I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) a downward Budget Amendment of \$197,595 in the Park Improvement Fund which includes a decrease in revenue of \$200,000 from the Bert Winters Park Phase II Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) Grant: and
- B) a \$2,405 Budget Transfer from the General Fund to the Park Improvement Fund to correct the appropriations from the Bert Winters Park Phase II FRDAP Grant.

Summary: On December 7, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) authorized the submission of a \$200,000 (FRDAP) grant application (R2021-1841) for the redevelopment of the southern portion of Bert Winters Park (Project). The grant was awarded under Department of Environmental Protection Agreement Number A3003 and was presented to the BCC on November 1, 2022 (R2022-1292) to receive and file and establish the Project budget. The grant required completion of improvements including a new waterfront promenade, canoe/kayak launch, expanded parking, playground, picnic facilities, group shelters, lighting, and landscaping by April 30, 2025 to qualify for reimbursement.

Due to procurement delays, including the need to re-bid the Project after the initial advertisement failed to attract qualified bidders, Palm Beach County (County) was unable to meet the required deadline. Although a contractor has now been selected, the updated project schedule did not allow for completion and public opening by April 30, 2025, resulting in the withdrawal of the grant. A Budget Amendment in the Park Improvement Fund and a Budget Transfer from the General Fund are necessary to correct the appropriations. District 1 (AH)

Background and Justification: Bert Winters Park is a 16.5 acre park located along the Intracoastal Waterway in the northern part of the County. The park is being redeveloped in three (3) phases. Phase I was completed in 2018 and included the construction of a second entrance road along the northern portion of the park to improve traffic flow and circulation; construction of 45 new boat parking spaces; a new restroom; three (3) new floating staging docks; and renovation of the existing boat ramps. The future Phase II includes the installation of a new canoe/kayak boat launch, expanded parking, new family picnic shelters, new lighting, landscaping and associated infrastructure. The existing parking and day use dock will also be renovated as part of Phase II. Phase III Project elements are still being finalized but are expected to include the renovation and reconfiguration of the athletic fields, possible inclusion of additional tennis or pickleball courts and construction of additional parking for use by park patrons using the waterfront.

On behalf of the Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department, we are writing to formally notify you of our withdrawal from the grant agreement for Bert Winters Park (Agreement No. A3003), effective immediately.

This décision follows careful assessment of our current departmental capacity and the revised project timeline. While we remain committed to the goals outlined in the grant, unforeseen delays in the procurement process have impacted our ability to meet the required timeline. Specifically, the project needed to be re-bid due to a lack of qualified bidders during the initial advertisement. Although a contractor has now been selected, the updated schedule no longer allows for the project to be completed and open to the public by the deadline specified in the agreement.

We are sincerely grateful for the opportunity to have been selected for this grant and for the trust your agency placed in our work. We regret that we are unable to move forward as planned and will take all necessary steps to ensure a smooth and orderly withdrawal, including the submission of any required documentation or reports.

Please advise on any additional procedures for formally closing out the agreement on your end. We hope to remain eligible for future funding opportunities and look forward to the possibility of partnering again.
