I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order (CO) No. 5 with TLC Diversified, Inc., (Contractor) for the Improvements to Master Repump Station 9-North (Project) in the amount of \$38,516.04 and for an additional Project time extension of 168 calendar days.

Summary: On July 13, 2021 the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2021-0908) with Contractor. The Project provides for the rehabilitation of Master Repump Station 9-North. Work includes mechanical, electrical, and civil rehabilitation, including a new pump, piping, valve replacements, instrumentation, control panels, electrical switchgear, drives, a new standby generator and temporary bypass pumping. CO No. 5 provides for modifications needed to the original design, which include purchasing four (4) additional hoses for the bypass pumps, furnishing & installing two (2) additional pressure sensors for the pump discharge and a 168 day extension due to the generator manufacturing and delivery delays.

The Contract was procured under the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance. On January 20, 2021 the Goal Setting Committee applied an Affirmative Procurement Initiative of a minimum mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation. The Contract provides for 20.87% SBE participation, which includes 14.52% MBE participation, 14.52% MBE (B). CO No. 5 includes 0% SBE participation which includes 0% MBE participation, 0% MBE (B). The cumulative SBE participation including CO No. 5 is 19.28%, which includes 13.42% MBE participation, 13.42% MBE (B). Contractor is headquartered in Palmetto, Florida, but maintains an office in Palm Beach County from which the majority of the work will be formed. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY24 budget. (PBCWUD Project 18-036) <u>District 5</u> (MWJ)

Background and Justification: Master Repump Station 9-North is an integral component of the wastewater network serving Palm Beach County. It conveys flow from the communities in southern Palm Beach County to the Southern Region Water Reclamation Facility. The Project provides for structural upgrades for hurricane hardening, a new backup power generator, upgrading the electrical switchgear and adding a new jockey booster pump to handle low flows during early morning hours. Improvements to Master Repump Station 9-North will restore the service life of the repump station and increase the reliability, safety, and operability of the wastewater collection system. The Project delay is due to supply chain issues and material delay that is industry wide.


