I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve Amendment Number 1 to the Material Removal Agreement (Agreement) with Florida Inland Navigation District (District) to provide for the upfront payment of \$3,247,200 to the County.							
Summary: On August 23, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved Agreement (R2022-0884) for payment from the District to the County on a reimbursement basis of up to \$3,500,000 or \$20 per cubic yard, whichever amount is less, for the removal of an estimated 164,000 cubic yards of spoil material from the Dredge Material Management Area Peanut Island (DMMA PI). The spoil material will be used to construct the Bonefish Cove Project (Project), in partnership with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), with the County as the local sponsor. The County is required to provide its share of funds to USACE before it releases the Project for bid. This upfront payment by the District will serve as a portion of the County's monetary contribution to USACE as the local sponsor. There is no cost to the County associated with this item. Background and Justification: The construction of this Project would not be possible without the partnership with the District to repurpose their dredge material and amend the Agreement. The Project will construct 40 acres of island restoration area in the Lake Worth Lagoon to provide seagrass, mangrove, oyster, and shorebird nesting habitats.

Final Agreement-unsigned Will be signed by FIND on 5/19/23. **AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 TO** MATERIAL REMOVAL AGREEMENT **BETWEEN** PALM BEACH COUNTY

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT is made and entered into on this , 2023 by and between FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT, an independent special taxing district of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "DISTRICT," and PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement dated August 23, 2022 (R2022-0884) wherein the District is paying the County to remove spoil material from the Dredge Material Management Area Peanut Island (DMMA PI); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement to change the payment structure as described below;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and representation herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3, PAYMENT, of the Agreement, is hereby replaced in its entirety as follows:
 - a) DISTRICT shall pay COUNTY per cubic yard of material removed to cover a portion of the estimated costs for removing the spoil material from the DMMA PI and relocating to the Project site. The cost to the DISTRICT will not exceed \$3,500,000 or \$20 per cubic yard of material removed, whichever amount is less. The total payment is based on an estimated 164,000 cubic yards of spoil material to be removed.
 - b) Upon execution of this Agreement, DISTRICT shall pay COUNTY \$3,247,200 as a deposit toward the final removal cost. COUNTY may immediately apply the deposit toward the cost of the project.
 - c) Upon completion of the project, COUNTY shall deliver to the DISTRICT a certified tally sheet of the volume of spoil material removed from PI in order to calculate the final removal cost and any remaining fees to be paid to COUNTY or refund to be paid to DISTRICT.
 - d) COUNTY shall pay DISTRICT an administrative removal fee in the amount of \$0.20 per cubic yard of material removed. The COUNTY acknowledges that any removed

material shall only by utilized for the Project. Upon completion of the project, the COUNTY shall deliver to the DISTRICT a certified tally sheet of the volume of spoil material removed from PI in order to calculate the final removal cost.

e) COUNTY shall make any and all payments due hereunder to DISTRICT at the address set forth below unless otherwise notified by DISTRICT in writing:

- f) COUNTY shall pay all administrative removal fees without demand as required to be paid by COUNTY under this Agreement.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
