SUMMARY: On December 20, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the hiring of professionals to appraise and assist in the acquisition of lands, rights-of-way and easements necessary to undertake the projects in the adopted Five Year Road Program (O2022-035). Approval of these contracts will allow the Engineering and Public Works (EPW) Department to procure professional appraisal services to provide appraised property values needed for road right-of-way and easement acquisitions. EPW is contracting with ten appraisal firms to ensure timely availability of appraisal services as needed. The contract period for these contracts is 36 months from the date of approval by the BCC. The contracts were presented to the Goal Setting Committee (GSC) on February 1, 2023. The GSC applied an Affirmative Procurement Initiative of a Small Business Enterprise (SBE) evaluation preference for SBE prime bidders with contracts valued at less than \$500,000. On June 15, 2023, the Appraiser Selection Committee selected AGA, ACI, AAC, CPI, CBRE, MRF, PEI, REA, SFH and SPI in accordance with EPW PPM EWO-006. AGA, ACI, AAC, CPI, CBRE, MRF, PEI, REA, SFH and SPI have offices located in Palm Beach County (County), and ACI, CPI, PEI, and SFH are certified SBE companies. Countywide (YBH)
