I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Supplement No. 1 to Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 19 to the Consulting/Professional Services General Utility, Architectural, and Value Engineering Services Contract (Contract) with Baxter & Woodman, Inc. (Consultant) for Engineering Services During Construction for Rehabilitation of Master Repump Station 9-North, Repump Station 8310, and Five (5) Lift Stations (Project) for a not to exceed amount of \$192,796.46.

Summary: On June 20, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2017-0815) with the Consultant. Supplement No. 1 to CSA No. 19 provides for additional professional engineering services during construction for Master Repump Station 9-North and Repump Station 8310 and five (5) lift stations including, but not limited to, construction management services, field observations, and project administration. This Contract was procured under the requirements of the 2002 Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance (R2002-0064) prior to the adoption of the new Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance on October 16, 2018. The SBE goal established under the 2002 Ordinance was 15% overall participation. The Contract provides for 26% SBE participation. Supplement No. 1 to CSA No. 19 includes 0% SBE participation. The cumulative SBE participation, including CSA No. 19, is 26.41%. Consultant is headquartered in Crystal Lake, IL, but maintains an office in Palm Beach County from which the majority of the work will be undertaken. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY23 Budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 20-061) Districts 2, 3, 5 and 6 (MWJ)

Background and Justification: These engineering services during construction will maximize the value of the County's rehabilitation projects during construction through services to enforce contract requirements, coordinate construction activities with stakeholders, and review the Contractor's documentation, including pay applications.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

PBCWUD Project No.: 20-061

Project Title: Engineering Services During Construction for Rehabilitation for Master

Repump Station 9-North, Repump Station 8310, and Five (5) Lift Stations

Baxter & Woodman, Inc. (CONSULTANT) shall perform:

BACKGROUND

Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) has requested CONSULTANT to provide additional engineering services during construction for the rehabilitation of Master Repump Station 9-North and Repump Station No. 8310. The additional services shall include the extension of construction schedules for both projects for Construction Administration Services and to provide a full-time Resident Project Representative (RPR) on site at each project during construction.

Improvements to Master Repump Station 9-North (PBCWUD – Zone 4) PBCWUD Project No.: 18-036

Master Repump Station 9-North is located in Boca Raton, Florida. Master Repump Station 9-North is an inline type booster station, which conveys domestic wastewater. The site is currently equipped with four (4) 200-horsepower (HP) end suction centrifugal pumps which are each driven via dedicated variable frequency drives (VFDs).

Repump Station No. 8310 Upgrades and Improvements (PBCWUD – Zone 6) PBCWUD Project No.: 18-064

Repump Station 8310 is located at the site of the previously decommissioned City of South Bay Wastewater Plant, on the west side of NW 1st Avenue in South Bay, Florida. Repump Station 8310 conveys raw wastewater, which was previously treated onsite, to PBCWUD's sanitary force main system. The station is currently equipped with a skid-mounted wastewater inline booster pump station which includes three (3) 60 HP horizontal centrifugal pumps. The inline station was placed into service in 2010. Each of the pumps is driven by a VFD installed within dedicated control panel enclosures.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Task 2 – Engineering Services During Construction (Additional Services)

The specific engineering services during construction to be provided by the CONSULTANT include the following:

Subtask 2.2 General Administration (Additional Services)

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Δ-1

CONSULTANT will administer PBCWUD's contract with TLC Diversified, Inc. for Master Repump Station 9-North or Cardinal Contractors, Inc. for Repump Station No. 8310 (Contractor) and ensure contract conditions are met. Conduct daily email and written correspondence for project communication as the lead point of contact through the established lines of communication protocol, monitor and ensure Contractor obtains all governmental and regulatory permits, inspections and approvals. CONSULTANT shall provide general project administration for the duration of each project.

- a. Improvements to Master Repump Station 9-North 150 hours
 - Original total hour budget for Construction Manager was 470 hours over 20 months, averaging 23.5 hours per month. Current remaining budget from July 2022 to April 2023 (ten (10) months) averages 13.4 hours. Additional budget requested is the difference between averages times ten (10) months plus 50 hours of contingency = [(23.5 hours 13.5 hours) * 10 Months] + 50 hours contingency = 150 hours

Task 3 – RPR Services (Additional Services)

The specific RPR services to be provided by the CONSULTANT include the following:

Subtask 3.1 Field Observations (Additional Services)

Provide a full-time (approximately 40 hours per week) RPR during the construction of Improvements to Master Repump Station 9-North and Repump Station No. 8310 Upgrades and Improvements (assumes the first three (3) months of construction will include shop drawing approval and material procurement). Activities performed under this task consist of furnishing a RPR during the actual construction of the project, to observe the quality of the construction work and to determine, in general, if the construction is proceeding in accordance with the Contract Documents so that an engineering certification can be made regarding the construction of the proposed improvements. The RPR shall:

