I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- (A) Amendment No. 10 to the General Consulting Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM) for Consulting/ Professional Services in the amount of \$1,153,626.28 for the continued performance of professional planning and design services related to the approved Palm Beach County Airports Capital Improvement Program; and
- **(B)** A Budget Transfer in the amount of \$1,153,627 in the Airport's Improvement and Development Fund to provide budget for the project; including a transfer from Reserves in the amount of \$1,153,627.

Summary: The Consulting Agreement with AECOM for general airport planning and design was approved by the Board on March 12, 2019 (R-2019-0301) in the amount of \$828,984.74 in order to carry out the approved Capital Improvement Programs for the County's Airports. Amendment No. 1 was approved by the Board on August 20, 2019 (R-2019-1160) increasing the amount of the contract by \$1,032,651.29. Amendment No. 2 was approved by the Board on February 4, 2020 (R-2020-0079) increasing the amount of the contract by \$1,753,356.78. Amendment No. 3 was approved by the Board on June 16, 2020 (R-2020-0639) increasing the amount of the contract by \$885,789.10. Amendment No. 4 was approved by the Board on October 6, 2020 (R-2020-1514) increasing the amount of the contract by \$1,789,325 and modified Article 21, Access and Audits, of the agreement. Amendment No. 5 was approved by the Board on February 9, 2021 (R-2021-0233) exercising the first one (1) year renewal option. Amendment No. 6 was approved by the Board on August 17, 2021 (R-2021-1160) increasing the amount of the contract by \$1,583,691.58. Amendment No. 7 was approved by the Board on February 8, 2022 (R-2022-0134) increasing the amount of the contract by \$1,763,111.51 and exercising the second and final, one (1) year renewal option. Amendment No. 8 was approved by the Board on June 7, 2022 (R-2022-0573) increasing the amount of the contract by \$1,727,453.97. Amendment No. 9 was approved by the Board on October 18, 2022 (R-2022-1243) increasing the amount of the contract by \$976,819. Approval of Amendment No. 10 will provide an additional \$1,153,626.28 to complete the following tasks: Task I Services - PBI Part 139 Grading Design/ CM (Construction Management)/ CA (Construction Administration)/ RPR (Resident Project Representative); PBI Pavement Repairs CA/RPR Services; LNA West Apron Reconstruction (CA/CM/RPR); PBI Garage Repairs CM/CA/RPR Services; and Task III Services - Deliverable(s) as required in accordance with specific Task Authorizations. Work to be completed under these Task III Services will be issued in accordance with PPM CW-F-050, by way of a separate proposal or task authorization. AECOM is a Dallas, Texas based firm; however, the majority of the work to be completed in this agreement will be completed and/or managed through their West Palm Beach and Tampa, Florida offices in conjunction with several Palm Beach County-based sub-consultants and firms. A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 18% was set for this contract. AECOM committed to 18% in its proposal. The anticipated DBE participation based upon the previous approved tasks is approximately 23.77%. The DBE participation for this Amendment is 4.02%. Pursuant to changes to Chapter 332, Florida Statutes, effective October 1, 2020, a governing body of a commercial service airport may not approve purchases of contractual services in excess of the Category Five threshold amount of \$325,000 provided in Section 287.017, Florida Statutes, on a consent agenda. This amendment exceeds the threshold amount and must be approved on the regular agenda. Countywide (AH)

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2020, the County entered into an Amendment No. 3 (R2020-0639) with the Consultant to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2020, the County entered into an Amendment No. 4 (R2020-1514) with the Consultant to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2021, the COUNTY entered into an Amendment No. 5 (R2021-0233) with the CONSULTANT to exercise the first one (1) year renewal option for the continuation of services and to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2021, the County entered into an Amendment No. 6 (R2021-1160) with the Consultant to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2022, the COUNTY entered into an Amendment No. 7 (R2022-0134) with the CONSULTANT to exercise the final one (1) year renewal option for the continuation of services and to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

The total amount to be paid by the COUNTY to the CONSULTANT for professional services, including any out of pocket expenses, shall not exceed One Million One Nine Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Six Dollars and Twenty Eight Cents (\$1,153,626.28) for the services in Amendment No. 10 to the original Contract.
- 2. Except as specifically amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

OVERVIEW

The Palm Beach Department of Airports (DOA) has requested AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM) to develop this Task I-23-PBI-A-82 PBI Part 139 Grading Design/CM/CA/RPR Project (Project) at Palm Beach International Airport (PBI). The scope of work for this Project includes providing Construction Documents, Bidding Services, Construction Management (CM), Construction Administration (CA), and Resident Project Representative Services (RPR) services for this Project.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE AND APPROACH

This task will be carefully coordinated by the Team provided below:

The FAA Airport Certification Safety Inspector issued a Report, dated April 22, 2022, to the DOA, with findings at PBI that included PBI Runway Safety Areas (RSAs). The Report noted the observation of potentially hazardous humps, depressions, and other surface variations observed in nine areas associated within the RSAs of Runways 10L/28R and 14/32. AECOM evaluated the areas identified by the inspector and prepared a letter highlighting the preliminary recommendations to address the safety concerns that were highlighted.

