I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 9 to the continuing architectural/engineering consulting services contract (R2019-1898) with Architecture Green LLC (Consultant) in the amount of \$213,849.19 for the North County Aquatic Complex-Pool Renovation and New Splash Pad project (Project).

Summary: On December 17, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the continuing architectural/engineering consulting services contract (R2019-1898) with the Consultant to provide architectural/engineering services for various projects. The Parks and Recreation Department desires to renovate the existing 50 meter pool/dive well and construct a splash pad area to better serve the users of the North County Aquatic Complex Facility. Under CSA No. 9, the Consultant will provide the professional services (i.e. design, construction document preparation, permitting and construction administration services) necessary for the Project. The continuing architectural/engineering consulting services contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on August 7, 2019 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (APIs) of a minimum mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation and an SBE evaluation preference for the selection. The Consultant committed to achieving an SBE goal of 100%. The SBE participation on this CSA is 64.18%. To date, the cumulative SBE participation on the contract is 86.99%. The Consultant is a local and SBE certified firm. Funding for this project is from the Infrastructure Sales Tax Fund. (Capital Improvements Division) District 1 (MWJ)

Background & Justification: The design professional was selected on November 8, 2019, pursuant to the Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA), Florida Statute 287.055. CSA No. 9 will provide the professional services necessary for the Project which will benefit the residents of the community.

THIS CONSULTANT SERVICES AUTHORIZATION (CSA) NO. 09 to the Contract dated 12/17/2019 (R2019-1898) (the "Contract") between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners and the Consultant identified herein is for the consultant services described in Item 4 of this CSA.

- 1. CONSULTANT: Architecture Green LLC, whose Federal Tax ID# is 77-0714409.
- 2. History: Not applicable. This CSA is for a new project.
- 3. Services completed to date: Not applicable. This CSA is for a new project.
- 4. Description of Services to be provided by Consultant: Professional services shall include the design, document preparation, permitting and construction administration services necessary for the renovations of the existing 50-meter pool/dive well and new children's splash pad area, as detailed on the attached proposal dated 12/14/2023. In the event of a conflict between the terms and conditions of the Contract and the terms and conditions of Consultant's proposal, the terms and conditions of the Contract shall control.
- 5. Compensation: The compensation to be paid to the Consultant for the requested services shall be :Lump Sum charge of \$ 213,849.19.
- 6. This CSA may be terminated, in whole or in part, by the County with or without cause in accordance with the Contract terms. In the event of termination not the fault of the Consultant, the Consultant shall be compensated for all services performed to termination date, together with reimbursable expenses (if applicable) then due in accordance with the Contract terms.

Consultant agrees to waive any and all claims for lost profits or anticipated future profits in the event of a termination with or without cause under this Contract.

- 7. If not previously provided or for a new project, the Consultant shall provide County with an executed Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form, attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- **8.** All terms, conditions, and obligations of the original Contract, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, unless specifically noted as follows:

E-VERIFY - EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

CONSULTANT warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov) uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of the CONSULTANT's subconsultants performing any duties and obligations under this Contract are registered with the E-Verify System and use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

CONSULTANT shall obtain from each of its subconsultants an affidavit stating that the subconsultant does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with an Unauthorized Alien, as that term is defined in section 448.095(1)(k), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. CONSULTANT shall maintain a copy of any such affidavit from a subconsultant for, at a minimum, the duration of the subcontract and any extension thereof. This provision shall not supersede any provision of this Contract which requires a longer retention period.

COUNTY shall terminate this Contract if it has a good faith belief that CONSULTANT has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.

If COUNTY has a good faith belief that CONSULTANT's subconsultant has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended, COUNTY shall notify CONSULTANT to terminate its contract with the subconsultant and CONSULTANT shall immediately terminate its contract with the subconsultant.

If COUNTY terminates this Contract pursuant to the above, CONSULTANT shall be barred from being awarded a future contract by COUNTY for a period of one (1) year from the date on which this Contract was terminated. In the event of such contract termination, CONSULTANT shall also be liable for any additional costs incurred by COUNTY as a result of the termination.

RESILIENCY AND SUSTAINABILITY

The design must meet the requirements of County's policy and procedures manual, PPM CW-O-093, "Resiliency and Sustainability in County Capital Construction Projects". The design professional shall provide the County a complete resiliency and sustainability checklist for the project. Pursuant to Florida Statutes 255.2575, all County buildings shall be constructed to comply with a sustainable building rating system or national model green building code. The project should use the most recent version of the Southeast Florida Regional Climate Change Compact's Unified Sea Level Rise Projection to plan for future sea level rise.

9. Time of Commencement: Consultant shall begin work immediately on the requested services upon receipt of this executed document which shall constitute official "Notice to Proceed".

10. EBO Program:

The API established for this contract is a mandatory minimum of 20% SBE participation. The Consultant committed to an SBE participation of 100%. The SBE participation for this CSA is 64.18%. When added to the Consultant's participation to date, the resulting SBE participation is 86.99%.



AQUADYNAMICS will provide coordination of SWIMMIMG POOL technical issues with other consultants with owner's Architect, structural engineer and MEP engineer and ancillary consultants as may be necessary, with all communication, progress drawings and the like copied Owner.
