I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF								
Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: an annual contract with the following contractor for asphalt, pavers and pathway construction services on an as-needed basis through May 15, 2028.								
Contractor Saffold Paving, Inc.	<u>Status</u> Local	SBE or Non-SBE S/MBE						
Summary: On May 16, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the annual asphalt, pavers and pathway construction services to County-owned properties on an as needed basis. The Contractor now joins the list of two (2) prequalified contractors for a total of three (3) prequalified contractors with a contract expiration date of May 15, 2028. The specific requirements of the work will be determined by individual work orders issued against this annual asphalt, pavers and pathway construction services contract. These contracts are five (5) year indefinite-quantity contracts with a maximum cumulative value of \$3,000,000 across all prequalified contractors. Work will be awarded as work orders on a lump-sum, competitively bid basis across all prequalified contractors. Contractors may qualify at any time and be added to this annual asphalt, pavers and pathway construction services contract before the term ends. Projects less than \$100,000 are bid among the pool of certified Small Business Enterprise (SBE) contractors, when three (3) or more small businesses are qualified under the contract. Projects \$100,000 or greater are advertised on the vendor self-service (VSS) website while projects \$200,000 or greater are additionally advertised in the newspaper. The bidding pool is further expanded to include additional bidders responding to the specific project advertisement that submit a qualification application at least ten (10) calendar days before the bid due date. The annual asphalt, pavers and pathway construction services contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on January 4, 2023 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (APIs) of sheltered market for projects less than \$100,000 (when three (3) or more small businesses are qualified under the annual contract) or an SBE contractor will be given a price preference for projects \$100,000 or greater if its bid is within 10% of the lowest non-small business bid. Actual Small/Minority/Women Owned Business Enterprise (S/M/WBE)								
Background and Justification: The pre-qualification for this contract was advertised on January 29, 2023. The Contractor has met the established criteria and now joins the list of two (2) contractors already pre-qualified for the contract. Work will be awarded as work orders on a lump-sum, competitively bid basis across all prequalified contractors. Projects less than \$100,000 are bid among the pool of certified SBE contractors, when three (3) or more small businesses are qualified under the contract. Projects \$100,000 or greater are advertised on the VSS website while projects \$200,000 or greater are additionally advertised in the newspaper. The bidding pool is further expanded to include additional bidders responding to the specific project advertisement that submit a qualification application at least ten (10) calendar days before the bid due date. Contractors may qualify at any time and be added to this annual asphalt, pavers and pathway construction services contract before the term ends.
