I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$551,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO).

Summary: Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes; provides that the seizing agency shall use Forfeiture proceeds for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education and prevention programs, or for other law enforcement purposes, which include defraying the cost of protracted or complex investigations, providing additional equipment or expertise, purchasing automated external defibrillators, and providing matching grant funds. Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, also requires that no less than 25% of the LETF's previous year's revenues be used for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and school resource officer programs of various non-profit organizations. The PBSO's FY 2024 donation requirement is \$279,292. The PBSO's support of these programs exemplifies its strong commitment to the prevention and reduction of crime throughout the communities it serves and its desire to put money back into these communities to support organizations that provide such services. The year-to-date transfer for all donations to outside organizations after approval of this item is \$1,227,500. The funds requested are to aid PBSO and qualified organizations that meet the requirements set forth in Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes. Use of LETF requires approval by the Board, upon request of the Sheriff. The current State LETF balance is \$4,360,037. Approval of this request will reduce the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund balance to \$3,809,037. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes. Below is a table indicating the organizations the PBSO seeks to fund and the corresponding amount of funding proposed per respective organization or agency. No new positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. Countywide (RS) (Continued on Page 3)

Background and Justification: The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office is dedicated to providing the most efficient and effective law enforcement services and also has a long-standing commitment to the reduction of crime and implementation of crime and drug prevention programs within Palm Beach County. Use of LETF requires approval by the Board, in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, upon request of the Sheriff. This Statute also requires that no less than 25 % of the last fiscal year's revenues be donated or expended for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood or school resource officer programs. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds by the organizations listed above is in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes.

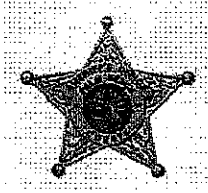

1. Program Coordinator - Part Time Position - Program Coordinator will oversee the program components to allow the curriculum developed so that all facets will come to their optimum level for success. The Coordinator will also oversee various elements such as scheduling workshops, seminars, networking activities, and daily management of program elements.
2. Curriculum Developer - Part Time Position - Curriculum Developer will be responsible for developing and coordinating the program.

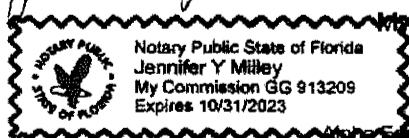

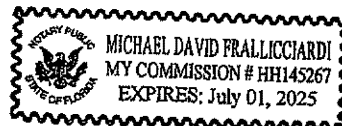

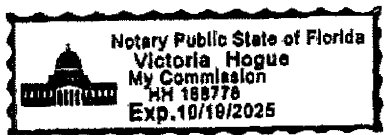

For 50 years the Faulk Center for Counseling has provided free and low-cost mental health counseling and supportive services to low-income and historically marginalized individuals and families throughout Palm Beach and Broward County Florida.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

The Schools Preventative Program represents a collaborative initiative between the Faulk Center and select elementary and middle public schools in Palm Beach County. Its purpose is to deliver onsite mental health group counseling to students who are deemed high-need or at-risk, as recommended by parents or caregivers, teachers, and school guidance counselors. Through the renewed funding from the PBSO, we will be able to extend the provision of no-cost group counseling services to economically disadvantaged, at-risk students enrolled in one of our partnering schools for the 23/24 academic year. These counseling sessions are conducted outside of regular academic hours and are specifically tailored to address the needs of at-risk students aged 5 to 18 who have exhibited inclinations towards violent, criminal, and delinquent behaviors.

What results are you committed to achieving?

Through our partnerships with public elementary and middle schools in Palm Beach County, we have the ability to make a significant difference in the mental well-being of those we support. For the current academic school year, we anticipate that 85% of approximately 300 unique children and adolescents who participate in onsite group mental health counseling services offered by the Faulk Center's Schools Preventative Program will demonstrate reduced symptomatic impacts (such as depression, anxiety, fear, tiredness, etc.) or increased functionality (including improved engagement, social skills, behavior control, etc.) within an 8-week period or by the end of their counseling journey. This progress will be measured using a pre and post assessment known as the Children's Functional Assessment Rating Scale (CFARS).



