### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** a Contract for the Valve Additions – Phase 1 (Project) with Johnson-Davis, Incorporated (Contractor) in the amount of \$8,875,000.00.

**Summary:** On October 5, 2022, the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) received one (1) bid for the Project. Contractor was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$8,875,000.00. The Project provides for all materials, labor, supervision, equipment, supplies, fees, expertise, and services necessary for the installation of seventy-five (75) isolation valves within the PBCWUD water and wastewater service area.

This Contract was procured under the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance. On June 3, 2022, the Goal Setting Committee applied an Affirmative Procurement Initiative (API) of a minimum mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting participation of which 5% shall be among certified African American and/or Hispanic American owned firms. Contractor has met the established API. The Contract provides for 30.69% SBE participation, which includes 9.56% MBE participation, 0.22% MBE (B), and 9.34% MBE (H). Contractor is a Palm Beach County based company. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY23 budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 21-016) Countywide (MWJ)

**Background and Justification:** The completion of the work under this Project is necessary as part of the continued improvement, restoration and repair of water and force main infrastructure in the PBCWUD service area and will allow the isolation of pipelines during pipe breaks, thereby reducing emergency repair costs, minimizing the interruption of water and sewer services to customers and critical facilities, and in some cases, preventing the release of sewage into the environment.
