I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Request for Release of Funds and Certification (HUD Form 7015.15) on behalf of the Palm Beach County Community Services Department (CSD) for activities approved by the U.S. Department of Development (HUD) through the Urban Community Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending Program (CPF).

Summary: HUD awarded a \$1,000,000 CPF grant to CSD to remodel the Health Clinic at the Senator Philip D. Lewis Homeless Resource Center and convert it into a medical respite facility with four (4) to five (5) beds for homeless individuals. The CPF Program requires that an environmental review be performed in accordance with Federal regulations at 24 CFR Part 58. The environmental review has been completed by the Department of Housing and Economic Development (HED) and the County must now provide HUD with a Request for Release of Funds and Certification (HUD Form 7015.15) for the project. The Certification affirms that procedures required by 24 CFR Part 58 have been followed, the activity did not require an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), and the County will comply with the National Environmental Policy Act and other environmental laws as they relate to the activity. A required Notice of Intent to Request Release of Funds was published on November 20, 2022, and no public comments were received during a 15-day comment period. Approval of the certification will allow CSD to proceed with CPF activities that will shelter homeless individuals with medical conditions. District 7 (HJF)

Background and Policy Issues: Federal regulations at 24 CFR 58.2(a)(7)(ii)(B) establish environmental processing requirements for all HUD-assisted activities. The CPF Program is administered by HUD to provide financial assistance for projects that will assist communities. CSD requested that HED prepare the environmental review because HED routinely prepares environmental reviews for federally-funded programs.
