I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Order No. 25-010 (Work Order) to the annual minor construction services contract (R2025-0464) with Andrea Construction, Inc. (Contractor) in the amount of \$902,288 for the Water Utility (WUD) SROC Warehouse – Roof Replacement project for a period of 200 calendar days from notice to proceed.

SUMMARY: The project consists of the removal, disposal, and replacement of the existing warehouse roof system with a new roofing system for the WUD SROC Facility located at 13026 South Jog Road in Delray Beach. The Work Order authorizes the construction services necessary to furnish all labor, equipment, devices, tools, materials, transportation, professional services, supervision, shop drawings, permitting and all miscellaneous requirements necessary to replace the existing warehouse roof system. The new roofing system will provide years of weather protection. This project was competitively advertised and new contractors were invited to bid on the project by submitting prequalification documents prior to the submission of the bid response. The Contractor will have 200 calendar days from notice to proceed to substantially complete the project. Liquidated damages for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved time extension thereof are \$180 per day. This Work Order was solicited pursuant to the annual minor construction services contract and the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity (EBO) Ordinance. The annual minor construction services contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on October 2, 2024 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives of a Small Business Enterprise (SBE) price preference whereby an SBE contractor will be given a price preference if its bid is within 10% of the lowest non-small business bid on single trade projects or a minimum mandatory 25% SBE subcontracting goal for multi-trade projects. The SBE participation on this Work Order is 25.13%. To date, the Contractor's SBE participation on its annual minor construction services contract is 41.71%. The overall SBE participation across all the annual minor construction services contracts to date is 42.46%. This contract is subject to emergency ordinance R2025-014 approved by the BCC on June 3, 2025. Funding for this project is from the WUD Operation and Maintenance Fund. (Capital Improvements Division) District 5 (MWJ)

Background and Justification: This project was openly, competitively advertised and procured where new contractors were invited to bid on the project by submitting prequalification documents prior to the submission of the bid response. The Contractor submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the two (2) bids received.



THIS WORK ORDER is made as of August 19, 2025 by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "Owner", and Andrea Construction, Inc., a Florida Profit Corporation, authorized to do business in the State of Florida, whose Federal ID# is 65-0231292 hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

WHEREAS, the Owner and Contractor acknowledge and agree that the Contract between Owner and Contractor dated April 8, 2025 (R2025-0464) ("Contract") is in full force and effect and that this Work Order incorporates all the terms and conditions of the Contract and the IFB/Q for this project, as may be supplemented and amended by this Work Order;

NOW THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein and the sums of money agreed to be paid by the Owner to the Contractor, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Total Bid Amount. Pursuant to Section 6.3 of the Instructions to Bidders of the Annual Contract for Minor Construction Services between Owner and Contractor, the Contractor was the lowest, responsive, responsible Bidder in the amount of \$902,288.00 for the construction costs to furnish all material, labor, supervision, permits and supplies necessary and reasonably incidental to remove and replace the existing warehouse roof system per Attachment "C" and addenda provided by Capital Improvements Division as set forth on the Bid Form attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. Schedule of Time for Completion. The time of completion for this Work Order will be as follows: The Contractor shall substantially complete the project within 200 calendar days from notice to proceed. Liquidated Damages are \$180/day for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved extension thereof.
- **4. APIs.** The APIs applicable to this Contract are attached hereto.
- **5. EBO Participation to Date.** To date Contractor has achieved 41.71% SBE subcontracting participation on this Contract. Contractor will provide 25.13% on this Work Order.

Commercial Non-Discrimination. The Bidder represents and warrants that it will comply with the County's Commercial Nondiscrimination Policy as described in Resolution R2025-0748, as may be amended. As part of such compliance, the Bidder shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, ancestry, sex, age, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, disability, or genetic information in the solicitation, selection, hiring or commercial treatment of subcontractors, vendors, suppliers, or commercial customers, nor shall the Bidder retaliate against any person for reporting instances of such discrimination. The Bidder shall provide equal opportunity for subcontractors, vendors and suppliers to participate in all of its public sector and private sector subcontracting and supply opportunities, provided that nothing contained in this clause shall prohibit or limit otherwise lawful efforts to remedy the effects of marketplace discrimination that have occurred or are occurring in the County's relevant marketplace in Palm Beach County. The Bidder understands and agrees that a material violation of this clause shall be considered a material breach of any resulting contract and may result in termination of the contract, disqualification or debarment of the Bidder from participating in County contracts, or other sanctions. All subcontractor agreements shall include a commercial non-discrimination clause.

9. Except as modified herein, the Contract remains in full force and effect. All capitalized terms herein shall have the same meaning as set forth in the Contract.

1. GENERAL

- a. The work covered by this Request for Quote consists of the furnishing of all labor, equipment, devices, tools, materials, transportation, professional services, supervision, drawings, permitting, and all miscellaneous requirements to perform all operations necessary to accomplish the work set forth below and shall be considered part of the Scope of Work.
- b. Please reference the Annual Contract Minor Construction for additional requirements.
- c. Work to be completed during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- d. Contractor shall contact the Project Manager within seventy-two (72) hours of notice to proceed to establish scheduling, etc. required for project implementation.
- e. Work to be completed within two hundred (200) calendar days from Notice to Proceed. Permit application, if required, is to be submitted by Contractor within five (5) days of "Notice to Proceed" and due diligence exercised to address all Building Department comments.
- f. Liquidated damages will accrue in the amount of \$180 per day.
- g. The Contractor will provide a Certificate of Occupancy or Certificate of Completion, as appropriate, obtained from the proper Building official, prior to processing of final payment.
- h. Contractor is responsible for obtaining all measurements and determining site condition during the site inspection.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

To removal and replace the existing warehouse roof system per the project requirements provided below and Exhibits "1" and "2":

a. Any work not specifically called out or noted shall be addressed by a Request for Information (RFI) from the contractor at least seven (7) calendar days prior to the bid due date.

b. Johns Manville, or Palm Beach County (PBC) approved equal, is the Basis of Design for this project. Alternate manufacturers are GAF, Soprema, or Elevate. Any substitutions must be submitted as a (RFI). The Architect will review these requests to ensure they meet all necessary specifications and warranty requirements. Please note that any additional work required due to a change in manufacturer must be included in the project at no extra cost to the County.

3. SUBMITTALS

All submittals shall be sent to the Project Manager and Architect for approval. This includes, but is not limited to, products to be used, methods of installation and requests for information and/or clarification. All submittals must be made by the Contractor and must include all details necessary for the Architect and Palm Beach County to make any necessary determinations. A transmittal form must be included, which clearly requests data or information and deviations from the contract requirements for which approval is being requested. Failure to provide sufficient information will result in the rejection of the submittal. Where the specifications do not specify a brand name product or where a substitution of a product is not specifically prohibited, the Contractor shall submit their selected products for approval by the Project Manager. 6. PROJECT CONDITIONS
