A) The County has encumbered \$2,197,455 (\$67,614/month) during the previous thirty-two and one-half (32.5) months of the current thirty-six (36) month term contract. The Fire Rescue Department, as lead department, requests an increase of \$300,000 over the previously authorized amount of \$2,225,000 for the remaining three and one-half (3.5) months of the current term contract. The County has encumbered \$49,393 (\$4,295/month) during the previous eleven and one half (11.5) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. The Facilities Development and Operations Department requests a six (6) month extension to the current term contract for audio visual equipment, repair services.