- Serve as CONSULTANT's liaison with Contractor, working principally through the Contractor's construction manager and assisting them in understanding the intent of the Contract Documents.
- Conduct on-site observations of the work in progress to assist in determining if the work is
 proceeding in accordance with the Contract Documents and that completed work conforms
 to the Contract Documents. Report, in writing, whenever CONSULTANT believes that work
 is unsatisfactory, faulty or defective, or does not conform to the Contract Documents, or does
 not meet the requirements of inspections, tests or approval required to be made, or has been
 damaged prior to final payment.
- RPR shall provide a report of activities performed by Contractor each day that the RPR is onsite and submit to PBCWUD at the end of each workweek.
- Accompany visiting inspectors representing public or regulatory agencies having jurisdiction over the project. Record, in writing, the outcome of these inspections and report it to PBCWUD.
- Consider and evaluate Contractor's suggestions for modifications in drawings or specifications and report them to PBCWUD, in writing. CONSULTANT shall make recommendation for action by the PBCWUD.
- Observe all flushing and pressure testing of the piping.
- Assist the Contractor in coordinating all required density testing, etc., as required by the Construction Documents.

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- · Attend start-ups of all equipment.
- Review work progress at key steps to allow certifications to permitting agencies that work was completed in substantial conformance with the Contract Documents.
- a. Improvements to Master Repump Station 9-North 745 Hours
 - Original total hour budget for Field Observations was 885 hours over 17 months at 12 hours per week. Current remaining hours is 885 hours 67.5 hours = 817.5 hours. Full-time inspection (40 hours/week) is expected to begin August 2022 and end April 2023 (nine (9) months). Additional budget requested is the amount of time for full-time inspection services times nine (9) months minus the remaining hours:

{[((30.4 Days/Month) * 9 Months) / (7 Days/Week)] * 40 Hours/Week} - 817.5 hours = 745 hours

- b. Repump Station No. 8310 Upgrades and Improvements 1,094 Hours
 - 1. Original total hour budget for Field Observations was 469 hours over nine (9) months at 12 hours per week. Current remaining hours are 469 hours. Additional budget requested is the amount of time for full-time inspection services times nine (9) months minus the current hours:

{[((30.4 Days/Month) * 9 Months) / (7 Days/Week)] * 40 Hours/Week} - 469 hours = 1,094 hours

Deliverables

- Reports for unsatisfactory performance and conditions.
- Daily reports for days RPR is on site.
- · Reports on outcomes of regulatory agency inspections.
- Contractor's suggestions for modifications.

LIMITATIONS OF AUTHORITY

Except upon written instructions of CONSULTANT, RPR shall not:

- 1. Authorize any deviation from the Contract Documents or approve any substitute materials or equipment.
- 2. Exceed limitations on CONSULTANT's authority as set forth in the Contract Documents.
- 3. Undertake any of the responsibilities of Contractor, Subcontractors or Construction Manager, or expedite the Work.
- 4. Advise on or issue directions relative to any aspect of the means, methods, techniques, sequences or procedures of construction unless such is specifically called for in the Contract Documents.
- 5. Be permitted to authorize PBCWUD to take ownership of the Project in whole or in part.

ASSUMPTIONS

The scope of work presented herein is based on the assumptions as listed in original Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 19 and per the following assumptions:

1. Attachment - E Budget Summary is based on current project financials as of July 7, 2022.

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- 2. Construction durations for each project are based on the following original estimated months:
 - a. Improvements to Master Repump Station 9-North 20 Months. Substantial Completion scheduled for April 1, 2023 and Final Completion scheduled for May 1, 2023.
 - b. Repump Station No. 8310 Upgrades and Improvements 12 Months. Substantial Completion and Final Completion are to be determined.
- 3. Construction RPR hours are based on estimated months of actual construction (Monday through Friday) at 40 hours per week. Weekend work and/or nighttime work is not included in this scope and budget; this supplement to the original CSA will be executed for the additional time as presented below:
 - a. Improvements to Master Repump Station 9-North 17 Months. Additional Services assumes based on the Contractor's schedule that full-time RPR will begin August 1, 2022 to April 1, 2023. Currently unused budget hours for RPR was subtracted from nine (9) months of full-time RPR hours.
 - b. Repump Station No. 8310 Upgrades and Improvements Nine (9) Months. Additional Services subtracts budgeted hours from nine (9) months of full-time RPR hours.
- 4. Reimbursable Expenses (Mileage) originally included three (3) days of travel for RPR for each site. Additional Services includes two (2) additional days of travel for RPR for each site.




