I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: an increase to the maximum cumulative value for the annual fire alarm repair and replacement contract in the amount of \$5,000,000 for fire alarm repair and replacement services on an as-needed basis through June 1, 2025.

Summary: On June 2, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved fire alarm repair and replacement contracts (R2020-0567 and R2020-0568) for fire alarm repair and replacement services related to repairs, modifications and replacement of existing fire alarm systems as per the Electronic Services and Security (ESS) fire detection and alarm guidelines for county buildings throughout Palm Beach County. To date, the County has awarded work orders in the amount of \$512,583.54. In order to accommodate additional anticipated new projects required to be accomplished before this contract expires on June 1, 2025, staff is requesting to increase the maximum cumulative value for the annual fire alarm repair and replacement contract in the amount of \$5,000,000. This increase will bring the maximum cumulative value of the annual fire alarm repair and replacement contract to \$6,000,000. Work is to be awarded as work orders on a lump-sum, competitively bid basis across all prequalified contractors. Contractors may qualify at any time and be added to this annual fire alarm repair and replacement services contract before the term ends. Projects less than \$100,000 are bid among the pool of certified Small Business Enterprise (SBE) contractors, when three (3) or more small businesses are qualified under the contract. Projects \$100,000 or greater are advertised on the vendor self-service (VSS) website and are bid among the pool of pre-qualified contractors while projects \$200,000 or greater are advertised on the VSS website and additionally advertised in the newspaper. The bidding pool is further expanded, for projects \$100,000 or greater, to include additional bidders responding to the specific project advertisement that submit a qualification application at least ten (10) calendar days before the bid due date. Currently two (2) contractors are prequalified. This annual fire alarm repair and replacement contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on November 20, 2019 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (APIs) of sheltered market for projects less than \$100,000 (when three (3) or more small businesses are qualified under the annual contract) or SBE contractor will be given a price preference if its bid is within 10% of the lowest non-small business bid. The cumulative Small/Minority/Women Business Enterprise (S/M/WBE) participation for the annual fire alarm repair and replacement contract is 82.09%. (Capital Improvements) Countywide (MWJ)

Background and Justification:

The prequalification for this contract was advertised on January 12, 2020. In order to accommodate additional anticipated new projects required to be accomplished before the term of this contract expires on June 1, 2025, staff is requesting to increase the maximum cumulative value for the annual fire alarm repair and replacement contracts in the amount of \$5,000,000. This increase will bring the maximum cumulative value of the annual fire alarm repair and replacement contracts to \$6,000,000.
