I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order (CO) No. 6 to the Water Treatment Plant No. 2 Treatment and Disposal Package 1, 3 and 4 (Project) with PC Construction Company dba PCEO, Inc., (Contractor) in the amount of \$453,399.

Summary: On October 18, 2022, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2022-1219) with Contractor. The Project includes furnishing all materials, labor, supervision and equipment necessary to construct one (1) 5.0 million gallon pre-stressed ground storage tank; two (2) aeration and mixing systems for the ground storage tank, one (1) 15 million gallon per day (MGD) lime softening water treatment unit, one (1) surficial aquifer supply well, chemical storage and delivery systems, exterior stairs and elevated walkways, all electrical, instrumentation, piping, valves, pumps, paving, general civil site and other appurtenances for a completely functioning system and demolition, rehabilitation and modification of existing systems as specified. CO No. 6 authorizes the additional work necessary to install the chemical trench and double containment piping that provides various chemicals to treat potable water for consumption. This work is needed to complete the project and is due to unforeseen conditions.

The Contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee (Committee) on April 21, 2021 and the Committee established a 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting participation. The Contractor committed to 36.63% SBE participation. The SBE participation for this CO No. 6 is 5.95%. To date, the overall participation achieved on this Project is 37.20%. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY 2025 budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 18-066R) **District 3** (MWJ)

Background and Justification: PBCWUD has a comprehensive plan for future upgrades to Water Treatment Plant No. 2. The original lime softening Unit 1, constructed in 1973, will be demolished and Unit 2, constructed in 1981, will be placed on standby when the new 15 MGD lime softening unit is completed. A new water storage tank will be constructed to increase reliability for hurricanes and to provide fire flow. CO No. 6 will provide additional work needed to install the chemical trench and double containment piping that provides various chemicals to treat potable water for consumption.

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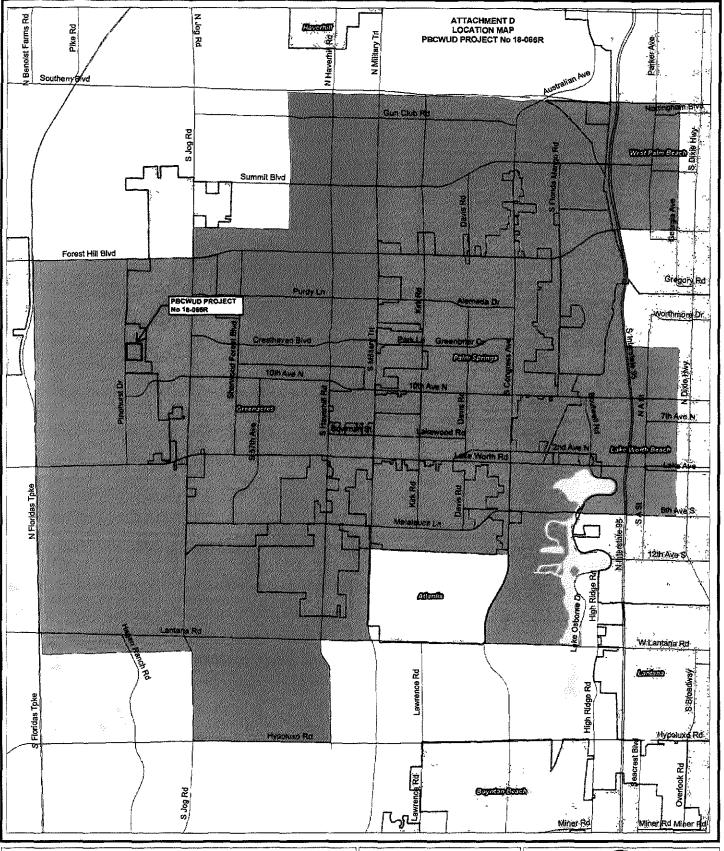

PC Construction dba PCEO, Inc. (PC Construction), the general contractor for the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD), Water Treatment Plant (WTP) No. 2 Treatment and Disposal Improvements – Design Package 1, 3 and 4 Project provided proposed contract change orders, PCO-117 (Rev 4) and PCO-120 (Rev 4), for Chemical Trench Installation Additional Work I and II totaling \$453,399.00. The PCOs are based upon additional utility conflicts that the Contractor uncovered in the field while installing the chemical trench. PBCWUD and PC Construction agreed to modify the standard Change Order language in the Change Order No. 6 package. Per the request of PBCWUD, Kimley-Horn signed Change Order No. 6 to reflect Kimley-Horn's review of PC Construction's material and labor costs only.

