I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Title: Palm Tran Service Recommendations and Funding

Summary: The purpose of this workshop is to provide staff recommendations on improving Palm Tran's system efficiency through service modifications of its fixed route and paratransit modes. These recommendations will lower operational costs, diversify service delivery methods and continue the implementation of the Connection Efficiency Project (CEP). **Countywide (MM)**

Background and Policy Issues: In September 2018, Palm Tran implemented its first Route Performance Maximization (RPM) initiative after receiving approval from the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). This initiative provided a comprehensive evaluation and system-wide redesign of the bus network, resulting in a more direct, efficient and rider-friendly system in Palm Beach County. In November 2019, Palm Tran presented its CEP recommendations before the BCC which included a change to the eligibility process implemented in 2021. On April 25, 2023, Palm Tran presented a comprehensive overview of its system and a CEP update to the BCC. At the conclusion of the presentation, the BCC directed Palm Tran to schedule a future workshop to present recommendations for system efficiencies.

At this workshop, Palm Tran will be recommending and requesting board direction on service cuts and modifications to provide a more efficient fixed route bus system, to include the introduction of Transit Network Companies (TNC's) using a voucher program. Additionally, Palm Tran will be seeking direction on the implementation on the remaining phases of the CEP to address the growing costs of paratransit services.

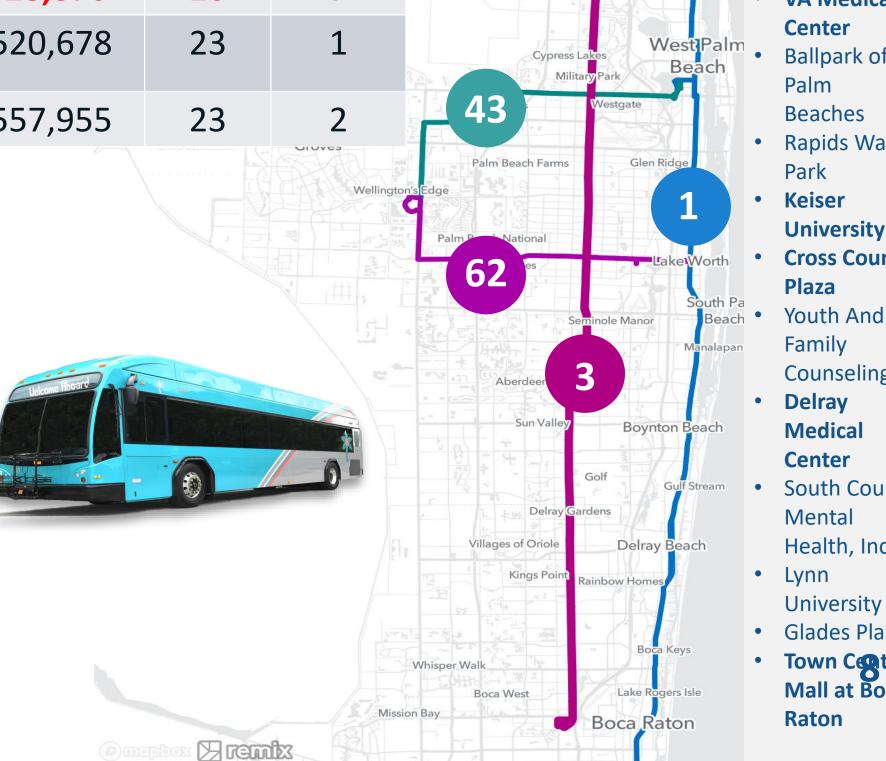

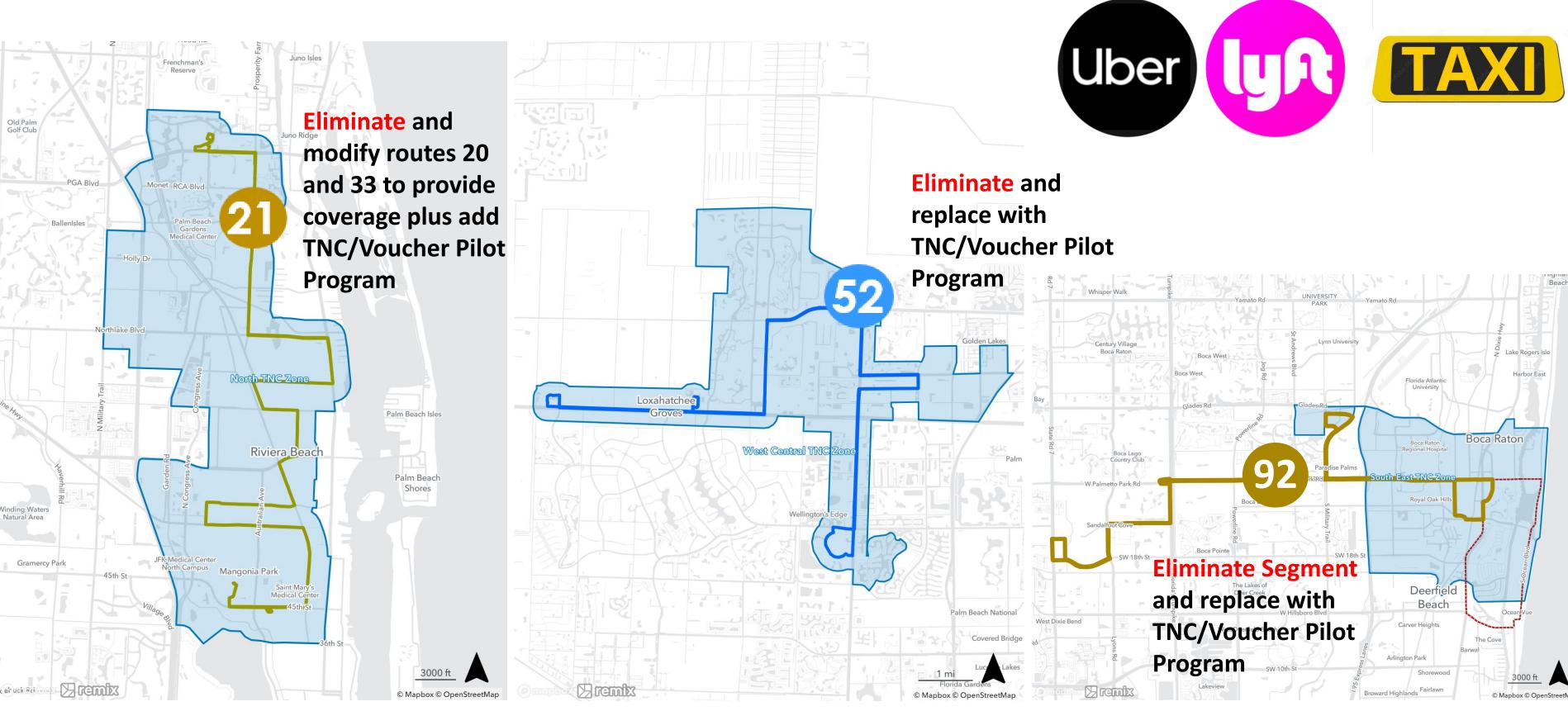


Route 3 - Overcrowding

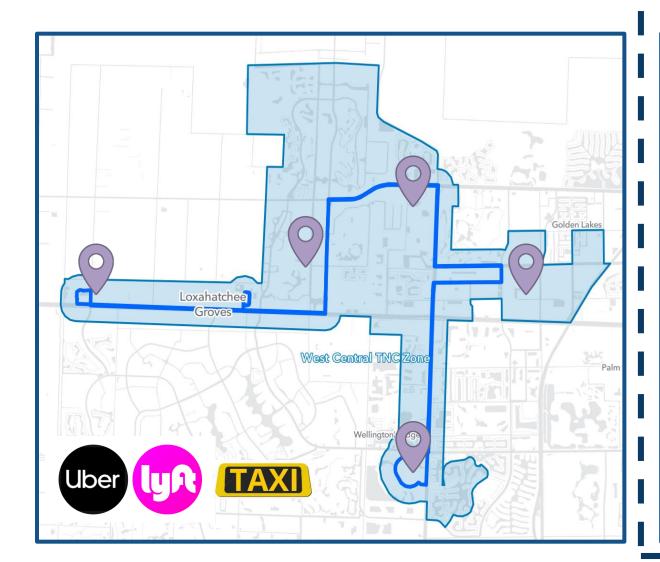

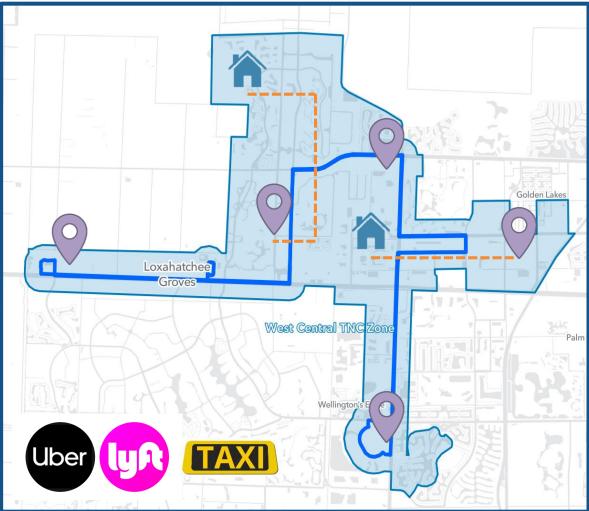
Curb to Curb

