I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve Contract No. 2022ERM01 (Contract) with B&B Underground Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$397,600 providing construction services for a Casing Under A1A at Ocean Inlet Park, (Project) for a term beginning upon execution and expiring within 90 days from the Notice to Proceed.

Summary: The Contract will provide for the installation of a 115-foot long, 30-inch diameter steel casing under State Road A1A for future use as a dredge pipeline corridor during inlet management dredging activities at the South Lake Worth Inlet. The proposed steel casing will align with a largely unused south section of Ocean Inlet Park and provide a safer and more cost efficient method of routing discharge pipe through Ocean Inlet Park.


Two sealed bids were received by the Department of Environmental Resources Management (ERM) on July 11, 2022. B&B Underground Construction, Inc., a West Palm Beach, Florida company, was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. State regulations prohibit local geographical preferences in construction procurements involving state funds, so the County's Office of Equal Business Opportunity Program, Local Preference, Glades Local Preference, Glades Resident Incentive, and Apprentice Incentive could not be included in this competitive solicitation.

The Project is funded by the combination of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Agreement No. 20PB11 (R2019-1540) providing \$106,500.00 and the Beach Improvement Fund providing \$291,100. District 4 (YBH)

Background and Justification: The County is responsible for managing South Lake Worth Inlet and bypassing beach compatible sediments to adjacent beaches in accordance with FDEP's adopted inlet management plan. In doing so, the County periodically conducts maintenance dredging in and around the inlet. During prior dredging events, the dredge pipeline was routed along the public beach and through heavily used sections of Ocean Inlet Park causing public access and safety conflicts.