1) Additional Work to Install Chemical Trench and Double Containment Piping (PCO-117) (6.1)

Contract drawings M-201 through M-208 show the routing and details for the installation of the chemical trench and the double containment piping within the trench. Existing utilities are shown on the Contract Drawings and are based on the best available record drawings provided to Kimley-Horn. PC Construction uncovered existing utilities in the field in locations that were different from the record drawings provided to Kimley-Horn and, in turn, the Contract Drawings. In order to install the double containment piping for the chemical systems, a revised routing was provided via RFIs 179.3 and 184. The revised routing detailed direct bury installation of the double containment piping, saw cutting and removal of the existing MIEX concrete slab, additional concrete form work and concrete cap installation, and additional sidewalk installation. The revised routing utilized the original design to the best extent possible, while avoiding impacts to existing utilities. This required additional material not already included in the Contract Documents, as well as labor hours associated with the Work. A change in contract price is included for this Work.

PC Construction provided PCO-117 (Rev 4) on February 13, 2025, in the total amount of \$288,697. Kimley-Horn reviewed the material and labor costs to perform the work included within PCO-117 (Rev 4) and takes no exception to the breakdown of costs provided by PC Construction.

PC Construction previously requested 170 additional days in PCO-117 Revisions 2 and 3, at a Daily OH Rate of \$8,040.00. Kimley-Horn takes exception to the Daily OH Rate line item being added to PCO-117. The Contractor's fee only allows for overhead and profit as defined in Article 44, Paragraph C of the General Conditions. Further, per PBCWUD request, all delay claims are to be addressed at the end of the Project.

At PBCWUD's request, Kimley-Horn prepared draft Work Directive Nos. 003, 007 and 008 that included a "not to exceed" amount for the labor and material costs associated with PCO-117. The total of draft Work Directive Nos. 003, 007 and 008 is \$291,747. As detailed within Kimley-Horn's October 3, 2024 and December 6, 2024 letters regarding PCO-106 and PCO-114, the work within Work Directive Nos. 003, 007 and 008 could have been advanced had PC Construction identified chemical trench conflicts prior to procurement, as required by the Contract Documents.

2) Additional Work to Install Chemical Trench and Double Containment Piping (PCO-120) (6.2)

Contract drawings M-201 through M-208 show the routing and details for the installation of the chemical trench and the double containment piping within the trench. Existing utilities are shown on the Contract Drawings and are based on the best available record drawings provided to Kimley-Horn. PC Construction uncovered existing utilities in the field in locations that were different from the record drawings provided to Kimley-Horn and, in turn, the Contract Drawings. In order to install the double containment piping for the chemical systems, a revised routing was provided via RFIs 182, 203, 194, 185, 187 and 184. The revised routing included direct bury installation of the double containment piping, saw cutting and removal of the existing MIEX concrete slab, additional concrete form work and pouring for concrete cap installation, and additional sidewalk installation. PC Construction provided PCO-120 (Rev 4) on February 6, 2025, in the total amount of \$164,702. Kimley-Horn reviewed the material and labor costs to perform the work included within PCO-120 (Rev 4) and takes no exception to the breakdown of costs provided by PC Construction.

On February 11, 2025, PC Construction sent an email stating that it would be adding 14 calendar days to the construction schedule presumably at the same Daily OH Rate identified in PCO-117. Kimley-Horn takes exception to a Daily OH Rate line item being added to PCO-120. The Contractor's fee only allows for overhead and profit as defined in Article 44, Paragraph C of the General Conditions. Further, per PBCWUD request, all delay claims are to be addressed at the end of the Project.

At PBCWUD's request, Kimley-Horn prepared draft Work Directive No. 006 that included a "not to exceed" amount for the labor and material costs associated with PCO-120 (Rev 4). The total of draft Work Directive No. 006 is \$100,000. As detailed within Kimley-Horn's October 3, 2024 and December 6, 2024 letters regarding PCO-106 and PCO-114, the work within Work Directive No. 006 could have been advanced had PC Construction identified chemical trench conflicts prior to procurement, as required by the Contract Documents.

Kimley-Horn reviewed Change Order 6 (CO-6) provided by PC Construction and, although Kimley-Horn does not agree that PC Construction should receive costs or time at the Daily OH Rate associated with the work set forth in PCO-117 and PCO-120 for the reasons expressed within this memo, Kimley-Horn takes no exception to PC Construction's calculation of the total amount of \$453,399.00 for labor and material costs.

PC Construction (PC) issues this PCO-117- Chemical Trench Installation Additional Work_Rev4 to provide pricing per the requirements of the Contract for additional cost and time impact to the Chemical Trench installation through February 3, 2025, which is the date the critical path work resumed.

