### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A) Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office a Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, FY2018 Innovations in Community-Based Crime Reduction Program grant award in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2021; (B) Approve a budget amendment of \$1,000,000 in the Sheriff's Grants Fund.

**Summary:** On October 1, 2018, the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) received a Federal grant award in the amount of \$1,000,000 to address the disproportionate rate of violent crimes and related crime drivers in the South End community of the City of Lake Worth. Funding provided will be used for personnel costs, contractual services, supplies, equipment, travel/training, community outreach, supplies, and community awareness. There is no match requirement associated with this award. Two PBSO positions are created with this action. An increase in funding from the County may be requested through our annual budget process once the grant ends. <u>Countywide (LDC)</u>