Unrestricted travel between two points within a defined zone



Curb to Point / Point to Curb

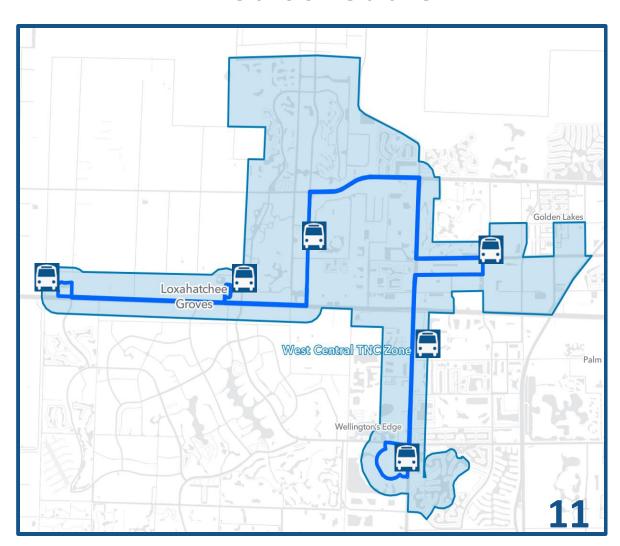
Travel from the curb to a predetermined point within a zone and return from the point to the curb

Fixed

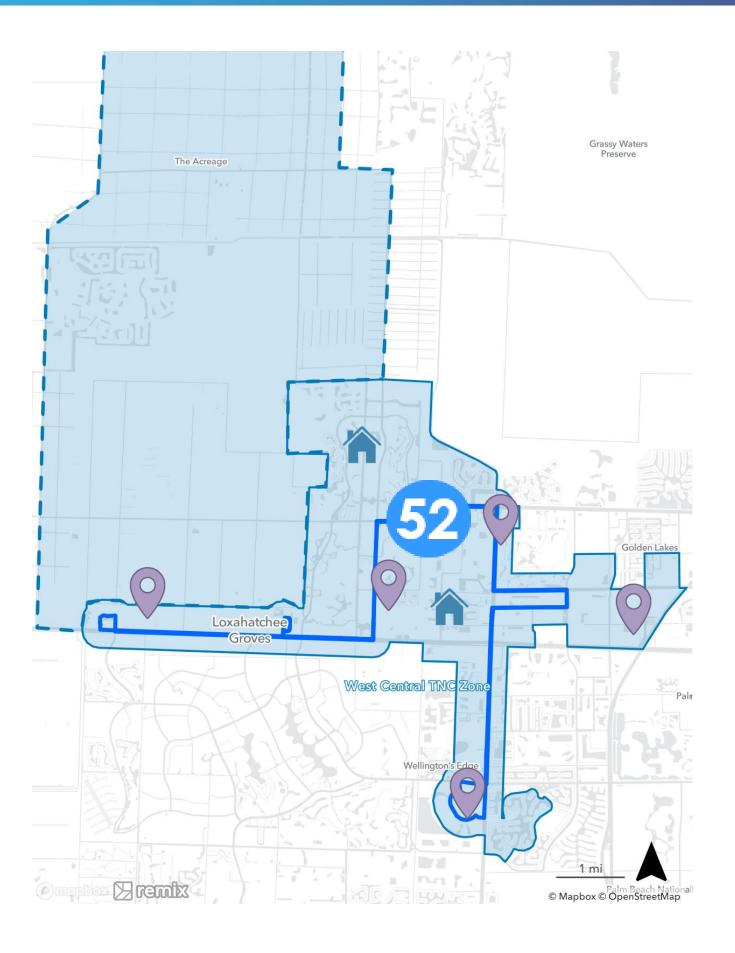
Travel between fixed points along a fixed route, operating on a fixed schedule





TNC / Voucher Pilot Program - How it Works





How it Works



- 1. Select origin "curb or predetermined point" within zone.
- 2. Select destination "curb or **predetermined point**" within the zone. **Customer's trip cannot extend beyond the zone.**
- 3. If trip is within 2.5 miles, the customers **\$2 co-pay and \$8 voucher** will cover one-way trip.
- 4. If customer's trip exceeds the subsidy within the zone, the customer will be responsible for the difference.
- 5. If customer does not have a smart phone or requires an ADA vehicle, ADA accessible Taxis will be deployed by telephone.

