# I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to Adopt:** an Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, amending Ordinance No. 90-16, as amended, the "Surplus Property Ordinance", by amending Section 7 - Recordation and Inventory of Certain Property by increasing the capitalization level for tangible personal property assets from \$1,000 to \$5,000; providing for the repeal of laws in conflict; providing for severability; providing for inclusion in the Code of Laws and Ordinances; and providing for an effective date. <u>Countywide</u> (DB)

**Summary:** On February 6, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners approved the preliminary reading and permission to advertise for Public Hearing amending Ordinance No. 90-16, as amended, the "Surplus Property Ordinance" in accordance with Section 274.02, Florida Statutes which provides that the County shall establish the requirements for the recording of property and for the periodic review of property for inventory purposes. Currently, the Surplus Property Ordinance provides that tangible personal property, the value of which is \$1,000 or more and the normal expected life of which is one year or more, shall be marked, recorded and inventoried. Staff recommends amending the ordinance to increase the threshold for marking, recording, and tagging inventory to \$5,000, which is consistent with the State's policy as applied to tangible personal property capitalization.

**Background and Justification**: Florida Administrative Rule 69I-72.007 provides that, for statewide financial reporting purposes, all tangible personal property with a value or cost of \$5,000 or more and having a projected useful life of one year or more must be capitalized. Staff recommends a motion to adopt amending the Surplus Property Ordinance to align the County's policy with that of the State. The County's current inventory of capitalized tangible personal property consists of approximately 40,000 assets.



12	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissions of Palm Beach County, Florida, adopted
13	Ordinance No. 90-16, as amended, the "Surplus Property Ordinance," which authorizes the disposal
14	and retirement of surplus property; and
15	WHEREAS, Florida Administrative Rule 69I-72.007 provides that, for statewide financial
16	reporting purposes, all tangible personal property with a value or cost of \$5,000 or more and having a
17	projected useful life of one year or more must be capitalized; and
18	WHEREAS, currently, the Surplus Property Ordinance requires the marking, recording, and
19	inventorying of all tangible personal property the value of which is \$1,000 or more; and
20	WHEREAS, the County intends to amend the Surplus Property Ordinance to align the
21	County's policy with that of the State, by increasing the capitalization threshold for tangible personal
22	property assets from \$1,000 to \$5,000.
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
24	COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

26	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE SURPLUS PROPERTY ORDINANCE
27	Section 7 of the Surplus Property Ordinance, as amended, is hereby further amended as
28	follows:

30	SECTION 7. RECORDATION AND INVENTORY OF CERTAIN PROPERTY
31	Tangible Personal Property, the value of which is \$5,000 or more and the normal
32	expected life of which is one (1) year or more, shall be marked, recorded and
33	inventoried in accordance with the requirements of Section 274.02, Florida Statutes.

35	SECTION 2. REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT
36	All local laws and ordinances or parts of such ordinance applying to the unincorporated area
37	of Palm Beach County in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the
38	extent of the conflict.

40	SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY
41	If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is for any reason
42	held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding shall
43	not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