For this Project, the AECOM Team will prepare Bid Documents in four work areas within the RSA of Runway 10L-28R to address the areas highlighted by the inspector and bring the areas into compliance with FAA Standards.

Task I – Bid Document Development

Advance Bid Documents

- a) Kick-off meeting will be held with DOA and Design Team prior to task beginning in order to discuss design objective and goals.
- b) Advance Bid Documents will be developed. Drawings will include existing conditions plans, demolition plans and proposed work plans, cross sections, stormwater pollution prevention plans and notes, and phasing.
- c) Any findings during this phase will be summarized and any changes to the project due to unforeseen conditions will be brought to the attention of the DOA.

During this phase, the Advance Bid Documents review meeting will be held with DOA and Design Team to evaluate the proposed plans and design intent. Any findings during this phase will be summarized and any changes to the project due to unforeseen conditions will be brought to the attention of the DOA.

Bid Documents

The CONSULTANT will develop Bid Documents from the approved Advance Bid Documents. They will consist of the information contained in the Advance Bid Documents, as well as incorporate any comments provided and by DOA, Permit Agencies, or other authorized reviewers, as directed by DOA.

 - Estimate of Probable Program Cost pdf;

Task II – Bidding Services

After authorization to proceed with the Bidding Phase, CONSULTANT will assist the DOA in advertising for and obtaining bids for each separate prime contract for construction, materials, equipment and services; and, where applicable, maintain a record of prospective bidders to whom Bidding Documents have been issued, via the County's Vendor Self-Service Website.

CONSULTANT will support the DOA in conducting a pre-bid to share pertinent bidding and technical information and requirements with prospective bidders; issue addenda as appropriate to interpret and clarify or expand the Bidding Documents during the Bidding phase; and attend the bid opening, prepare bid tabulation sheets and assist DOA in evaluating bids or proposals and in assembling and awarding contracts for construction, materials, equipment and services.

Meetings

The CONSULTANT will attend the following meetings during this Phase:

- a. One (1) Pre-Bid Meeting; and,
- b. One (1) Bid Opening Meeting;

Deliverables

The CONSULTANT will deliver the following major Deliverables for this Phase:

- a. Four (4) sets of Bidding Documents;
- b. Electronic Bid Documents;
- c. Applicable Addenda during Bidding process;
- d. Pre-Bid Agenda and Meeting Minutes;
- e. Bid Tabulation of Bids; and,
- f. Bid Recommendation Letter for Award.

Task III - CA Services

AECOM will provide CA Services throughout the scheduled construction of this Project and will include the following:

- A. Conferences and Meetings: Attend and facilitate meetings between Owner, Contractor(s), and Stakeholders, such as preconstruction meeting, kick-off meeting, progress meetings (a maximum of (5) five bi-weekly construction progress meetings), job conferences and other project related meetings. Meeting Minutes for all formal meetings will be prepared by AECOM;
- B. Conformed Documents: Prepare (6) sets of Conformed Contract Plans and Specifications for Contract Execution. Prepare (6) sets of Executed Contract Documents for Construction, (3) for DOA, and (3) for the Contractor. Prepare a CD with Deliverables:
- C. Review Contractor's Maintenance of Traffic Plans;
- D. Review Contractor's Critical Path Schedule;
- E. Review Contractor's Security Plans;
- F. Shop Drawings: Review and approve shop drawings prior to the beginning of construction activities. Develop and maintain a log that summarizes status of all shop drawings;
- G. Interpretation and clarification of Contract Documents: Respond to various Requests for Information, Job memoranda, and other field prepared inquiries;
- H. Records: Maintain electronic files of correspondence, meeting minutes, shop drawings and Contract Documents including all work directive changes, addenda, change orders, field orders, additional drawings issued subsequent to the execution of the contract, clarifications and interpretations of the Contract Documents, progress reports and other project related documents.
- I. Payment Requests: Review applications for payment with quantities observed and forward recommendations to the DOA;

- J. Periodic Inspection Services: AECOM construction manager and EOR will provide periodic inspections (Five (5) bi-weekly inspections);
- K. AECOM will be responsible for preparation, processing, review and document control of Change Orders, Field Instructions, Field Bulletins, Construction Change Proposals and Directives, and Notices of Non-Compliance;
- L. Task Management and Coordination: Coordinate as needed with FAA, DOA Operations, SFWMD, and other Project stakeholders;
- M. AECOM will review Contractor the Record Documents for completeness and obvious errors based on readily available information to the AECOM. The AECOM will provide comments prior to acceptance of the Contractor's Record Documents;
- N. AECOM will use all readily available information including the Contractor's Asbuilts to prepare Record Drawings for the completed work; and
- O. Project Close-out Activities: AECOM will prepare Certificate of Substantial Completion, and other Project related Close-out activities.