^{*}Taxi operator shall have a drug and alcohol testing policy in place.

^{*}Trips must originate or end at a predetermined point within the zone.

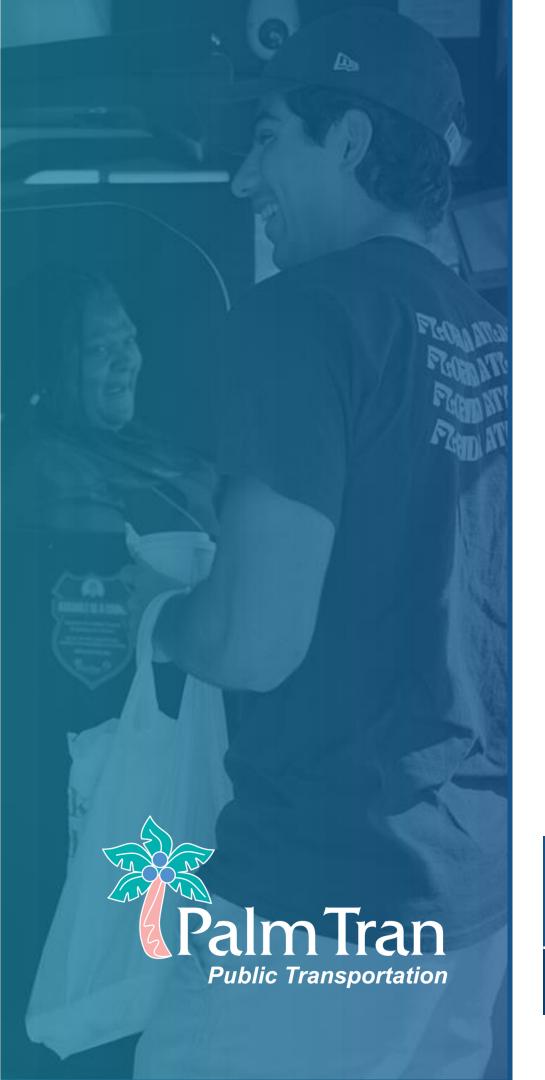

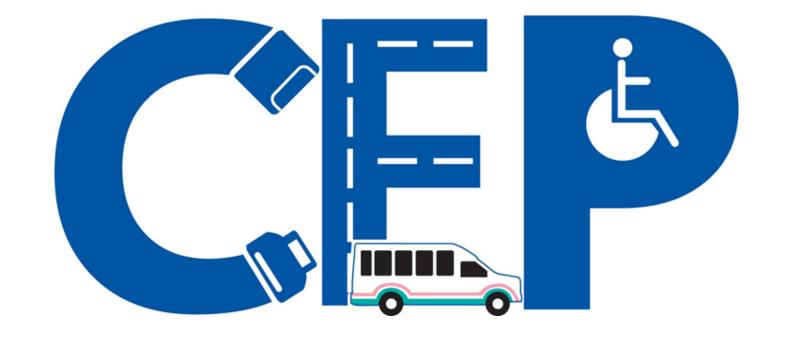

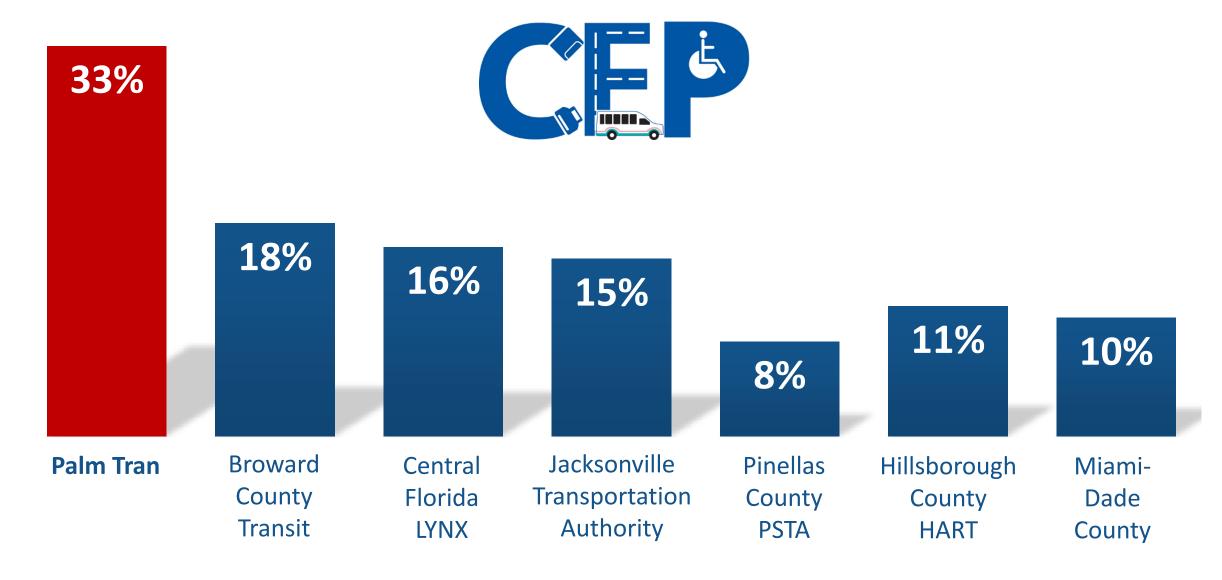
To address the rapid growth and increasing cost of Palm Tran Connection Service (Paratransit)

