I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF





Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement (R2020-0459) (Agreement) with the City of Riviera Beach (City) to extend the term of the Agreement for direct access to the County’s Public Safety Radio System (System) retroactively (due to the City’s delay in executing the amendment) from May 5, 2025, through May 4, 2030, with revenues totaling \$90,540.70 annually.

Summary: The Agreement, which provides the terms and conditions under which the City can directly access the System, expired on May 4, 2025. The Agreement provided for two (2) renewal options, each for a period of five (5) years. The City has approved this amendment to extend the term of the Agreement to May 4, 2030, and this renewal now requires approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). The terms of this Agreement are standard and have been offered to all municipalities and local branches of State/Federal agencies where connection through an established municipal hub is not technically feasible. The annual fees are consistent with those being charged to County departments. In addition, the City is required to pay all costs associated with the City’s subscriber units and to comply with the established operating procedures for the County’s System. The Agreement may be terminated by either party, with or without cause on October 1st of any year, with a minimum of six (6) months’ notice. This First Amendment extends the term of the Agreement, and adds the County’s standard E-Verify provision. Other than the changes set forth herein, all other terms remain the same. The annual fees for each unit will be added to the Renewal and Replacement Fund, and the maintenance fees to the Maintenance and Operation Fund. (ESS) Countywide (MWJ)

Background and Justification: The City has been interoperable with the County’s System since 2004. The Agreement with the City, which provides the terms and conditions under which the City has direct access to the County’s System, expired on May 4, 2025. The Agreement provided for two (2) renewal options, each for a period of five (5) years. After approval of this First Amendment, one (1) renewal option remains.

Whereas, the term of the proposed amendment begins on May 5, 2025, and continues through May 4, 2030

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved By The City Council Of The City Of Riviera Beach, Florida, That:

Section 1: The City Council hereby authorizes the City Council Chairperson to execute the First Amendment to an Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County for access to the Palm Beach County Public Safety Radio System.


Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the City of Riviera Beach City Council.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement (R2020-0459) dated May 5, 2020 ("Agreement") is made as of June 10, 2025, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, ("County") and City of Riviera Beach, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida ("Participant").

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the County and Participant agree as follows:

1. The term of the Agreement is renewed retroactively, beginning May 5, 2025, and continuing through May 4, 2030, pursuant to the exercise of the first renewal option for five (5) years.
2. The Agreement is hereby modified to add the following:

SECTION 27: E-VERIFY – EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

27.01 Participant warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov), and uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of the Participant's contractors and subcontractors performing any duties and obligations under this Agreement are registered with and use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

27.02 County shall terminate this Agreement if it has a good faith belief that Participant has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.

3. Except as modified by this First Amendment, the Agreement remains unmodified and in full force and effect in accordance with the terms thereof and is hereby ratified and confirmed by the Participant and County.
