I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order No. 1 to the sole source contract (R2021-1070) with Amano McGann, Inc. in the amount of \$47,055 with an increase to the project duration of 225 calendar days for the Judicial Center Parking Garage, and the State Attorney/Public Defender (SAPD) Parking Lot project.

Summary: On August 17, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved a sole source contract (R2021-1070) with Amano McGann, Inc. in the amount of \$336,974.60 for a period of 60 days from permit issuance for the installation of the OPUS parking access and revenue control systems at the entry and exit lanes for the Judicial Center Parking Garage, and the SAPD Parking Lot project. Change Order No. 1 to the sole source contract (R2021-1070) authorizes the replacement of the existing gate arms with gate arms with integrated lighting, installation of electrical patch panels and additional low voltage wiring, installation of additional revenue collection equipment and the furnishing of additional OPUS supplies. Change Order No. 1 to the sole source contract (R2021-1070) will also authorize an increase in the project duration of 225 calendar days to accommodate the fiber network replacement. In accordance with the Equal Business Opportunity (EBO) ordinance, sole source procurements are exempt from EBO requirements. Funding for this project is from the Public Building Improvement Fund. (Capital Improvements Division) District 7 (MWJ)

Background and Justification: In 2019, the County solicited vendor services for parking garage and parking lot improvements to four (4) parking lots including the Governmental Center Parking Garage, the Judicial Center Parking Garage, the SAPD Parking Garage and the 4th Street Parking lot. The parking improvements included the addition of barrier gates, card readers and new server and software upgrades. Due to insufficient funds at the time, the Governmental Center Parking Garage and the 4th Street Parking lot were the only two (2) parking lots completed under the solicitation. The newly installed OPUS parking access and revenue control system included server hardware and software; automatic vehicle identification (AVI) readers; communication controllers; and AVI access control cards. The sole source contract (R2021-1070) with Amano McGann, Inc. for the Judicial Center Parking Garage, and the SAPD Parking Lot project authorized the installation of the OPUS parking lot. Change Order No. 1 to the sole source contract (R2021-1070) authorizes the replacement of the existing gate arms with gate arms with integral lighting, installation of electrical patch panels and additional low voltage wiring, installation of additional revenue collection equipment and the furnishing of additional OPUS supplies necessary to maintain the required compatibility.



Location: 505 Banyan Boulevard, West Palm Beach, Florida 33401 (Judicial Center Garage)