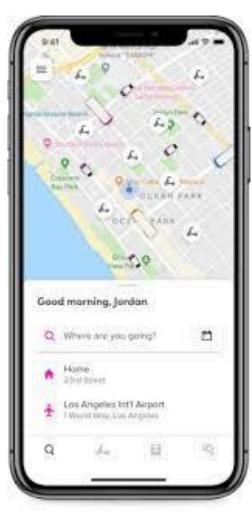

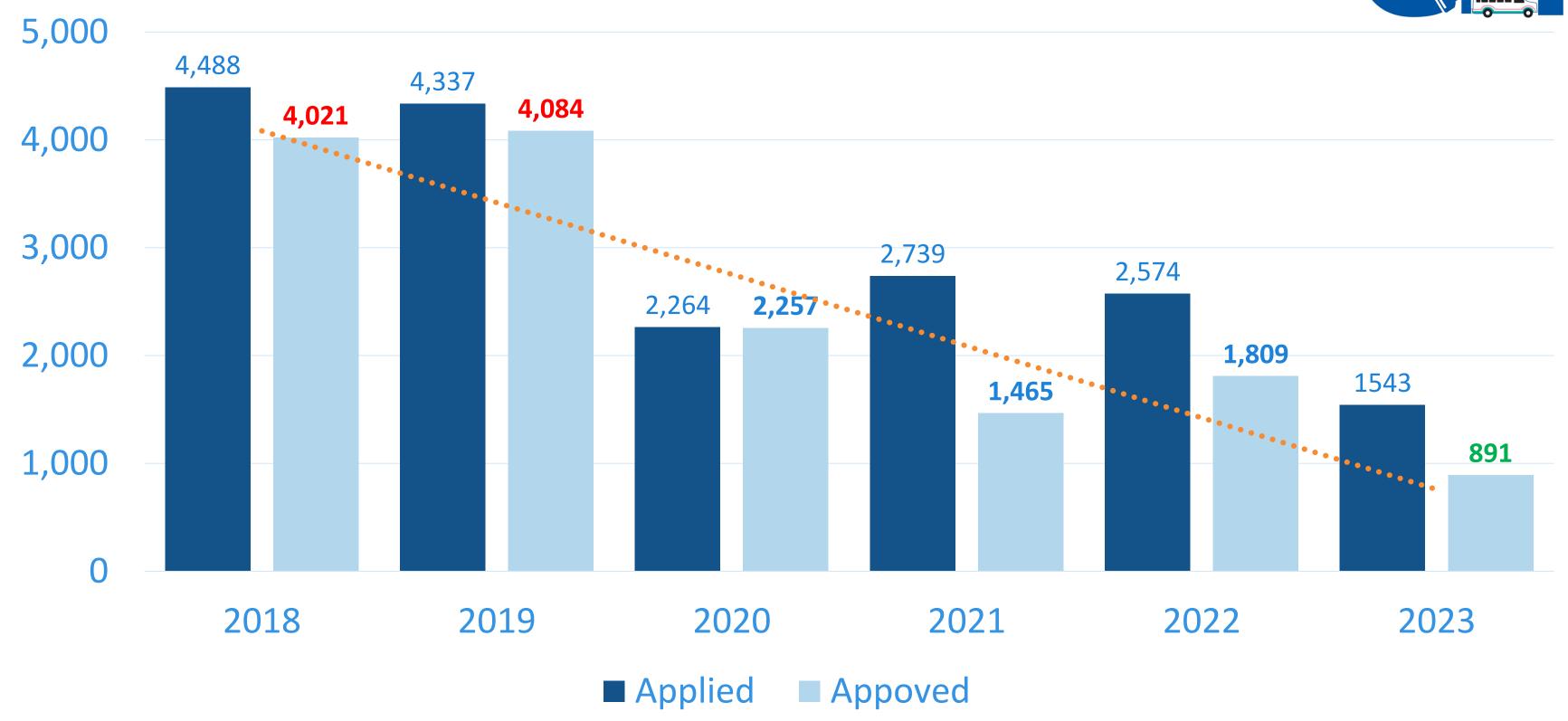


Eligibility Efficiencies - Success Story

Connection Efficiency Project (CEP) Implementation Plan







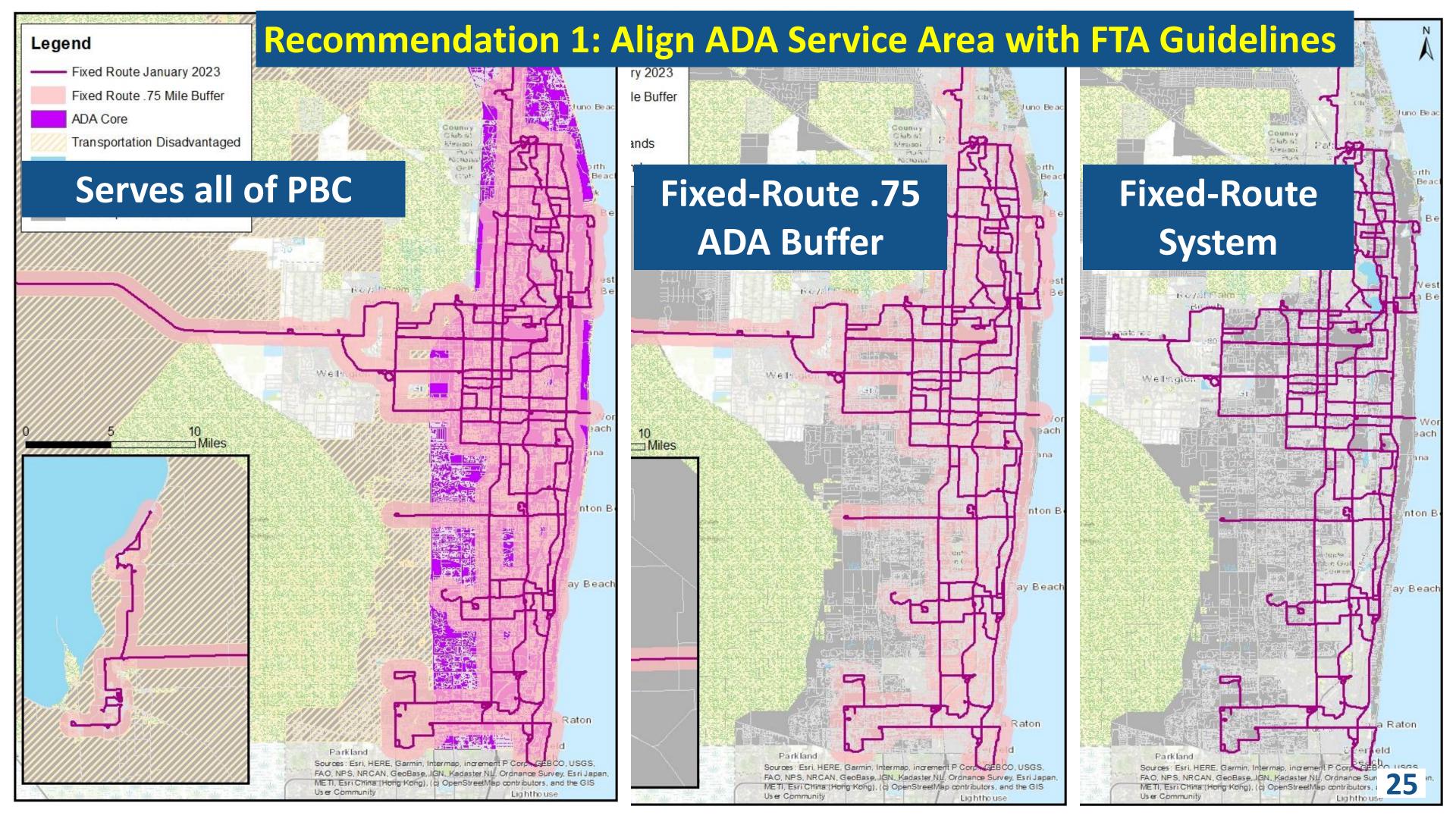
• ADA paratransit service will be provided within ¾ of a mile of Fixed-Route System

- TD (Transportation Disadvantaged) trips outside of the ADA area will be covered by the alternative transportation services program

