 83.3 Owner shall terminate this Contract if it has a good faith belief that Contractor has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.
 - **83.3.1** If Owner has a good faith belief that Contractor's subcontractor has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended, Owner shall notify Contractor to terminate its contract with the subcontractor and Contractor shall immediately terminate its contract with the subcontractor.
- 83.4 If Owner terminates this Contract pursuant to the above, Contractor shall be barred from being awarded a future contract by Owner for a period of one (1) year from the date on which this Contract was terminated. In the event of such contract termination, Contractor shall also be liable for any additional costs incurred by Owner as a result of the termination.
- **8.** Except as modified herein, the Contract remains in full force and effect. All capitalized terms herein shall have the same meaning as set forth in the Contract.