Task IV - CM/RPR Services

As Part of this task, AECOM will perform the following services as part of CM/RPR:

- A. AECOM will perform Pre-Construction Inspection and take photographs of the Project Site in collaboration with the Contractor and the DOA to document existing site conditions. All areas where the Contractor is expected to impact including the: Project Work Areas, Haul Roads, Access Gates, Staging Areas, and Stockpile Locations will be documented;
- B. Review Contractor's record survey data as it is developed for existing conditions to evaluate conformance with design;
- C. CONSULTANT will review Contractor Daily Reports;
- D. QA Materials Testing: Provide materials testing for construction activities. Facilitate meeting at onset of Project outlining material testing requirements, as outlined in the contract documents, with materials testing personnel, RPR, and the Contractor.
- E. CONSULTANT will review QA Materials Test Results and Laboratory Reports performed by responsible Subconsultant;
- F. AECOM will review Guarantees, Warranties, Certifications, and Operation & Maintenance Manuals provided by the Contractor;
- G. Substantial and Final Completion: Conduct substantial and final completion inspection in the company of the DOA, and develop a substantial and final punch list of items in conjunction with Owner to be completed or corrected; and,
- H. Provide Construction Support Services to DOA during the performance of the Project.
- I. RPR Services: CONSULTANT will provide full-time RPR with on-site observations of the quality and progress of the contractor's work in-order to determine if the construction is proceeding in accordance with the Contract Documents. The RPR's efforts will be directed toward determining whether the constructed project conforms to the Contract Documents. These RPR Services will include developing Daily Reports, monitoring the Contractor's progress, serving as the Owner's liaison with the Contractor, coordinating materials testing, and conducting on-site observations of the construction activities in

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progress to assist in determining if the work is being carried out in compliance with the Contract Documents;

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The duration of this Project is: Procurement: 60 Days, Construction: 93 Days, and Close-Out: 30 Days, for a Total of 183 Days. AECOM is scheduled to complete this project within 200 Calendar Days following receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

PROJECT DELIVERABLES

Project Deliverables are as described in the above-mentioned Tasks I and II.

PROJECT ASSUMPTIONS

- AECOM shall not be responsible for the means, methods, techniques, sequences, procedures of construction or selection of materials selected by the Contractor or the safety precautions and programs incident to the work of the Contractor. AECOM shall not guarantee the performance of the Contractor nor be responsible for the acts, errors, omissions, or the failure of the Contractor to perform the construction work in accordance with the Contract Documents.
- 2. AECOM does not have the authority to prepare and/or issue NOTAMs and as a result, this task will be the responsibility of the DOA.
- 3. AECOM will perform all services listed in this scope of services and it is expected that the DOA will perform services that are not listed.
- 4. DOA will submit the Construction Safety Phasing Plan to the FAA.
- 5. AECOM understands and agrees that the DOA shall have the responsibility for the general administration of the construction contract. AECOM shall not have the authority or responsibility to accept or reject work done by the Contractor and is only responsible for providing recommendations to the DOA based on the available information.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE AND APPROACH

This Project includes providing Construction Administration (CA), Construction Management (CM), and Resident Project Representative Services (RPR) services for this Project that constructs improvements for the improvements for the LNA West Apron that include:

- Reconstruction of the General Aviation (GA) West Apron
- Aircraft Parking Tie-down Reconfiguration
- Drainage Improvements, and the
- Pavement Marking Application for Airfield Services Road extending from the new west driveway entrance (LN 17-1 constructed by others) to the west of the transient ramp, immediately north of the existing terminal building.

Procurement shall consist of materials procurement and mobilization for a period of Sixty (60) Calendar Days from the Notice to Proceed (NTP). Project construction will be for a period of One Hundred (100) Calendar Days. Final acceptance shall be achieved within a period of Thirty (30) Calendar Days from the date of substantial completion.