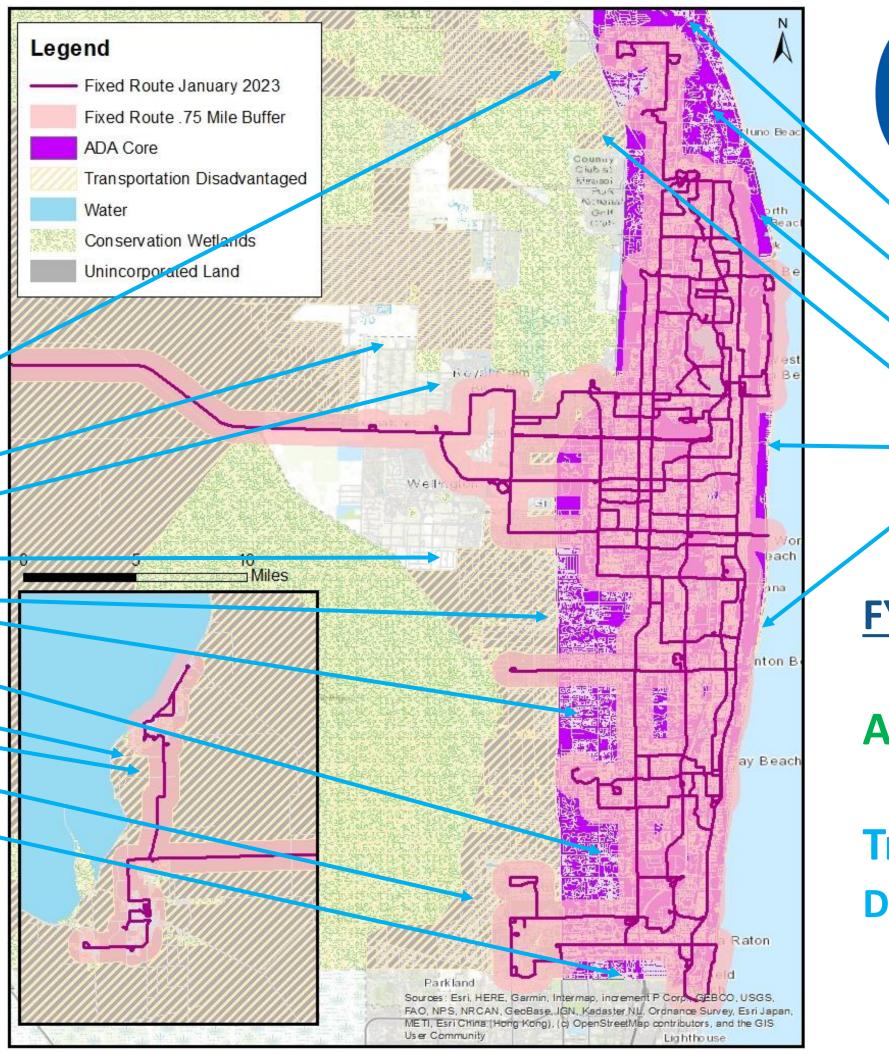
Recommendation 3: Adjust Fares to Federal Guidelines

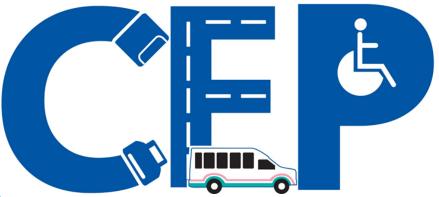
To no more than twice the conventional Fixed-Route Fare (\$3.50 to \$4.00 per trip)

Federally Mandated ADA Service will be provided by Palm Tran Connection



Alternative Transportation Provider will provide service outside of ADA service area (example providers: Uber, Lyft, Taxi, Uzurv:

1. UBER/Lyft for those that can utilize an ambulatory curb-to-curb service and use the technology associated with the program

