### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: staff recommends motion to adopt: Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, adopting the FY 2022/2023 budget for the Air Pollution Control Program.

Summary: This Resolution is required by the August 21, 1984, Agreement with the Department of Health Palm Beach County (DOHPBC) to establish the annual budget for the expenditure of fees deposited into the Air Pollution Control Trust Fund. This Program is solely supported by motor vehicle license registration fees. The proposed FY 2022/2023 budget for the Air Pollution Control Program from this funding source is \$994,345, which is a 3.41% increase from the current year budget. This budget can be accommodated by future revenues and a surplus in the Air Pollution Control Trust Fund. Countywide (HH)

Background and Justification: In 1983, the State Legislature enacted Section 320.03(6), Florida Statutes, which provided for an additional fifty cent (50¢) motor vehicle license registration fee for the control of air pollution in the State. If this fee is collected in counties with approved air pollution control programs, such as the existing Health Department Program, then it is returned to a trust fund established by the County. This Statute also requires that these funds be used only for air pollution control purposes. Therefore, the County entered into an agreement with the DOHPBC authorizing the Health Department Air Pollution Control Program to act on behalf of Palm Beach County, and to establish an Air Pollution Control Trust Fund to support such a program. The Resolution, No. R-84-1196, was adopted on August 21, 1984 (Attachment 4) and was amended on September 15, 2020 via resolution R-2020-1385 (Attachment 5).

The 1990 State Legislature amended Section 320.03(6), Florida Statutes, to increase the registration fee to One Dollar (\$1.00) for support of air pollution control activities. (Continued on page 3)

# **Background And Justification (Continued):**

**Background And Justification:** Section 320.03(6), Florida Statutes, was further amended to provide that an approved local air pollution control program is eligible to receive an additional twenty-five cents (25¢) from the fee for a total of seventy-five cents (75¢), provided the local air pollution control trust fund has an unencumbered balance not exceeding 50% of the previous year's revenue allocation. It is estimated that the unencumbered balance at the end of the current fiscal year will be more than 50% of the annual revenue thus making the County eligible to receiving funding at the 50¢ level. It is also estimated that annual tag fee revenues collected during FFY 2022/2023 will provide sufficient funds for this budget.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA APPROVING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE PALM BEACH COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ESTABLISH THE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL TRUST FUND PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE 320.03(6)

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County recognizes the need for the control of air pollution; and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County currently has in effect an Environmental Control Ordianance, Ordinance No. 78-5, as amended, which provides for the adoption by reference of all State Air Pollution rules; and

WHEREAS, the Air Pollution Control Program in the Health Department is an approved and certified program in accordance with S.403.182, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 320.03(6) authorizes the establishment of a local Air Pollution Control Trust Fund with the monies deposited in said fund to be used only for Air Pollution Control programs relating to the control of emissions from mobile source: and toxic and odor emissions, air quality monitoring, and facilitinspections pursuant to Florida Statute 320.03(6) or the Palm Beach County Environmental Control Ordinance.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to enter into a contractual agreement to delineate their responsibilities and obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COM-MISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

The above statements are hereby affirmed and the Palm Beach County Health Department Air Pollution Control Program is authorized to act as the local Air Pollution Control Program on behalf of Palm Beach County, and the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to accept and transfer funds from the Department of Environmental Regulation Air Pollution Control Trust Fund to a County Air Pollution Control Trust Fund for the support of such a program in accordance with Florida Statute 320.03(6).

Be it further resolved that the agreement between Palm Beach County and the Palm Beach County Health Department, a cop of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is approved and the Chairman and Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners are hereby authorized to execute said contract on behalf of Pal Beach County.

AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE PALM BEACH COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR THE CONTROL OF AIR POLLUTION

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into at West Palm Beach, Florida, on this 21st day of August 1984, by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Flor: hereinafter referred to as "County", and the PALM BEACH COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, a Health Unit of the State Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services, hereinafter referred to as "Health Department".

WHEREAS, the County desires to establish an Air Pollution Control Program; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department Air Pollution Control Progrits an approved program in accordance with 8.403.182, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 320.03(6) authorizes the establishment of a local Air Pollution Control Trust Fund with the monies deposited in said fund to be used only for Air Pollution Control programs, relating to the control of emissions from mobile source and toxic and odor emissions, air quality monitoring, and facil inspections pursuant to Florida Statute 320.03(6) or the Palm Beach County Environmental Control.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual premises and undertakings contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The County will adopt the existing Health Department
  Air Pollution Control Program as the approved local Air Polluti
  Control Program specified in Florida Statute 320.03(6)
- 2. The Health Department will administer said local program in accordance with the mandates set forth in Florida Statu 320.03(6); Florida Statute 403; and the Palm Beach County Envir mental Control Ordinance.
- 3. The County shall establish a local Air Pollution Contr Trust Fund in accordance with Florida Statute 320.03(6).
- 4. The County shall disburse monies from said Trust Fund to the Health Department, and the Health Department will utiliz and account for said funds, in accordance with the provisions o

Plorida Statute 320.03(6), Florida Administrative Code Chapter 17-2.820, and generally accepted accounting procedures and principles Exhibit 1 is attached hereto as a summary example of the accounting procedure to be utilized.

- The Health Department will submit semi-annual written reports to the County setting forth the goals, objectives and accomplishments of the Local Air Pollution Control Program.
- The Health Department shall submit a proposed budget to the County on an annual basis, the first of which is attached hereto as Exhibt 2 and made a part hereof.
- This agreement shall become effective on the date last signed by the parties below.
- This agreement may be terminated by either party upon 30 days written notice given by either party to the other prior to the proposed date of termination.
- 9. Realth Department shall indemnify and hold harmless County from liability of any kind, including cost expenses for or on account of any suits, actual or threatened, or damages arising out of acts of its employees or program participants during the period of this agreement.

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT is made as of the \_\_\_\_\_\_day of \_\_\_\_\_2020, by and between Palm Beach County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY, and the State of Florida Department of Health, Palm Beach County, hereinafter referred to a DOH, collectively referred to as the Parties.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on August 21, 1984, the Parties entered into An Agreement for the Control of Air Pollution wherein the COUNTY and DOH agreed that DOH would administer the COUNTY's local Air Pollution Control Program specified in Section 320.03(6), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the agreement to conform the language of the indemnification provision in that agreement to current language.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree that the Contract is amended as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. PARAGRAPH 9 is hereby replaced in its entirety with the following:
  - 9. Each party shall be liable for its own actions and negligence and, to the extent permitted by law, COUNTY shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless DOH against any actions, claims or damages arising out of COUNTY'S negligence in connection with this Agreement, and DOH shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless COUNTY against any actions, claims, or damages arising out of DOH'S negligence in connection with this Agreement. The foregoing indemnification shall not constitute a waiver of sovereign immunity beyond the limits set forth in Florida Statutes, Section 768.28, nor shall the same be construed to constitute agreement by either party to indemnify the other party for such other party's negligent, willful or intentional acts or omissions.