Task I - CM/CA Services

AECOM will provide CA Services throughout the scheduled construction of this Project and will include the following:

- A. Conferences and Meetings: Attend and facilitate meetings between Owner, Contractor(s), and Stakeholders, such as preconstruction meeting, kick-off meeting, progress meetings (a maximum four (4) progress meetings during procurement and seventeen (7) bi-weekly construction progress meetings plus two (2) progress meetings during Final Close-out, job conferences and other project related meetings. Meeting Minutes for all formal meetings will be prepared by AECOM;
- B. Review Contractor's Maintenance of Traffic Plans;
- C. Review Contractor's Critical Path Schedule;
- Shop Drawings: Review and approve shop drawings prior to the beginning of construction activities. Develop and maintain a log that summarizes status of all shop drawings;
- E. Clarification of Contract Documents: Respond to various Requests for Information, Job memoranda, and other field prepared inquiries;

These RPR Services will include developing Daily Reports, monitoring the Contractor's progress, serving as the Owner's liaison with the Contractor, and conducting on-site observations of the construction activities in progress to assist in determining if the work is being carried out in compliance with the Contract Documents;

- D. Periodic Inspection Services: AECOM construction manager will provide periodic inspections (bi-weekly inspections total of seven (7) inspections);
- E. Interpretation and AECOM will review Guarantees, Warranties, Certifications, and Operation & Maintenance Manuals provided by the Contractor;

- 2. AECOM does not have the authority to prepare and/or issue NOTAMs and as a result, this task will be the responsibility of the DOA.
- 3. AECOM will perform all services listed in this scope of services and it is expected that the DOA will perform services that are not listed.
- 4. In the event that the DOA and the AECOM believe it to be in the best interests of the Project that additional construction engineering inspection services, or additional services beyond what is provided in this scope of work be provided by the AECOM, a separate Task Authorization, which specifies the proposed scope of services to be performed, will be prepared.
- 5. AECOM understands and agrees that the DOA shall have the responsibility for the general administration of the construction contract. AECOM shall not have the authority or responsibility to accept or reject work done by the Contractor and is only responsible for providing recommendations to the DOA based on the available information.

Overview

Professional services described herein will be authorized by the Notice-to-Proceed for this project. CH2M HILL, INC. (CH2M), a wholly owned subsidiary of Jacobs Engineering Group Inc., will provide Construction Administration (CA) Services associated with the West Apron Reconstruction project at Palm Beach County Park (Lantana) Airport (LNA). The project includes the following improvements:

Document control of construction payment applications, notices of non-compliance, construction change directives and construction proposals will be performed by others and is not included in this scope of services.

Provide one set of reproducible drawings and CAD file "record drawings," which will become the property of the DOA, corrected to show changes made in the work during construction of the project. Such corrections will be based solely upon "as-built" prints, drawings, field sketches, and other data furnished to CH2M by the DOA and the contractor, and upon change orders issued during construction. CH2M will not verify the as-built information provided by the DOA or contractor. Record drawings will be prepared in part on the basis of information compiled and furnished by others, and may not always represent the exact location, type of various components, or exact manner in which the Project was finally constructed. CH2M is not

responsible for any errors and omissions in the information from others which is incorporated into the record drawings.

CH2M will provide Task Coordination including emails, telephone conversations, and general correspondence with DOA. For budgeting purposes, CH2M assumes an average of 1.5 hours per week from Construction Administration NTP through issuance of Final Completion throughout active construction.

CH2M will perform Task Independent Technical Reviews (QA/QC) of CH2M's responsible services including shop drawings / submittals, RFIs, Field Instructions / Bulletins, and Record Drawings.

To avoid misunderstandings or questions, CH2M understands and agrees that the DOA shall have the responsibility for the general administration of the construction contract. Accordingly, CH2M shall not have the authority or responsibility to issue direct instructions to the Contractor, to reject the work performed by the Contractor, or to require special instructions and/or tests. CH2M, however, will provide continuing counsel to the DOA representatives throughout the construction of the project.

Project Deliverables

As required under Phase 5 summarized in this scope of services.

Project Assumptions

- 1. CH2M will perform services listed in this scope of services. It is assumed that the DOA or others will perform all construction services NOT listed in this scope of services.
- 2. Construction management services are not included in this scope of work. A separate task authorization will be prepared and negotiated for construction management services if requested by the DOA.
- 3. Pre-construction conference meeting agenda/minutes and bi-weekly construction progress meeting agenda/minutes will be prepared by others.
- 4. All permit fees are excluded from this scope of services and will be paid by the DOA.
- 5. CH2M assumes the DOA and Contractor will be responsible for the following:
 - A. Reviewing and processing of contractor pay application requests, DBE monitoring and compliance, issuance and processing of change orders, and notices of non-compliance.
 - B. Badging, ensuring contractor is in compliance with airport requirements, safety regulations, etc.
 - C. Verifying construction vehicles are properly marked, lighted, registered, and verifying contractor equipment/vehicles meet the technical specification requirements and are in good operating condition.
 - D. Coordination with FBO and tenants necessary to relocate aircraft during construction activities.
 - E. Filing proper Notices to Airmen (NOTAMS).
 - F. Verifying barricades are placed in accordance with the construction drawings or as approved by airport operations.