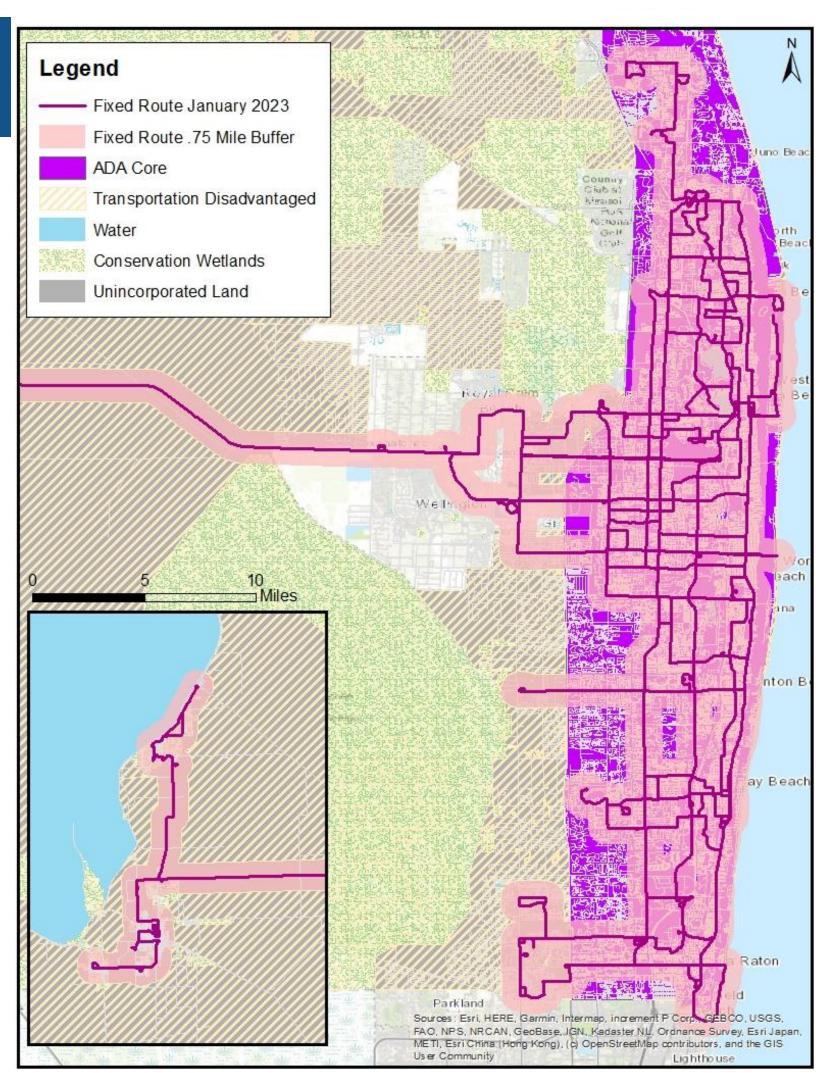




- 2. Compliant door-to-door service (UZURV) for those that do not have a mobility or disability restriction UZURV

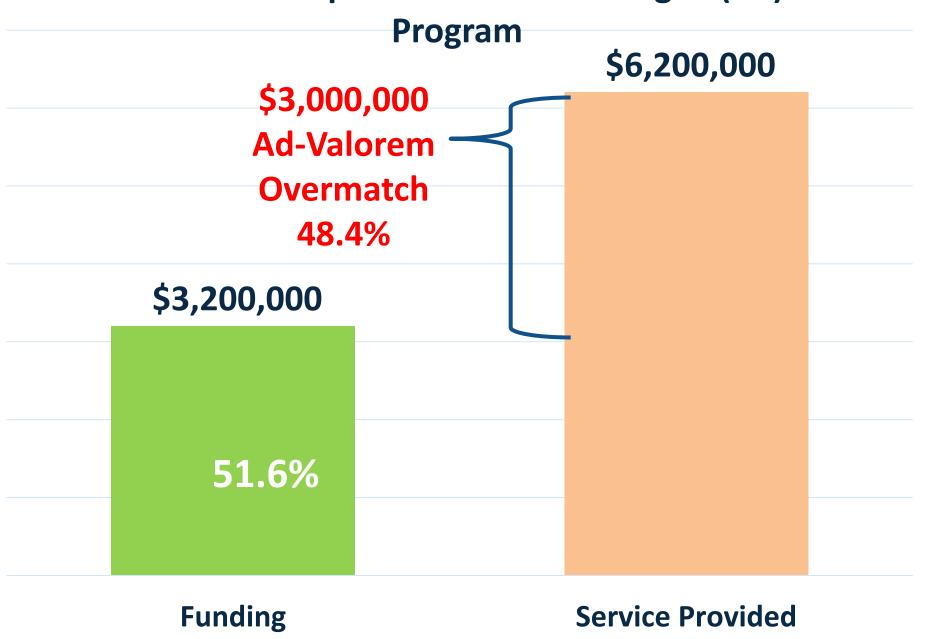

Recommendation 3: Adjust ADA Fare to Federal Guidelines



FTA recognizes high cost of paratransit operations and allows higher fares

Last Paratransit fare adjustment: \$3 to \$3.50 in 2013 (17%)

Recommendation: \$3.50 to \$4 (14%)

Requires separate board action at future BCC meeting
