I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Documents executed in connection with a loan made to Oceana Logistics International, Inc., in the amount of \$200,000 under the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Section 108 Loan Program as follows:

- A) Palm Beach County Section 108 Promissory Note;
- B) Palm Beach County Section 108 Loan Agreement;
- C) Section 108 Loan Program Agreement;
- D) Mortgage Agreement with Assignment of Leases and Rents;
- E) Collateral Security Mortgage Agreement;
- F) Guaranty Agreement;
- G) Environmental Indemnity Agreement;
- H) Further Assurances and Errors and Omissions Statement; and
- 1) State of Florida Uniform Commercial Code 1 Financing Statement.

Summary: This Section 108 Ioan in the amount of \$200,000 is to Oceana Logistics International, Inc., which operates under the name of Oceana Coffee. Oceana Coffee currently has two locations in Palm Beach County with a staff of 22 employees. The total cost of the project is \$1,501,550. The company will partner with two other companies to build a commercial kitchen and café at 1301 10th Street in Lake Park, Florida. The County's Section 108 Ioan funds will be used for working capital. The funds are leveraged with a bank Ioan, Small Business Administration Ioan, a grant from the Town of Lake Park, and borrower's equity. The project will create ten new full-time equivalent jobs over five years. In accordance with County PPM CW-0-051, all delegated contracts, agreements and grants must be submitted by the initiating Department as a receive and file agenda item. The documents have been executed on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) by the County Administrator or Designee in accordance with Resolution R2009-0725, and are now being submitted to the Board to receive and file. Background and Justification: The Palm Beach County Section 108 Loan Program, which is administered by the Palm Beach County Department of Housing & Economic Development, was developed to create a source of loan funding for use by businesses and investors to implement business ventures that will create new jobs and help revitalize communities. Funding for the Program is received from HUD.
