### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Second Amendment to the Agreement with Community Foundation for Palm Beach and Martin Counties, Inc. (Community Foundation) (R2024-0660) for the development and planning of the Palm Beach County African American Museum and Research Library (Museum), increasing to \$2,000,000 the County's Not to Exceed Amount and updating the Non-Discrimination provision.

Summary: On June 4, 2024, the County entered into the Agreement with Community Foundation for the planning and development of the Museum. On May 6, 2025, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the First Amendment (R2025-0600) to the Agreement. On July 8, 2025, the BCC approved a budget transfer in the ARPA Response Replacement Fund to modify project budgets of previously approved categories inclusive of assigning an additional \$1,000,000 towards development of the Museum. On June 3, 2025, through adoption of Resolution R2025-014 and Resolution R2025-0748, the BCC revised the County's Non-discrimination policies. Consistent with the aforementioned BCC approvals, the Second Amendment increases to \$2,000,000 the County's Not to Exceed Contribution, and updates the Non-Discrimination provision. These are County ARPA Response Replacement funds that do not require a local match. (FDO Admin) District 7/Countywide (MWJ)

**Background and Justification:** The Agreement provided a County contribution to initiate development, planning and fundraising efforts toward implementation of the Museum initiatives. The Museum will provide cultural and educational information to residents and visitors.

### SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT to Agreement R2024-0660 (Agreement) is made and
entered into this day of, 2025, by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY, a
political subdivision of the State of Florida (County) and THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR
THE PALM BEACH AND MARTIN COUNTIES, INC., a Florida non-profit corporation organized
under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (Community Foundation); collectively the "Parties".

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2024, the Parties entered into the Agreement for the planning and development of a Palm Beach County African American Museum and Research Library (Museum); and

WHEREAS, the Museum will be located at the former Roosevelt Full Service Center (Roosevelt Center), owned by the Palm Beach County School District (School District); and

WHEREAS, Phase 2 of the Roosevelt Center renovation project, which is to be implemented by the School District, includes construction of a new 20,000 sq. ft. 2-story building to house the Museum; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for Phase 2 of the Roosevelt Center renovation project being implemented by the School District will be limited to shell construction, with design and construction of the interior buildout to be undertaken as a separate construction effort not funded nor lead by the School District; and

WHEREAS, Community Foundation is to establish a not for profit corporation under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, that will ultimately oversee the planning, development and operations of the Museum (inclusive of fundraising efforts), and the Community Foundation is to seek tax exempt status for this new corporation as a supporting organization (Supporting Organization) of the Community Foundation, as provided for in Section 509(a)(3) of the Internal Revenue Services ("IRS") regulations; and

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2025, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the First Amendment (R2025-0600) to the Agreement extending the time Community Foundation has to appoint all members to the Board of Directors of the Supporting Organization and to conduct the first meeting of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2025, the BCC approved a budget transfer in the ARPA Response Replacement Fund to modify project budgets of previously approved categories inclusive of assigning an additional one million dollars (\$1,000,000) towards development of the Museum; and

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WHEREAS, on June 3, 2025, through adoption of Ordinance 2025-014 and Resolution R2025-0748, the BCC revised the County's non-discrimination policies.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and representations contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The Parties affirm and incorporate the recitals set forth above.
- 2. Section 3.1. Section 3.1 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

### **SECTION 3.1 County's Not to Exceed Amount.**

The County will timely pay any and all costs accrued by Community Foundation, which are incurred in compliance with the requirements of this Agreement, not to exceed the currently appropriated County Contribution of two million dollars (\$2,000,000). Community Foundation recognizes that the County is providing a one-time contribution and future contributions are not expected nor guaranteed. However, nothing precludes the County from providing future appropriations. Community Foundation shall hold the County Contribution in a separate account, ensuring that funds are not commingled with non-Museum related initiatives, thereby allowing for accounting of all expenditures.

3. Section 9.8. Section 9.8 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

#### **SECTION 9.8 Non-Discrimination.**

The County is committed to assuring equal opportunity in the award of contracts and complies with all laws prohibiting discrimination. Pursuant to Palm Beach County Resolution R2025-0748, as may be amended, Community Foundation warrants and represents that throughout the term of the Agreement, including any renewals thereof, if applicable, all of its employees are treated equally during employment without regard to race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, or genetic information. Failure to meet this requirement shall be considered default of the Agreement.

4. Confirmation. Except as specifically modified above, the terms and conditions of the Agreement are hereby confirmed and remain in full force and effect.
