I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- (A) Amendment No. 4 (Amendment) to the General Consulting Agreement with HDR Engineering, Inc. (HDR) for Consulting/Professional Services (R-2019-1157) in the amount of \$194,486.47 for the continued performance of professional planning and design services related to the approved Palm Beach County Airports Capital Improvement Program; and
- (B) a Budget Transfer in the amount of \$99,549 in the Airport's Improvement and Development Fund to provide budget for Amendment No. 4, including a transfer from Reserves in the amount of \$99,549.

Summary: The Consulting Agreement (Agreement) with HDR for general airport planning and design was approved by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) on August 20, 2019 (R 2019-1157) in the amount of \$960,107 in order to carry out the approved Capital Improvement Program for the County's Airport System. Amendment No. 1 was approved by the Board on August 17, 2021 (R 2021-1024), exercising the first one-year renewal option. Amendment No. 2 was approved by the Board on June 7, 2022 (R-2022-0574), increasing the amount of the Agreement by \$541,180.72 and exercising the second oneyear renewal option. Amendment No. 3 was approved by the Board on August 23, 2022 (R-2022-0887), increasing the amount of the Agreement by \$339,430.44. Approval of this Amendment will increase the amount of the Agreement by \$194,486.47, resulting in a total cumulative contract value of \$2,035,204.63. This Amendment includes the following tasks: Task I Services - North Palm Beach County General Aviation Airport (F45) Terminal Ramp Value Engineer Design and F45 Runway 9R-27L Design Update. This Amendment provides for supplemental design services associated with tasks previously assigned to HDR under the Agreement. HDR is an Omaha, Nebraska based firm; however, the majority of the work is managed from its West Palm Beach office. A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 20% was established for the Agreement. committed to 20% DBE participation. The DBE participation for this Amendment is 10%. The cumulative DBE participation, including this Amendment, is 20%. Countywide (AH)

Background and Justification: In order to carry out the approved Capital Improvement Program for the County's Airport System, the Department of Airports requires professional planning and design engineering services. Article 2 of the Agreement authorizes amendments to the Agreement to expand the scope of services to include additional services needed to complete tasks authorized prior to the expiration of the Agreement. Task I-22-F45-G-005 - F45 Terminal Ramp Expansion Design (R-2022-0574) requires additional value engineering design services to modify the scope of the terminal ramp expansion to ensure the project can be completed within the available budget. Task I-19-F45-H-001 - F45 Rehabilitation of Runway 9R-27L (R-2019-1157) requires additional design services to ensure compliance with updated FAA design standards and the future relocation of Runway 14-32.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Description of the services outlined below in Section 0 - General is intended to be general in nature and should not be construed to be a complete description of the services or a limitation on the Scope of Services to be provided. Refer to Sections 1 through 8 for the definition of specific scope items to be performed by HDR.

0. GENERAL

0.1 THE PROJECTS

Terminal Ramp Value Engineering

The Palm Beach County (COUNTY) Department of Airports (DOA) North Palm Beach County General Aviation Airport (F45) is designated as a reliever for Palm Beach International (PBI) and serves helicopters, reciprocating engine aircraft, and jet aircraft.




Figure 1 - Value Engineered Ramp Layout

In early 2023, HDR delivered 90% design documents for a 21,000 square yard terminal ramp expansion. The Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (OPC) exceeded the available funding for the project. HDR worked with the DOA to develop a value-engineered design to meet available funding. Figure 1 shows the agreed upon layout, a 9,100 square yard expansion.

The COUNTY wishes for HDR Engineering, Inc ('Consultant') to proceed with design and production of construction documents for the ramp expansion in general compliance with the preferred layout.

- Design Team Coordination Meetings. CONSULTANT will conduct up to 13 weekly design team coordination meetings during this phase to coordinate among the disciplines and subconsultant team members.
- Submit phase deliverables. CONSULTANT will submit the phase deliverables from Table 2 for 6.8. review by the DOA.
- Submittal review meeting. CONSULTANT shall coordinate and attend one (1) meeting at the 6.9. DOA to review the submittal. The CONSULTANT will provide written minutes from the meeting.

LNA Runway 4-22 Rehabilitation

- 6.10. Consultant shall evaluate the potential use of a state highway asphalt specification in lieu of an FAA asphalt pavement specification, as allowed by FAA construction specification P-403 for aircraft less than 12,500 lbs. The evaluation shall be for the Rehabilitation of Runway 4-22 at the LNA airport.
- 6.11. If the Consultant finds the state highway asphalt pavement specification is appropriate for the project, Consultant shall select an appropriate state highway mix and revise the design documents to show the state highway mix as a bid alternate to the FAA asphalt pavement mix.

0.1 THE PROJECTS

Runway 9R-27L Design Updates




Figure 1 - Runway 9R-27L Construction Updated Scope

The Palm Beach County Department of Airports' (DOA) North Palm Beach County General Aviation Airport (F45) is served by the 4,300' x 100' Runway 9R-27L and connecting taxiways E, F, and connectors K1-K7 (Figure 1). The DOA contracted with the Consultant in 2019 to provide design services for the rehabilitation of Runway 9R-27L and its connecting taxiways. The project is known as the 'Runway 9R-27L Rehabilitation'. The design was completed in January 2021 but was not bid for construction.

The DOA intends to bid the project in 2024. - Revise taxiway improvements from base bid to a bid alternate for Taxiways K1, K2, K3, K5, K6, and K7.
- Update taxiway grading to meet existing elevations
- o Update taxiway geometry to comply with FAA AC 150/5300-13B 'Airport Design'


