I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Order (WO) No. 3 to the 2023 Lift Station Rehabilitation Continuing Construction Contract (Continuing Contract) with Hinterland Group Inc., (Contractor) for the Lift Station Rehabilitation Priority Work Phase 2 Package C (Project) in the amount of \$3,193,473.03.

Summary: On January 23, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Continuing Contract (R2024-0069) with Contractor. WO No. 3 provides for the rehabilitation of five (5) lift stations across the Utility. The project will also provide for the installation of fall protection pilots at select stations.

The Continuing Contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee (Committee) on September 7, 2023 and the Committee established an Affirmative Procurement Initiative (API) of 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting participation of which 3% shall be among certified African American (AA) and/or Hispanic American (HA) owned firms. The Contractor committed to 26.14% SBE participation which includes 26.14% Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) (AA). The SBE proposed participation for this WO No. 3 is 19.13% MBE, 19.13% MBE AA. To date, the overall participation achieved on the Contract is 19.13%. The Contractor is located in Palm Beach County. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY 2025 budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 22-001) Countywide (MWJ)

Background and Justification: PBCWUD has determined that the following five (5) lift stations require improvements: 1. 0265, 2. 0391, 3. 4200, 4. 8108, and 5. 8201. Improvements required vary per lift station. Improvements may be limited to addressing existing deficiencies or full station rehabilitation. For lift stations that require a full rehabilitation, the lift station will be brought up to PBCWUD's Minimum Design & Construction Standards, where feasible.

PBCWUD also utilized this project as a pilot to investigate and ultimately choose one of two fall protection methodologies for lift stations. The first option mounts a removable safety guardrails around the wet well with embedded anchors so as to avoid tripping hazards when the guardrails are removed. The second option installs a fixed anchor post with mast designed for a personal fall arrest system with a harness and self-retracting lifeline.

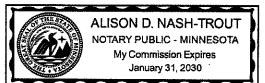

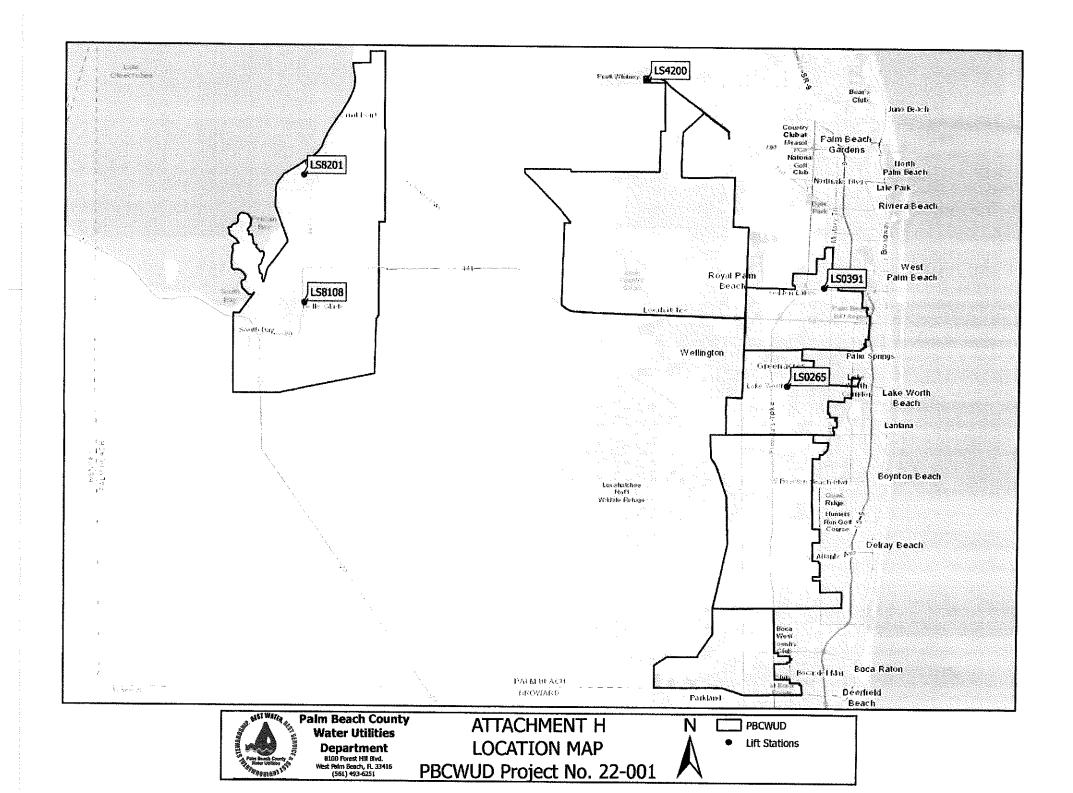

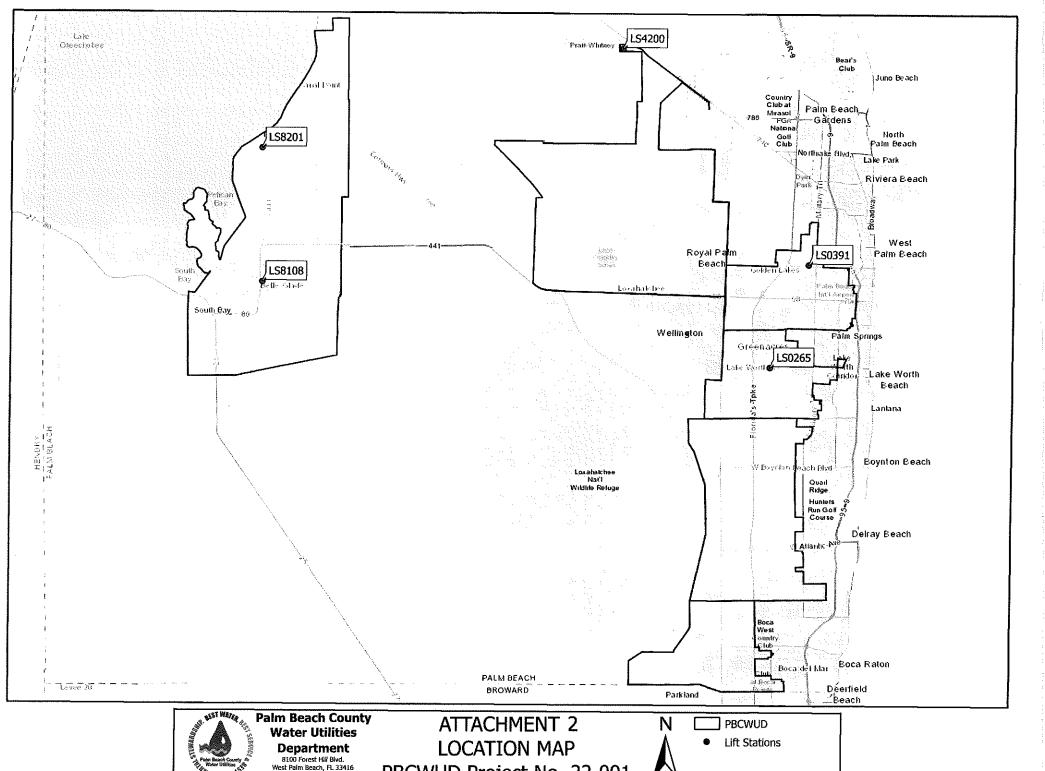

Location Map

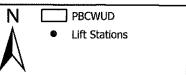
