Summary: Per Resolution R2018-0188, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) established the Commission on Women Advisory Board (ACW). The ACW is comprised of fifteen (15) members, two (2) appointed by each County Commissioner and one (1) at-large appointed by majority vote of the BCC. The Board may also appoint a youth representative (15-18 years of age) to serve as an exofficio member. The ACW serves as an advisory body to focus on matters pertaining specifically to women. Harriet Lerman and Rachelle Litt have expressed an interest in appointment. There is one vacancy. Fourteen (14) seats and one ex-officio seat are currently filled. The current diversity count is Caucasian: 6 (40%), African-American: 4 (27%), Hispanic: 4 (27%) and Unknown: 1 (7%). The gender ratio (female: male) is 15:0. These nominees are Caucasian females. Countywide (JW)

**Background and Justification:** The BCC adopted Resolution R2018-0188 establishing the ACW as an advisory body to focus on matters pertaining specifically to women. The Resolution requires that the appointees should be a Palm Beach County resident and reflect, to the greatest extent possible, the demographic and geographic diversity in the County. Pursuant to the PPM regarding board appointments, staff requested the Mayor and members of the BCC submit nominees to fill this At-Large vacancy. The ACW meets at least quarterly.



Tinuade ("Tinu") Peña was an at-large appointee to the ACW. She was automatically removed from the ACW due to attendance requirements. We received applications from *Harriet Lerman* and *Rachelle Litt* for consideration for this Board. Their completed applications and background information is attached. Some of you may have already nominated Ms. Lerman. There is no further action from you if you want to maintain your nomination of Ms. Lerman. If you wish to nominate Ms. Litt instead, please add your signature to her application.

Per Resolution 2018-0188, the Board of County Commissioners established the ACW. The ACW is comprised of fifteen 15 members, two (2) appointed by each County Commissioner and one (1) at-large appointed by majority vote of the BCC. The Board may also appoint a youth representative (15-18 years of age) to serve as an ex-officio member. The ACW serves as an advisory body to focus on matters pertaining specifically to women. The board meets at least quarterly. Fifteen (15) seats are currently filled and there is one (1) at-large vacancy. The current diversity count is Caucasian: 6 (40%), African-American: 4 (27%), Hispanic: 4 (27%) and Unknown: 1 (6%). The gender ratio (female: male) is 15:0. This nominee is a Caucasian female.

The appointment is for three (3) years. Members must be residents of Palm Beach County and should reflect, to the greatest extent possible, the demographic and geographic diversity in the County, represent the ACW's focus, as well as experts in the field. 

For the inaugural Commission on Women, each Commissioner shall appoint one member for a term of one year and one member for a term of two years. The at-large member shall be appointed for an initial term of two years. Thereafter, all appointments shall be made for a term of three years. If the Board appoints a youth member, the term is for one year.