PC previously submitted PCI-106 (dated March 13, 2024) which demonstrates critical delay totaling 206 calendar days for Chemical Trench design conflicts. PCI-106 was denied in whole. PC maintains its Contract rights for entitlement to the additional time and time-related costs in PCI-106 and currently awaits the Engineer of Record to address these adjustments via the Alternative Dispute Resolution process as required Contract.

Now, PC submits herein this PCO-117- Chemical Trench Installation Additional Work_Rev4 for additional time and cost for impacts to Chemical Trench installation through February 3, 2025. The critical path delay incurred for additional work and changes to the Chemical Trench installation through January February 3, 2025, is 176 calendar days. Costs in PCO-117_Rev4 include the time-related costs for 176 calendar days of critical path delay. PCO-117_Rev4 also includes costs for the additional work and changes to the Chemical Trench installation as identified through February 3, 2025.

PCO-117_Rev4 also includes costs for the investigative efforts associated with the additional work required for Chemical Trench design conflicts, previously included in PCI-106. PCO-117_Rev4 also includes the costs associated with light pole relocation and flow meter relocation originally included in PCI-106.

The additional costs in PCO-117_Rev4 for 176 calendar days of delay plus the costs for additional work and changes to the Chemical Trench installation as identified through February 3, 2025, plus the costs for Chemical Trench design conflicts in PCI-106, and the costs associated with light pole relocation and other items included in PCI-106, come together for a total of \$1,959,960. For the processing of this change order, the cost of work associated with this PCO, removing the time and OH rate, is \$288,967.

Importantly, PCO-117_Rev4 delay and cost for additional work and changes to the installation of the Chemical Trench are only as known and identified through February 3, 2025. Meanwhile, installation of the Chemical Trench remains ongoing, which risks yet more delay, additional work, and changes to the Chemical Trench installation that are not yet known. Accordingly, PCO-117_Rev4 excludes (and PC reserves its rights to future adjustment for) delay, additional work, and changes to the Chemical Trench as may be incurred and/or required for installation of the Chemical Trench after February 3, 2025.

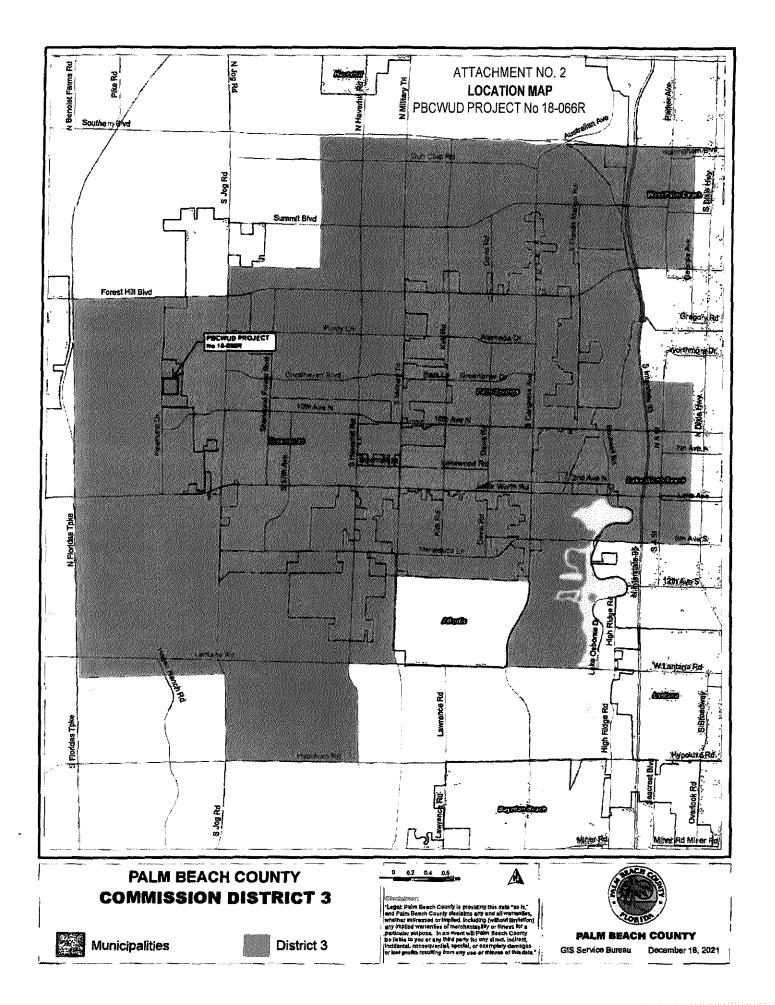
