**I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF**

**Motion and Title:** Staff recommends motion to approve: First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement (R2020-0575) with Martin County (Participant) to extend the term of the Agreement for interoperable radio communications through the countywide common talk groups of the County’s Public Safety Radio System (System) from June 2, 2025, to June 1, 2030.





**Summary:** The Agreement, which provides the terms and conditions under which the Participant can program its radios to utilize the countywide common talk groups for certain inter-agency communications, expires on June 1, 2025. The Agreement provided for two (2) renewal options, each for a period of five (5) years. The Participant has approved the amendment to extend the term of the Agreement to June 1, 2030, and the renewal now requires approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). The terms of the Agreement are standard and have been offered to all municipalities and local branches of State/Federal agencies with 800 MHz trunked radio capabilities. There are no charges associated with the Agreement. The Participant is required to pay all costs associated with its subscriber units and to comply with established operating procedures for the System. The Agreement may be terminated by either party, with or without cause, upon ten (10) days’ notice. This First Amendment extends the term of the Agreement and adds E-Verify provision. Other than the changes set forth herein, all other terms remain the same. **(ESS) Countywide (MWJ)**

**Background and Justification:** The Participant has utilized interoperable communications through countywide common talk groups since 2003. The Agreement with the Participant, which provides the terms and conditions under which the Participant can utilize the countywide and common talk groups of the County’s System, expires on June 1, 2025. The Agreement provided for two (2) renewal options, each for a period of five (5) years. After approval of this First Amendment, one (1) renewal option will remain.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT**

**THIS FIRST AMENDMENT** to the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement (R 2020-0575) dated June 2, 2020 (“Agreement”) is made as of May 6, 2025, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (“County”), and Martin County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (“ Martin County”),

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the County and Martin County agree as follows:

1. The term of the Agreement, is renewed beginning on June 2, 2025, and continuing through June 1, 2030, pursuant to the exercise of the first renewal option for five (5) years.
2. The Agreement is hereby modified to add the following:

**SECTION 26: E-VERIFY – EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY**

**26.01** Martin County warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov), and uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of the Martin County’s contractors and subcontractors performing any duties and obligations under this Agreement are registered with and use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

**26.02** County shall terminate this Agreement if it has a good faith belief that Martin County has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.

3. Except as modified by this First Amendment, the Agreement remains unmodified and in full force and effect in accordance with the terms thereof and is hereby ratified and confirmed by the Martin County and County.






