I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

LIST OF ERRORS, INSOLVENCIES, DOUBLE ASSESSMENTS, DISCOUNTS, AND
VALUE ADJUSTMENT BOARD REDUCTIONS ON THE 2024 ASSESSMENT ROLL.

Summary: Section 197.492, F.S., requires that on or before the 60th day after the tax certificate sale, the Tax Collector shall make out a report to the Board of County Commissioners, separately showing the discounts, errors, double assessments, and insolvencies for which credit is to be given, including in every case except discounts, the names of the parties on whose account the credit is to be allowed. 
Background and Justification:

Anne M. Gannon, Tax Collector of Palm Beach County certifies that the attached is a true list of Errors, Insolvencies, Double Assessments, Discounts and Value Adjustment Board Reductions on the assessment roll for the year **2024**, that the discounts were actually earned for the month as shown; that no exemptions, other than those shown on the Assessment Roll have been allowed; and that each item listed as an error, insolvency or double assessment has been certified by the Property Appraiser. The report listing all Errors Insolvencies, Double Assessments, Discounts & Value Adjustment Board Reductions has been received and is on file and available for inspection in the Board Services/ Minutes Department, Room 203.2, Governmental Center. Due to the bulk of the report, we are presenting only the recapitulation report, which is summarized below:
