Summary: The Board establishes the qualifications and competency of contractors that work within the County. The Board also provides for the testing and licensing of these contractors and is empowered to discipline licenses and hear citation appeals. The Board was established by Special Act, Laws of Florida, Chapter 67 1876, as amended. The Special Act and, subsequently, Section 489.131, Florida Statutes (F.S.) sets forth the membership of the Board, which consists of 15 members. This Board shall be comprised of fifteen (15) members as follows: two (2) general contractors, one (1) building contractor, one (1) residential contractor; one (1) electrical contractor; one (1) plumbing contractor; one (1) HARV contractor; one (1) roofing contractor; one (1) swimming pool contractor; one (1) architect; one (1) engineer and one (1) full-time building official employed by a local government within Palm Beach County, who meets the requirements of the Building Officials Association of FL; and three (3) consumer representatives. The Board establishes the qualifications and competency of contractors that work within the County. The Board also provides for the testing and licensing of these contractors and is empowered to discipline licenses and hear citation appeals. (Continued on page 3)

Background and Justification: The membership of the Board consists of two general contractors, and one member of the following categories: building, residential, electrical, plumbing, HARV (Heating, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, and Ventilation), roofing, swimming pool, architect, engineer, and building official. In addition, Section 489.131, F.S. requires that we have three Consumer Representatives. The Board establishes the qualifications and competency of contractors that work within the County. The Board also provides for the testing and licensing of these contractors and is empowered to discipline licensees.

A memorandum was sent to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on August 25, 2023, requesting support for 2 new board members, no other nominations were received. As required by Section 2-443 of the Code of Ethics, this Agenda Item Summary will serve as disclosure for Allen Gast. Allen Gast is the owner of Gast Construction Group, Inc., which contracts with Palm Beach County to provide construction services for the County through sealed bids. The Board provides no regulation, oversight, management, or policy-setting recommendations regarding contracts with the county. The Board currently has 12 seats filled. Four (4) of the current members will termed out by the end of September, bringing the membership down to 8 members. The agenda herein requesting approval to fill 2 new members will bring the membership up to 10 members. With the approval of the 2 new members the diversity count will be eight (8) Caucasians (80%); and two (2) Hispanic Americans (20%). The gender ratio for the Board (female: male) will be 2:8. ITEM: The purpose of this memo is to request your support for the appointment of new board members to the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CIL3). The new nominees are as follows, Mr. Jeffrey A. Remas volunteered to replace Peter Ringle who resigned leaving the vacancy in 2022 as the Building Official, seat 7; Mr. Alan Gast has been nominated by the Associated General Contractors of America, Florida East Coast Chapter (AGC) to replace Mr. Gerry Kelly, seat 5 whose second term will expire on September 30, 2023 and is no longer eligible to serve. Both terms would begin on October 17, 2023, through September 30, 2026.

BACKGROUND: The primary function of the CILB is approval and discipline of certificate of competency construction trade licenses for Palm Beach County. The CILB consists of twelve specified construction trade members per Special Act, in addition to three consumer members who may be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC), establishing 15 active members. The term of office of each member is three years, with one additional 3-year term subject to the BCC approval. The meetings are held once a month on the fourth Monday of each month except for November and holidays permitting. The qualification to be appointed to this board is to be actively engaged in the construction business in Palm Beach County; hold a certificate of competency under the nominee's name; be engaged for not less than five consecutive years immediately before the date of his appointment; and be a resident of Palm Beach County. The architect and engineer member shall be licensed in the State of Florida and be a resident of Palm Beach County. The consumer representative may be any resident of the local jurisdiction who is not and has never been, a member or practitioner of a profession regulated by the CILB or a member of any closely related profession.



The CILB has 12 seats currently filled, and a diversity count of nine (9) Caucasians (75%); and three (3) Hispanic-Americans (25%) showing the board's diversity at 25%. The gender ratio (female: male) is 3:9. Mr. Remas and Mr. Gast are both Caucasian males; the gender ratio would remain the same 9 males, participation to remain at 12 members out of 15.

**DISPOSITION:** The application, and resume for both Mr. Remas and Mr. Gast are attached for your review and signature. If you would like to nominate a different candidate, please provide us with the candidate(s) contact information, all nomination forms are due back by September 11, 2023, for the current seats or any open seats available.

The Contractors Certification Division encourages diversity in all CILB nominations; a diverse representation to the Board appointments is important in promoting various perspectives and approaches to policy development, strategic planning, and regulatory implementation for our citizens.

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#### Special Act, Chapter 67-1876, Laws of Florida as amended

# Board Member Qualifications

# Section 3. Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County, organization, meetings, powers, duties. —

- (A.) The Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County is hereby created and composed of the following: two general contractors, one contractor who is primarily engaged in the business of furnishing those services to which a building contractor is limited, one contractor who is primarily engaged in the business of furnishing those services to which a residential contractor is limited, one electrical contractor, one plumbing contractor, one HARV contractor, one roofing contractor, one swimming pool contractor, one architect, one engineer, and one full-time building official, employed by a local government within Palm Beach County who meets the requirements of the Building Officials Association of Florida. All members of the Board shall be appointed by the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners.
- (B.) To be eligible for appointment each contractor member shall be:
  - (1) Actively engaged in the construction business in Palm Beach County and have held a certificate of competency in his name and have been so engaged for a period of not less than 5 consecutive years immediately before the date of his appointment, and be a resident of Palm Beach County. The architect and engineer member shall be licensed in the State of Florida and be a resident of Palm Beach County.
  - (2) Each member of the Board except the Building Official shall hold a valid certificate issued by this Board or the state of Florida in addition to having the qualifications required in subsection (B) (1) above.
  - (3) In the event that any member of the Board no longer possesses the qualifications required in subsection (B) (1) and (B) (2) above, said member may be suspended or removed as a member of the Board upon a majority vote. If a member fails to attend three successive, regular scheduled meetings, he may be removed by a majority vote of the Board.
- (C.) All terms of office expire on September 30 of the last year of the term. As the terms of members expire, the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint a member to fill the vacancy for a term of 3 years, but no member shall serve for more than two consecutive terms but may be reappointed after a three (3) year hiatus. Vacancies in the membership of the board for any cause shall be filled by the Board of County Commissioners for the balance of the unexpired term.

# Board Member Qualifications

# Florida Statutes 489.131 Applicability:

(10) No municipal or county government may issue any certificate of competency or license for any contractor defined in s. 489.105(3)(a)-(o) after July 1, 1993, unless such local government exercises disciplinary control and oversight over such locally licensed contractors, including forwarding a recommended order in each action to the board as provided in subsection (7).

Each local board that licenses and disciplines contractors must have at least two consumer representatives on that board. If the board has seven or more members, at least three of those members must be consumer representatives. The consumer representative may be any resident of the local jurisdiction who is not and has never been, a member or practitioner of a profession regulated by the board or a member of any closely related profession. (7/1/93)