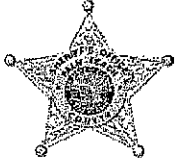

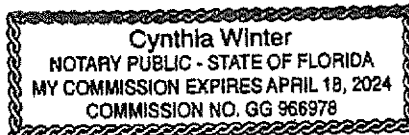

Give children living in at-risk, underserved homes equal educational opportunities as their more affluent peers and provide hard-working families and children the tools, skills & support needed to succeed in school and life, grow into successful adults and be positive contributions to our community.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

Out-of-School Time (OST) program for 250 school-age students year-round after school, non-school days, holidays & summer camp. New this year, middle schoolers (6-8th) are also served. Students are picked up from 12 area schools and stay until 5:30pm; 7:30a-5:30p on full days. They receive snacks, socialization, homework support, individualized/small group activities, tutoring and dinner; plus, use of Chromebooks and supplies needed to complete homework and projects. Therapeutic support is provided on campus by 50+ partner providers. After homework, we offer Space and technology-focused enrichment to ensure kids have access to high tech skills, and eventually, high paying jobs. The curriculum emphasizes social and emotional learning, life skills, daily fitness with indoor/outdoor sports, service-learning component, and the arts- music, dance, visual arts & drama.

What results are you committed to achieving?

Our program prevents crime, giving at-risk youth structured activities, addressing an urgent need. Last year, the Wayne Barton Study Center, across the street from Fuller East shut its doors after 20 years, leaving hundreds of youth from low-income at-risk homes nowhere to go once school is out. Studies show juvenile crime spikes 2 to 6pm- between school dismissal and parents' arrival from work. OST programs reduce unsupervised time, lower dropout rates, reduce addictive & criminal behavior, and reduce low-income achievement gaps. Children involved in extracurriculars are 400% more likely to go to college than kids who aren't. But, youth from under-resourced homes are 3X less likely to attend OST programs. Students who dropout are 63X more likely to be incarcerated than college grads. Dropout rates are highest for Black (31%) & Hispanic (33%) students.

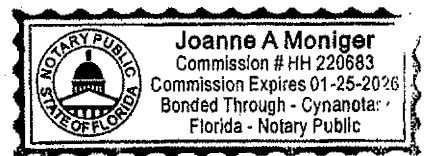

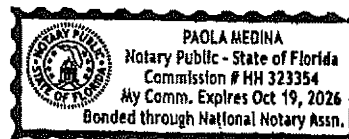

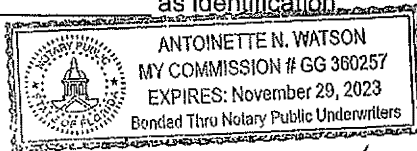

The officer usually tells a life story of a criminal he personally arrested and the testimony of that criminals poor choices.

We hope that our mentorship programs will help fill the gap that has been left by a now absent father. We strive to teach young men and women to be strong, resilient and successful. This is a vulnerable population. The chances of these kids being involved in crime is higher without the core familial infrastructure at home and dealing with tragedy. We believe the time we spend with them encouraging them to stay the narrow course, avoid drugs and crime will help them to be successful in life. Providing them with a mentor who keeps track of them through the year also provides accountability in this area.

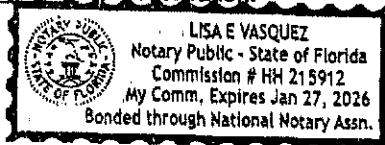

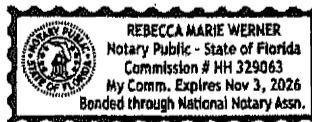

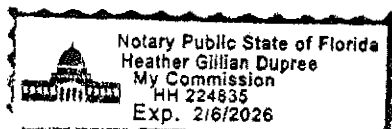
