I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a contract with Hardesty & Hanover, LLC (HHL) in the amount of \$907,256.01 for professional engineering services for the George Bush Boulevard Bridge Replacement over the Intracoastal Waterway (ICWW) (Project).

SUMMARY: Approval of this contract will provide the professional services necessary for the study phase of replacing the George Bush Boulevard bridge. On July 6, 2022, the Goal Setting Committee applied Affirmative Procurement Initiatives of a 10% minimum mandatory Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation and a Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) evaluation preference for African American owned firms. HHL agreed to 13.55% SBE participation for the Contract. On October 24, 2022, the Consultant's Competitive Negotiations Act Selection Committee selected HHL and, in accordance with PPM No. CW-O-048, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) was notified of the selection on October 24, 2022. **This Project is included in the Five-Year Road Program. Districts 4 & 7 (YBH)**



Background and Justification: Palm Beach County is now contracting with HHL to provide professional services necessary for the Project. The fee, as detailed in **Exhibit B** of the attached contract, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:

Basic Services (Lump Sum)	\$157,751.00	(Public Involvement, Environmental, Study Analysis and Preparation)
Reimbursable Services (Not to Exceed)	\$749,505.01	(Environmental, Study, Survey, Geotechnical)
Optional Services (Not to Exceed)	\$ 0.00	
Total:	\$907,256.01
